THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 5-1 thus far on their 11-game homestand, sweeping the Orioles in four games, followed by a win and a loss to the Royals the last two nights...today they will play the three-game series finale with Kansas City...after this series, the Twins will host Tampa Bay for four games from Thursday-Sunday, leading up to the break...the Twins have gone 25-21 at home this season (9-4 in their last 13).

WIN-STREAK STOPS AT FIVE: The Twins lost to the Royals last night by a score of 9-4 at Target Field...Aaron Slegers was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on seven hits in 1.1 innings pitched...the Twins used a total of six pitchers in the game...the offense recorded nine hits, went 1-for-5 with runners in scoring position and left five men on base.

#ACCEPTTHISROSIE: Eddie Rosario is one of the five AL final vote candidates, along with Giancarlo Stanton, Andrew Benintendi, Jean Segura and Andrelton Simmons...since May 1, Rosario is hitting .324 (85-for-262) with 19 doubles, 15 home runs, 42 RBI, 18 walks and a .944 OPS...below are his AL ranks on the season:

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have recalled right-handed pitcher Alan Busenitz from Triple-A Rochester...Busenitz, who will be making his third stint with the Twins this season, appeared in six games for Minnesota going 2-0 with a 6.43 ERA (7.0 IP, 5 ER), two walks and 12 strikeouts...he appeared in 20 games overall for the Red Wings this season, going 2-2 with a 1.41 ERA (32.0 IP, 5 ER), six walks and 37 strikeouts...to make room for Busenitz on the 25-man roster, the Twins have placed Addison Reed on the 10-day disabled list with a right triceps tightness.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the sixth of 19 games this season...they have gone 2-3 against KC this season...a win today would secure the series win, which would mark their first since May 19-21, going 0-3-1 since.

☞ Eddie Rosario has hit safely in 10 straight vs. the Royals...in his last 14 games vs. KC, he is hitting .356 (21-for-59) with 11 RBI.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .319 (237-for-743) with 44 doubles, four triples, 14 home runs, 121 RBI and a .403 on-base percentage in 200 career games against the Royals...he leads all actives in walks vs. KC...his 237 career hits are his personal most vs. any opponent.

SERIES STUFF: The Twins have gone 9-13-6 in series play this season...they are 5-5-4 at home and 4-8-2 on the road...the Twins are seeking consecutive series wins for the first time since June 15-17 at Cleveland (2 of 3) and June 19-21 vs. Boston (2 of 3)...they haven't won consecutive series' at home all season.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1968, Rick Renick became the first Twin and the 16th AL player to hit a home run in his first major league at-bat, hitting it off Detroit's Mickey Lolich...in 1999, Chuck Knoblauch recorded his 10th multi-hit game in-a-row in a game vs. CLE.

LUIS LUIS: Single-A Ft. Myers second baseman Luis Arraez was recently named Minor League Baseball's Player of the Month for June in the Florida State League...Arraez led the Florida State League in average (.449), hits (48), total bases (66), triples (3), on-base percentage (.487) and OPS (1.104)...he finished second in extra-base hits (13) and doubles (9) and was fourth in runs (19) and slugging (.617)...he walked 10 times while striking out only 11 times...Arraez, 21, was signed by Minnesota out of San Felipe, Venezuela, on Nov. 5, 2013.

LAST START: Lynn earned his sixth win of the season in his last start July 6 vs. Baltimore at Target Field...went 6.0 innings and allowed just one run on six hits, two walks and three strikeouts...marked his seventh quality start of the season and the eighth time he has gone 6.0+ innings in a start...was his longest start since May 14 at Detroit when he went a season long 6.2 innings...did not allow a home run for the 11th start this season...the run was scored on a Chris Davis sixth inning single.

AGAINST KANSAS CITY: Lynn is making his sixth career start against Kansas City, going 1-1 with a 5.04 ERA (30.1 IP, 17 ER) in his previous five starts...last start came earlier this year at Kansas City on May 28 when he earned his first and only win against the Royals after 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on six hits...of his five starts he has gone 6.0+ innings all but once, three of which were quality starts.

LYNN ON TARGET: Lynn is making his ninth start at Target Field this season...he has gone 4-2, 2.53 ERA (42.2 IP, 12 ER) with 28 walks, 39 strikeouts and two home runs allowed at home this season...after starting the season, going 0-2, 6.23 ERA (13.0 IP, 9 ER) in three starts, he has since gone 4-0, 0.91 ERA (29.2 IP, 3 ER) in five home starts...he has not allowed more than one run in any of those starts.

JAMMIN' JUNE: In five starts in June, Lynn went 2-2 with a 2.83 ERA (28.2 IP, 9 ER) with 14 walks and 31 strikeouts...among AL starters, ranked 14th in the AL in ERA and was tied for 15th in strikeouts...his nine earned runs allowed in the month were eighth fewest in the AL...opponents are only hitting .210 off Lynn this month, 11th best in the AL.

HOME IS WHERE THE LYNN IS: Lynn is 4-2 over eight starts with a 2.53 ERA (42.2 IP, 12 ER) and a .218 average against at home this season, allowing just two home runs...in nine road starts, he is 2-5 with a 7.83 ERA (43.2 IP, 38 ER) and a .315 average against...his road ERA ranks second-highest in MLB and his average against his third highest only to Wei-Yin Chen and Alex Cobb of starters with at least eight road starts.

MR. 1,000: Lynn eclipsed the 1000.0 inning mark for his career in his start on April 30 against Toronto...there are 71 active players in MLB that have 1,000-or-more innings, 12 of those have 2,000+ IP and just two have 3,000 IP or more...Lynn ranks 71st in innings among actives with 1064.0 innings.

- First pitcher in Twins uniform to reach 1,000.0 innings pitched since Phil Hughes in April of 2015.
- Lynn also eclipsed the 1000 strikeout mark, now with 1004 strikeouts...there are 53 active players who have accomplished this.

WALK-A-LOT: In 2017 Lynn ranked second in MLB and in the NL for most BB/9 (3.77) behind Arizona's Robbie Ray who had a 3.94 BB/9...his 3.77 mark was the highest of his career (2015 - 3.49, 2014 - 3.18, 2013 - 3.39, and 2012 - 3.27)...in his first season back from "Tommy John" surgery Lynn issued 78 walks in 186.1 innings...Lynn issued 44 walks on the road vs. 34 walks at home and of his 78 walks last season, 53 came against left-handed batters...Lynn is among the league leaders in walks in 2018, yielding 50 free passes in 16 starts, which is second most in the AL.

2017 RECAP:

- Lynn ranked tied for first in the NL in games started (33) sixth in AVG (.223), sixth in fewest H/9 (7.29), and seventh in ERA (3.43).
- Lynn had five starts of 7.0 or more innings and 19 starts of 6.0 or more innings, going 9-2 across those starts with 92 strikeouts.
- On May 5 against Los Angeles-NL, Lynn went 8.0 innings pitched while allowing just two hits, one run and 10 strikeouts.
- From April 17-May 5 Lynn had a season-high four-game win-streak posting a 0.72 ERA (25.0 IP, 2 ER) while striking out 23.
