## TODAY'S CONTEST

**LEADING OFF:** The Angels play their 10th of 33 Spring Training games today as the Club hosts the Colorado Rockies in Tempe...The starting pitching match-up is a rematch of the Feb. 27 meeting between these teams and features Angels RHP **Matt Shoemaker** against Colorado right-hander **Jon Gray**...Today's contest is the fifth of 15 scheduled Cactus League home games in Tempe.

**ANGELS/ROCKIES:** Today's contest is the second of four meetings this Spring between the Halos and Rockies...The Angels won the first contest by a 5-2 score on Feb. 27 at Salt River Fields...The teams will meet again on March 15 (Angels split squad at Salt River Fields) and March 16 (in Tempe)...The Clubs will also face off four times in the 2018 regular season (May 8-9 at Coors Field & Aug. 27-28 at Angel Stadium)...The Angels lead the all-time regular season series with Colorado 24-8 and have won each of the last nine regular season meetings.

**TV EXCLUSIVE:** Today's game will not have a local radio broadcast in Southern California and is being broadcast exclusively on television on Fox Sports West...KLAA AM830 will air the Anaheim Ducks game against the Chicago Blackhawks this afternoon.

**YESTERDAY'S RECAP:** Last night, the Angels were defeated by the Seattle Mariners by a 4-2 score at Peoria Stadium...**Martin Maldonado** hit his first home run of the Spring and INF **Matt Thaiss** added his second homer of Cactus League play for the Halos...LHP **Tyler Skaggs** made his second start of the Spring and allowed two earned runs in three innings of work.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Angels Minor League Pitchers and Catchers reported to Tempe yesterday...Position players will report on March 8 with the first full-squad workout set for March 10...Halos minor leaguers will play their first exhibition games on March 15 against the Cincinnati Reds.

**SHO-HALO:** RHP/DH **Shohei Ohtani** joins the Angels this season after spending the last five years with the Nippon-Ham Fighters of the Japanese Pacific League...The five-time NPB All-Star, was the 2016 Pacific League MVP and is a three-time winner of a "Best Nine Award" (twice as a pitcher and once at DH)...In 85 career games (82 starts) as a pitcher for the Fighters, he compiled a 42-15 record and 2.52 ERA (543 IP - 152 ER) with 624 strikeouts...In his five seasons at the plate, Ohtani has batted .286 (296/1035) with 70 doubles, four triples, 48 home runs and 166 RBI.

**MACHINE HISTORY:** **Albert Pujols** enters 2018 just 32 hits shy of becoming the 32nd member of the 3000 hit club...He will begin the year ranking seventh all-time in HR (614), eighth in RBI (1918), 10th in total bases (5461) and 12th in doubles (619).

**IN WITH THE NEW:** Angels General Manager **Billy Eppler** acquired several Major League veterans throughout the offseason who will contribute to the 2018 club...Angels kicked off the offseason by re-signing OF **Justin Upton** to a five-year deal...On Dec. 9 at Angel Stadium, the team introduced RHP/DH **Shohei Ohtani** after he signed a minor league deal to make the move from Japan to the Majors...The Club acquired four-time All-Star INF **Ian Kinsler** from Detroit on Dec. 13 and signed All-Star INF **Zack Cozart** on Dec. 15...The Angels also added veterans OF **Chris Young** and C **Rene Rivera** as free agent signings, acquired RHP **Jim Johnson** from Atlanta, RHP **Felix Peña** from Chicago (N.L.), OF **Jabari Blash** from New York (A.L.) and RHP **Luke Bard** in the Rule 5 Draft from Minnesota.

**IN THE DUGOUT:** Manager **Mike Scioscia** enters his 19th season at the helm of the Halos and is the longest tenured skipper in the Majors...New additions to the staff include former Angels catcher **Josh Paul** as Bench Coach and **Eric Hinske** as Hitting Coach...**Dino Ebel** returns to the role of Third Base Coach after spending the last three seasons as the Angels Bench Coach (he previously served as the Third Base Coach for eight seasons starting in 2005)...Also returning to Scioscia's staff in 2018, are: **Charles Nagy** (Pitching Coach), **Alfredo Griffin** (First Base Coach), **Paul Sorrento** (Assistant Hitting coach), **Scott Radinsky** (Bullpen Coach), **Tom Gregorio** (Bullpen Catcher), **Anel De Los Santos** (Bullpen Catcher) and **Steve Soliz** (Catching & Information Coach).

**OPENING DAY NOTES:** The Halos will square off with the Oakland Athletics on Opening Day (Oakland Coliseum - March 29)...Marks second consecutive Opening Day meeting and sixth overall between Angels and A's...Last season, Oakland won Opening Day meeting by a 4-2 score at the Coliseum...Angels are 2-3 all-time vs. Oakland on Opening Day...Mike Trout has homered on Opening Day three of the last four years...Since 2004, Angels are 9-5 on Opening Day, but have lost the opener in each of the last four seasons after winning a franchise record five straight Opening Day games from 2009-13.

## TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER - RHP MATT SHOEMAKER

2017 REGULAR SEASON: 6-3, 4.52 ERA

- Today's game marks second appearance of the Spring, both coming as starts vs. Colorado...Entering sixth Major League season with Angels.
- Made 14 starts for Angels last season, going 6-3 with a 4.52 ERA (77.2 IP - 39 ER)...Recorded 69 strikeouts while walking 28.
- Suffered a right forearm strain on June 14 vs. New York (A.L.) and missed remainder of season on disabled list.
- Last season, went 6-0 with a 3.56 ERA (52.2 IP - 18 ER) in night games, compared with a 0-3 record and 6.95 ERA (22 IP - 17 ER) in day games.
- VS. COLORADO:** Earned the win in first start this Spring vs. Rockies on Feb. 27 in Scottsdale after allowing one earned run in 2.1 innings of work...Only run allowed came on solo HR by Mike Tauchman...Did not factor in decision in only previous regular season start vs. Rockies on July 8, 2015 at Coors Field...Tossed 5.2 innings and allowed two earned runs on nine hits with two walks (one IBB) and two strikeouts.
- In 94 career games (86 starts) for Angels is 38-30 with a 3.87 ERA (514 IP - 221 ER) and 457 strikeouts.
- Originally signed by Angels as a non-drafted free agent on Aug. 14, 2008.
- Native of Wyandotte, MI and attended Eastern Michigan University.

## 2017 IN REVIEW

The Angels completed 2017 with an 80-82 mark, in second place in the A.L. West (-21.0)...LAA finished under .500 in consecutive full seasons for first time since 1992-93 and a sub .500 record for just fourth time in last 14 seasons...Club was not eliminated from playoff contention until Game #158 (finished 5.0 games back of Wild Card)...LAA was 39-37 against A.L. West, 11-23 vs. A.L. Central, 19-13 vs. A.L. East and 11-9 against National League opponents...Angels' 47 comeback wins led MLB (also tied Club record set in 2009)...Halos also set a Club record and paced the MLB with 10 comeback victories when trailing by four or more runs...**Albert Pujols** became ninth player in MLB history to hit 600 home runs and also reached 100 RBI for 14th time in career...SS **Andrelton Simmons** and C **Martin Maldonado** were named winners of 2017 A.L. Gold Glove Awards and Wilson Defensive Player of the Year Awards, while OF **Justin Upton** earned a Silver Slugger Award...RHP **Parker Bridwell** led A.L. rookies with 10 wins...Bullpen led MLB and set a team record with 36 relief wins...Club led MLB with 136 stolen bases...Angels reached the three million mark in home attendance (3,019,585) for the 15th consecutive season.

## THIS 'N' THAT

**BROADCAST INFO:** In 2018, the Angels will have 31 Spring Training games airing on television, with Fox Sports West carrying 26 games, Prime Ticket televising four games and KCOP airing one game...The games will also be available for live streaming via FOX Sports GO via mobile, tablet and connected devices...**Terry Smith** and **Jose Mota** will team up to call the action from Arizona...Immediately following game coverage, "Angels Live" will offer a post-game recap with **Kent French** who will rotate at the host position with **Patrick O'Neal** and **Mota** throughout the schedule to lead discussions alongside Analyst **Mark Gubicza** and **Mota**...When the Angels return to Southern California on March 25 for their final three exhibition games, **Victor Rojas** will take over television play-by-play duties alongside Gubicza as the pair begin their ninth season together as the Angels television announcing team...**Alex Curry** will report throughout the Freeway Series.

**TEMPE TRADITION:** 2018 represents the Angels' 26th Spring Training campaign in Tempe, AZ (since 1993)...Tempe Diablo Stadium is the oldest ballpark in the Cactus League...Halos have drawn over 100,000 fans to Tempe Diablo Stadium in 12 of the last 14 seasons...LAA set a franchise Spring Training home attendance record in 2012, attracting 130,126 fans to Tempe Diablo Stadium.

### HISTORY OF TEMPE DIABLO STADIUM

Tempe Diablo Stadium (1968) is now the oldest ballpark in the Cactus League after Oakland moved out of Phoenix Municipal Stadium (1964) following the 2014 season. The ballpark originally hosted the expansion Seattle Pilots in 1969. The Pilots became the Milwaukee Brewers at the end of the 1970 Spring season. The Brewers played at Diablo through 1972 before moving to Sun City. The ballpark sat empty for four years before another expansion team, the Seattle Mariners, arrived in 1977. The Mariners left after the 1992 season for a new ballpark in Peoria. The Angels moved their spring camp from Palm Springs to Tempe in 1993. Diablo Stadium underwent renovations in 1992 and 2006.
