**AND ON WEDNESDAY, WE FUEGO:** Last night, the Padres recorded their first Wednesday win, toppling the Washington Nationals 2-1 in the final matchup of the series between the two clubs...the Friars will head east in two weeks time when they challenge their east coast nemesis at Nationals Park.

- Starter **Joey Lucchesi** worked 5.0 innings, allowing one run (earned) on six hits with six strikeouts...the rookie southpaw picked-off two runners, which are the most of any pitcher in a game this season (or of any team in a game)...only once last season did a pitcher pick off two runners in a game, and that happened to be Clayton Richard on May 27 at WSH.
- **Manuel Margot** had a career-high-tying three hits last night, going 3-for-4 with a double and an RBI.
- **Matt Szczur** added a go-ahead RBI double in the seventh inning to give the Padres their eventual game-winning lead...it was the first time this season and the fifth time in his career in which he's logged a go-ahead RBI hit in the seventh inning or later.

**\*CAP TIP:** Tonight's game commences the four-day weekend celebration of the 20th anniversary of the Padres' 1998 National League Championship team...in honor of former Padres outfielder **Tony Gwynn**, who would have celebrated his 58th birthday on Wednesday, all fans in attendance on Thursday will receive a Tony Gwynn '98 Commemorative Bobblehead...Padres broadcaster **Tony Gwynn Jr.** will throw the Ceremonial First Pitch prior to tonight's game.

**AND I WILL WALK 500 LYLES AND I WILL WALK 500 MORE:** Jordan Lyles makes his first start of the season tonight after beginning 2018 in the bullpen...Lyles has excelled in extended relief appearances in 2018, and he's tied for second-most appearances (six) in recording over three outs without allowing a single earned run.

**KING OF THE CASTLE, I HAVE A CHAIR, I HAVE A CHAIR:** 3B **Christian Villanueva** is one of four NL hitters leading his team in homeruns (nine), RBI (20) and OPS (.867)...the others include WSH's Bryce Harper, ARI's A.J. Pollock and MIA's Justin Bour...the last NL rookie to lead his team in all three categories over a full season was Albert Pujols for the Cardinals in 2001, and the last rookie 3B to do so was Scott Rolen for the Phillies in 1997.

**ORDERLY OPS:** The Padres have the second-highest combined OPS of their fourth and fifth batters of any team (.853), trailing just the Braves (.899).

**A SIGH OF RELIEF:** The Padres bullpen has posted a 3.33 ERA this season, good for the fifth-best mark of an NL relief crew...the Cardinals have the fourth-best ERA of any NL team (3.53)...San Diego relievers have also combined to throw 148.2 innings, leading the NL and tying for the most of any club with LAA.

**SOMETIMES YOU JUST HAVE TO BE SUPPORTIVE:** The Padres starters have received 90 runs of support this season, the sixth fewest of any rotation this year...overall, SD pitchers have received 143 runs of support, tied for fifth-fewest.

**SCORE THOSE RUNS:** Since 2015, the Cardinals have allowed fewer than three runs in 10 of the 21 meetings with San Diego...the Padres are 11-7 this season when scoring four-or-more runs, and the Cardinals are 10-0 when allowing fewer than three in a game.

**PADRES ON DECK:** Last night for Lake Elsinore (A), LHP **Adrian Morejon**, 19, allowed three hits and a walk with seven strikeouts over 7.0 scoreless innings...Morejon is rated the 48th over prospect by the MLB Pipeline and the No. 6 prospect among all left-handed pitchers...2B **Esteury Ruiz**, the Padres' 11-ranked prospect, homered for Fort Wayne (A).

## STARTING PITCHER NOTES

### #27 RHP JORDAN LYLES (0-0, 3.66 ERA)

**ALL LYLES, I MEAN SMILES:** 27-year-old RHP Jordan Lyles replaces RHP Bryan Mitchell in the starting rotation tonight vs. St. Louis to make his first start of the season.

- Has posted 10 scoreless outings in 13 appearances out of the Padres bullpen.
- His last start came on September 29th of last season at the San Francisco Giants.

**SOLID START:** Posted a 6.1-scoreless inning streak over his first four outings of the season, allowing just three hits and one walk while striking out eight from 3/31-4/6.

**OVER AND OUT:** Lyles has six appearances in which he has recorded over three outs and allowed zero earned runs, tied for the second-most such appearances.

- Teammate **Craig Stammen**, MIL's **Jeremy Jeffress** and LAD's **Ross Stripling** also have six such appearances, while MIL's **Josh Hader** leads the pack with seven.

**NO LONG BALLS FOR CHICKS TO DIG:** Has allowed just two home runs this season...is one of just 19 relievers this season who have tossed at least 19.2 IP and allowed two home runs or fewer.

- The Padres are the only bullpen to have three relievers who have thrown at least 19.2 IP and allowed fewer than two home runs (also, RHPs **Adam Cimber** and **Craig Stammen**).

**NO, NO, NO... NOT TODAY:** Is limiting opposing hitters to a .194 (14-for-72) average, the sixth-lowest average among relievers with at least 19.2 IP.

**QUOTABLE:** Jordan Lyles, yesterday, on what he has learned from being in the bullpen to start the season:

- *"One thing it taught me was being on the attack a little bit more... Sometimes as a starter you slow things down, process everything, go over previous at-bats. I definitely want to take the mentality of getting after it a little bit more and being on the attack."*

- Tomorrow will be his first career start at Petco Park.
- Earned his first career win in his last outing on 5/6 vs. LAD, tossing a career-high 6.0 IP of scoreless ball in Monterrey, Mexico...also struck out five and walked one in SD's 3-0 shutout win.
- Struck out a career-high seven on 4/30 at SF in his 5.0 IP of three-run ball.
