TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland's "magic number" to clinch its third consecutive American League Central title currently stands at five.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** has become the third CLE hitter with 30HR/30SB in a season, joining **Joe Carter** (1987) and **Grady Sizemore** (2008)...he is just the fourth different third baseman to achieve the feat, and the first since NYM's **David Wright** in 2007.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** has established a new career high in home runs (34), breaking his own club record for homers by a shortstop...he leads all Major Leaguers with 33 home runs and 83 RBI from the top spot of the batting order.

» **COREY KLUBER** threw 7.0 shutout innings on August 31 at Progressive Field in his first start of the season against Tampa Bay...he is tied with TB's **Blake Snell** for the Major League lead with 18 wins and is seeking to become the second player in Tribe history to lead MLB in wins for two consecutive seasons (**Bob Feller**, 1940-41).

RAYS 'EM UP

» Cleveland is set to conclude its six-game season series vs. Tampa Bay this week with a three-game set at Tropicana Field.

» In the clubs' first matchup at Progressive Field from August 31-September 2, the Rays won two out of three contests, narrowly outscoring the Tribe 11-10.

» The Tribe went 4-3 in their season series vs. Tampa Bay in 2017, going 1-2 at Progressive Field (May 15-17) and 3-1 at Tropicana Field (August 10-13)...Cleveland holds an all-time record of 94-60 (.610) against the Rays in a matchup that dates back to 1998.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians fell 6-2 in their series finale at Toronto, settling for a split in their four-game set...Cleveland finished the 2018 campaign with a 3-4 record vs. the Blue Jays.

» The Tribe scored both runs via solo homer...**FRANCISCO LINDOR** belted his 34th home run of the season with a solo shot in the top of the 3rd inning, marking a new single-season career high...**BRANDON BARNES** hit his first Major League homer since August 26, 2015 (with Colorado), cutting the Blue Jays' lead to 3-2 in the 7th inning.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** went 0-for-4 with a fielder's choice...stole second base in the top of the 1st inning to log his 30th stolen base of the year...**became the third player in franchise history to record a season with 30+ homers and 30+ steals, joining Joe Carter (1987) and Grady Sizemore (2008).**

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** took the loss in a quality start, allowing three runs on four hits over 6.0 innings of work...walked two batters and fanned nine, bringing his season total to 191 strikeouts (8th in American League).

GETTING CLOSER

» The Indians enter play tonight with a 15.5-game lead over second-place Minnesota in the A.L. Central...the club's "magic number" to clinch a third consecutive division title currently sits at 5.

» Cleveland has 81 wins this season, one shy of clinching their sixth straight season with a record above .500...**will mark the 5th-longest streak of winning seasons in franchise history.**

WELCOME BACK

» **LHP ANDREW MILLER** has been activated from the 10-day Disabled List...he had been on the D.L. since August 29 with a left shoulder impingement.

» In 10 appearances with Cleveland since the All-Star break, Miller has posted a 1.86 ERA (2ER/9.2IP), allowing just five hits and striking out 10 batters.

SPREAD THE WEALTH

» The Indians' 193 home runs this season (T4th in MLB) have been hit by 19 different players, with **BRANDON BARNES** becoming the most recent Tribe hitter to hit a homer in yesterday's contest.

» The Tribe ranks T4th in the A.L. in number of players with a home run, and their 19 such players are the most by the club since 20 different players homered for Cleveland in the 2012 season.

KLUBER DAY

» **COREY KLUBER** is pitching on regular four days' rest after making his last start on September 5 vs. Kansas City...**earned his 18th win of the season after holding the Royals to one run on just two hits over 6.2 dominant innings (1BB, 10K).**

» His 18 wins this season match a career high, done three other times (2014, 2016, 2017)...with a win tonight, he would become the first Tribe pitcher to win 19 games since **Cliff Lee** went 22-3 in his 2008 Cy Young Award campaign.

» Kluber is currently tied with Tampa Bay's **Blake Snell** for the Major League lead in wins...**he is seeking to become the second pitcher in franchise history to lead MLB in wins for two consecutive seasons (Bob Feller, 1940-41)**...Kluber's 54 wins since the start of 2016 are the most in MLB in that span, and the most by an Indians pitcher over a three-year stretch since **Gaylord Perry** won 64 games from 1972-1974.

» Owns a career 5-2 record with a 2.17 ERA (15ER/62.1IP) in nine career starts vs. Tampa Bay...**tossed 7.0 shutout innings on two hits (2BB, 8K) in his previous start against the Rays this season, which came on August 31 at Progressive Field.**

» Enters play tonight leading MLB with just 1.30 walks per 9.0 innings...Kluber ranks among American League leaders in innings pitched (1st, 193.1), WHIP (4th, 0.95), ERA (5th, 2.75), opponent batting average (T7th, .218) and strikeouts (9th, 190).

30/30 MAN

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** stole his 30th base of the season (T3rd in American League) in yesterday's loss, to go along with his 37 home runs (3rd in A.L.)...**Ramírez has joined Joe Carter (1987) and Grady Sizemore (2008) as the only players in franchise history to record a season with 30+ home runs and 30+ steals.**

» Ramírez is the first player in MLB to achieve the feat since 2012, when **Mike Trout** (LAA) and **Ryan Braun** (MIL) both did so.

» Additionally, Ramírez is just the fourth different third baseman in MLB history to collect a 30/30 season (sixth instance overall).

FRANKIE STRIKES AGAIN

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** established a new single-season career high with his 34th home run of the season yesterday...broke his own franchise record (33HR in 2017) for homers by a shortstop.

» **Marks the most home runs by a shortstop in a single season since Milwaukee's Bill Hall hit 35 in the 2006 campaign.**

» Lindor has hit 33 homers and driven in 83 runs from the top spot of the batting order, both of which lead MLB...he has tied **Grady Sizemore** (33 in 2008) for the club record in home runs from the top spot, and sits seven away from matching Sizemore's RBI record (90 in 2008) in that same category.

STRONG STARTERS

» Cleveland's starting rotation enters play tonight with a franchise-record 26 starts with 10-or-more strikeouts this year, tied with Houston for the most among Major League starting staffs.

» Tribe starting pitchers have recorded 956 strikeouts this season (2nd in MLB, Houston - 985) and have issued just 215 walks (4th-fewest in MLB)...**the rotation's collective 4.45 K/BB ratio is the highest in MLB and currently stands as the best mark by a rotation in MLB history.**

» The Indians currently boast four pitchers among the American League top 10 in both ERA and strikeouts.

TONIGHT'S START

» Kluber is scheduled to make his 30th start of the season in tonight's series opener at Tampa Bay...will also mark his 198th career appearance and 193rd start.

» Will be pitching tonight on regular four days' rest after making his last start on September 5 vs. Kansas City...fanned 10 batters in 6.2 innings, allowing one run on two hits, with one walk en route to his 18th win of the season.

» With a win tonight, Kluber would become the first Indians pitcher with 19-or-more wins in a season since **Cliff Lee** won 22 games in 2008, as well as the first Indians right-hander with 19 wins since **Roberto Hernández** in 2007 (19 wins).

» He is due to face the Rays for the second time this season, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings (2H, 2BB, 8K) en route to a win on August 31 at Progressive Field...owns a career 5-2 record and 2.17 ERA (15ER/62.1IP) in nine career starts against Tampa Bay.

» Kluber has walked just 28 batters in his 29 starts this season, which is the 3rd-fewest among qualified Major League starters this season, behind Texas' **Bartolo Colon** (24) and St. Louis' **Miles Mikolas**...**Kluber enters play today averaging 1.30 walks per 9.0 innings, the lowest rate in the Majors.**

» He has tossed 7.0-or-more innings in 18 starts this season, which is the most among all Major League starting pitchers...has also recorded quality starts in 23 of his outings, which leads the American League and is tied with Philadelphia's **Aaron Nola** for 3rd-most MLB, behind Washington's **Max Scherzer** (26) and New York-NL's **Jacob deGrom** (24).

» Kluber enters play today among the American League pitching leaders in walks-per-9.0IP (1st, 1.30), complete games (T1st, 2), wins (T1st, 18), innings pitched (1st, 193.1), ERA (5th, 2.75), opponent batting average (T7th, 2.18) and strikeouts (190, 9th).

VS. TAMPA BAY | A.L. EAST

» Kluber is due to face the Rays for the second time this season, after earning the win on August 31 at Progressive Field (7.0IP, 2H, 2BB, 8K)...owns a career 5-2 record and 2.17 ERA (15ER/62.1IP) in nine starts against Tampa Bay...his 2.17 career ERA vs. the Rays is his lowest mark against a single opponent (min. 50.0IP).

» Last pitched at Tropicana Field on August 13, 2017, holding the Rays to three runs on four hits (one home run), with two walks, a hit batter and nine strikeouts in 7.0 innings...has compiled a career 2-1 record and 3.38 ERA (11ER/29.1IP) in four starts in this ballpark.

» Tonight will mark Kluber's fifth start of the season against an opponent from the A.L. East, compiling a 3-1 record and 3.90 ERA (12ER/27.2IP) across his four prior starts.

18 WINS AND COUNTING

» Kluber enters play tonight with a career high-tying 18 wins (also, 2016-17), tied with Tampa Bay's **Blake Snell** for the Major League lead...with a win tonight, Kluber would become the first Indians pitcher with 19-or-more wins in a season since **Cliff Lee** won 22 games in 2008, as well as the first Indians right-hander with 19 wins since **Roberto Hernández** in 2007 (19 wins).

» Kluber has won 18 games each of the last three seasons (2016-), marking the first Indians pitcher with 18-or-more wins in three straight seasons since **Gaylord Perry** (1972-74)...also marked the fourth pitcher since 2000 to do so, alongside **Randy Johnson** (2000-02), **CC Sabathia** (2009-11) and **Justin Verlander** (2009-11). -STATS LLC

» He also looks to become the second Indians pitcher to lead MLB in wins consecutive seasons, after **Bob Feller** did so from 1940-41.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

» Kluber will make his 14th road start of the season in tonight's contest, compiling an 8-4 record and 3.67 ERA (34ER/83.1IP) across his 13 prior starts...he enters play tonight tied for 4th in the American League in road wins.

» Kluber has won four of his last five road starts, posting a 3.66 ERA (13ER/32.0IP) and striking out 29 batters combined across the outings.

K IS FOR KLUBER

» Kluber enters tonight's start with 190 strikeouts, 10 away from recording his fifth career season with 200-or-more punchouts...five 200+ strikeout seasons would tie him with **Bob Feller** (1938-46) for the 2nd-most such seasons by a pitcher in Indians franchise history, behind **Sam McDowell** (6, 1965-70)...would also mark his fifth consecutive season with 200+ strikeouts, which would be the 2nd-longest run in Tribe history.

AND THE SECOND HALF IS UNDERWAY

» Kluber is 6-2 with a 2.72 ERA (18ER/59.2IP) in nine second-half starts this season...entering play tonight, his second-half win total is tied for 2nd-best in MLB and his ERA is 6th-lowest in the American League (min. 50.0IP).

» He owns a 46-18 record and 2.88 ERA (184ER/575.1IP) in his career in the second half...his second-half ERA since the start of 2011 is 4th-lowest in MLB (min. 400.0IP), behind **Clayton Kershaw** (1.72), **Justin Verlander** (2.82) and **David Price** (2.85).

» Since the start of 2013, Kluber has gone 44-13 with a 2.55 ERA (144ER/508.0IP) in 74 second-half starts...in that span, he leads MLB in second-half wins and his second-half ERA is the 2nd-lowest mark (min. 200.0IP), behind LAD's **Clayton Kershaw** (1.72).

2018 RECAP & HIGHLIGHTS

» Kluber was named to the 2018 American League All-Star team, but did not pitch after receiving an injection in his right knee following his July 12 start vs. New York-AL...marked his third career All-Star selection (third consecutive).

» Had his career-long walkless innings streak snapped at 46.1 innings on June 15 vs. Minnesota, after issuing a free pass in the 4th inning...streak marked the longest such run by a Tribe pitcher since **Paul Byrd's** stretch of 48.0 innings from April 26-June 6, 2007...also had his quality start streak snapped at 14, the longest streak of quality starts to begin a season by a Tribe starting pitcher since Hall-of-Famer **Stan Coveleski** began the 1918 campaign with a string of 16 consecutive quality starts.

» From August 3, 2017 - June 15, 2018, Kluber recorded a string of 26 starts that marked the longest streak in American League history and tied with Philadelphia's **Chris Short** (also 26G from 1967-68) for the 2nd-longest such streak in the *Baseball-Reference Play Index* era (1908-), behind Chicago-NL's **Jake Arrieta** (29G from 2015-16).

» Tossed his 16th career complete game in his first start of the year on March 29 at Seattle...marked the first Opening Day complete game by a Cleveland pitcher since **Jake Westbrook** on April 4, 2005 at Chicago-AL (1-0 loss), and the first such complete game in MLB since **Clayton Kershaw** threw a complete-game shutout on April 1, 2013 vs. San Francisco...struck out eight batters, the 2nd-most by a Tribe starter on Opening Day over the last 14 seasons (2005-18), behind **Justin Masterson** (10K on April 5, 2012 vs. Toronto).
