TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Indians' 32-28 record through 60 games sits one game ahead of the 102-win 2017 club (31-29)...Cleveland is the only divisional leader in MLB with a lead larger than 1.0 game, as they enter play tonight with a 4.0-game lead over second-place Detroit.

» **TREVOR BAUER** enters tonight's start with 10-or-more strikeouts in each of last two starts, as well as three of his last four...in his last start at Detroit on May 16, Bauer tossed 8.0 shutout innings, allowing just four hits while striking out 10 batters.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** has collected at least one extra-base hit in eight of his last 12 games (5 HR, 5 2B)...his 38 extra-base hits this season are the most in MLB and rank T2nd in franchise history through 60 team games.

WEDNESDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians finished off their brief homestand with a two-game sweep of Milwaukee, winning the finale 3-1...the victory improved the Tribe to 6-2 in Interleague play this season, as well as 20-11 at Progressive Field (4th-best home record in MLB).

» Trailing 1-0 through 4.0 innings, the Indians sent all nine men to the plate in the bottom of the 5th, scoring all three of their runs...**MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (2-4) tied the score at 1-1 with an RBI-single, followed by a **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** RBI-double that gave Cleveland the lead...**YONDER ALONSO** capped the rally by drawing a bases-loaded walk.

» **RAJAI DAVIS** went 2-for-3 and stole three bases, the most in a single game by an Indians player since Davis and **Ramírez** each did so on August 12, 2016 vs. Los Angeles-AL.

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** earned his 7th win of the season, allowing just one run over 7.0 strong innings...scattered eight hits and one walk while fanning 10 batters, his second double-digit strikeout performance of 2018 (also did so on May 9 at Milwaukee)...**CODY ALLEN** struck out three batters across 1.1 scoreless innings, collecting his second save in as many games.

MOTOWN MATCHUP

» The Indians and Tigers are set to begin the third of six scheduled series between the clubs tonight, including their second set at Comerica Park.

» The Tribe owns a 5-2 record against the Tigers through seven matchups...the teams first met from April 9-12 at Progressive Field, where Cleveland recorded a four-game sweep, outscoring Detroit 18-5...the Tigers took two of three contests in Detroit from May 14-16, snapping an 11-game losing streak vs. the Indians.

» Cleveland has gone 14-3 over its last five series vs. Detroit (dating back to July 7, 2017), allowing three-or-fewer runs in all 14 of their wins...over that span, Tribe pitching has posted a 1.97 ERA (33ER/151.0IP).

» The Indians own an overall franchise record of 1089-1120 (.493) against the Tigers in a 118-year-old rivalry (1901)...the two clubs have combined for six of the last seven A.L. Central division titles.

CENTRAL FOCUS

» Tonight's contest at Detroit marks the first of 16 consecutive scheduled games for the Indians against A.L. Central opponents, the club's longest divisional stretch of the season...with the exception of the team's recent two-game set vs. Milwaukee, 23 of the Tribe's 25 contests from May 28 - June 20 are set to come against divisional opponents.

» Cleveland has gone 14-8 thus far against the A.L. Central, going 4-2-1 across seven series...the Tribe is 3-6 in divisional road games, compared to 11-2 at Progressive Field.

SCORE TACTICS

» The Indians enter play tonight with 297 runs scored, 4th-most in the American League (6th in MLB)...their 195 runs since May 1 are the most in MLB.

» Cleveland also ranks 3rd in MLB this season with 89 longballs, trailing only New York-AL (98) and Boston (93)...the Indians and Yankees are the only MLB teams boasting five players with 10-or-more home runs.

» The Tribe also places among MLB leaders with a .442 team slugging percentage (3rd), 212 extra-base hits (4th), a .764 team OPS (4th) and 118 doubles (T7th).

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1965: The Indians draft **Ray Fosse** with the 7th overall pick in the 1965 Amateur Draft, making him the first catcher drafted by Cleveland in the 1st round...Fosse spent parts of eight seasons (1967-72, 1976-77) with the Tribe, batting .269 with 50 homers and 230 RBI...Cleveland selected catcher **Noah Naylor** with the 29th overall pick on Monday evening, joining Fosse, **Rick Cerone** and **Tim Glass** as the Indians' only 1st-round backstops.
