## NATIONALS NEWS

### MOVING ON...

The Washington Nationals dropped the series opener against the Pittsburgh Pirates, 6-3, despite solo home runs from left-fielder **Juan Soto** and center-fielder **Bryce Harper**, as well as a 3-for-3 performance from right-fielder **Adam Eaton**.

- After a three-game sweep of the Cincinnati Reds to open up the season and a four-game sweep of the Pirates at Nationals Park in May, the loss against the Pirates marked just the first loss of the season for the Nationals against a National League Central team.

### ROSTER MOVE

The Nationals recalled right-handed pitchers **Wander Suero** and **Austin Voth** from Triple-A Syracuse on Tuesday, placed left-handed pitcher **Sean Doolittle** on the 10-day disabled list with left-toe inflammation and optioned right-handed pitcher **Jefry Rodriguez** to Triple-A Syracuse.

### SUMMER OF SOTO

Last night, **Juan Soto** blasted his ninth home run of the season, a line drive to right field in the fifth inning... Soto leads all MLB rookies (min. 180 PA), in batting average (.301), on-base percentage (.415), and OPS (.964)...His .549 slugging percentage is second behind NYY **Gleyber Torres** (.555)...Though he was called up on May 20, he ranks among NL rookies in walks (3rd, 30), HR (3rd, 9), doubles (T5th, 11) and RBI (6th, 27).

- Since May 15 (the date of his "first" game due to the suspended game vs. NYY), he leads National League rookies in walks (1st, 30), home runs (1st, 9), doubles (T2nd, 11), and RBI (1st, 27).
- Among all National League players (min. 180 PA), Soto ranks in on-base percentage (2nd, .415), OPS (5th, .964) and slugging (9th, .549).

### HARPER'S HOMERS

**Bryce Harper** clubbed his 22nd home run last night, a solo shot in the sixth inning...Harper's 22 home runs rank tied for second-most in the National League with COL **Nolan Arenado** (22) and behind MIL **Jesus Aguilar** (23).

- Harper's 36 extra-base hits rank tied for second among National League outfielders with ARI **David Peralta** (36) and PIT **Gregory Polanco** (36) and trailing only ATL **Nick Markakis** (38).

### VOTE FOR TREA!

Shortstop **Trea Turner** was named one of five candidates for the National League Final Vote to the All-Star Game...Fans can cast their votes from now through Wednesday at 4:00 p.m. by visiting Nationals.com or MLB.com...The winners of the Final Vote will be announced live on MLB Network on Wednesday at 8:00 p.m. ET.

- Washington's come-from-behind win on Thursday night was powered by Turner, who went 3-for-5 with two home runs (including the go-ahead grand slam), eight RBI and three runs scored...His eight RBI were tied for the most by a leadoff hitter in Major League history and were tied for second-most in a game by any hitter in Nationals history (2005-pres.).
- Over his last 20 games, **Trea Turner** is 28-for-83 (.337) with one double, one triple, four homers, 12 RBI, six walks, two stolen bases and 17 runs scored...He has a .389 on-base percentage and a .518 slugging percentage during this stretch.
- Turner ranks ninth among National League shortstops in Wins Above Replacement (3.0), according to FanGraphs.com...He is hitting .275 with 14 doubles, two triples, 11 home runs, 37 RBI, 40 walks, 22 stolen bases and 54 runs scored in 90 games...His 22 stolen bases rank tied for fourth in Major League Baseball.

### BIG CITY IS HEATING UP

Infielder **Matt Adams** is 8-for-19 (.421) with one double, one walk and five runs scored in five games since returning from the disabled list on July 4...Adams collected four hits in his first game back on July 5 against the Marlins marking a season-high and matching a career-high...Prior to being placed on the disabled list, Adams hit .275 with seven doubles, 13 home runs, 36 RBI, 16 walks and 24 runs scored in 57 games...The Nationals went 26-12 in his 38 starts prior to the injury.

- From April 25 to June 16, Adams ranked third in the National League with 11 home runs and was tied for seventh with 32 RBI over this span.
- On the season, he ranked just outside of the top 10 in the National League with 13 home runs when he was placed on the disabled list on June 16.

### MIGHTY EATON

Over his last nine games outfielder **Adam Eaton** is 12-for-33 (.364) with one double, five walks, one stolen base and two runs scored...He has a .447 on-base percentage during this stretch...On the season Eaton has a .312 batting average (34-for-109) in 32 games.

### EXTRA! EXTRA!

Since June 15, **Anthony Rendon's** 17 extra-base hits are third-most in MLB behind STL **Matt Carpenter** (18) and HOU **Alex Bregman** (18)...On the season, Rendon is tied for 11th in the National League with 37 extra base hits...His 25 doubles rank fourth in the National League.

## NATIONALS HISTORY

### July 10 (3-6 on this date)

2008 - **Wily Mo Pena** somehow recorded 11 putouts to establish a Nationals (2005-pres.) single-game record for outfielders in an 11-inning 7-5 setback vs. ARI.

2013 - **Anthony Rendon** and **Wilson Ramos** hit back-to-back solo shots in the fifth inning, then **Ryan Zimmerman** and **Jayson Werth** did the same in the sixth, as the Nationals powered past the Phillies for a 5-1 road win. The Nationals hit at least four home runs for the 9th time in 2013.

## OPPONENT

### PITTSBURGH PIRATES

Former National **Felipe Vázquez** (formerly Rivero) now pitches out of Pittsburgh's bullpen...In the late 1930s and early 40s, the Negro League's Homestead Grays played their home games at Forbes Field in Pittsburgh, but also scheduled games in D.C. at their alternate home, Griffith Stadium.

### THE SERIES

The Nationals and Pirates will play seven times in 2018...Washington dropped the season series (3-4) in 2017 for the first time since 2013...The Nationals have won six of the last eight matchups and since May 24, 2014, Washington is 19-10 against Pittsburgh.

## DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

## #58 - JEREMY HELLICKSON - RHP

A veteran of eight Major League seasons joined the Nationals on a Minor League deal with an invite to Major League Spring Training in mid-March... Was the 2011 American League Rookie of the Year for Tampa Bay...Took home the Gold Glove in 2012...Has made more than 27 starts in six of his eight Major League seasons...Pitched for Tampa Bay from 2010-14 while Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** served as the club's bench coach.

**AGAINST THE PIRATES:** Makes his seventh career start against the Pirates, his second of the 2018 season...Is 3-1 with a 2.38 ERA in six previous starts against Pittsburgh.

**LAST START:** He did not factor into the decision after tossing 4.0 innings and allowing a season-high nine hits and eight earned runs while striking out two and walking one in Washington's come-from-behind 14-12 win over the Miami Marlins on July 5.

### 2018 NOTES

- Has issued just nine walks this season, fewest among MLB pitchers with at least 10 starts this season...His seven home runs allowed are tied for the ninth-fewest in the NL (min. 10 GS).
- Was reinstated from the 10-day disabled list on June 30...Injured his right hamstring after recording one out on June 3 at Atlanta.
- Prior to his injury suffered on June 3 at Atlanta, allowed just four earned runs in 27.2 innings spanning his five previous starts (1.30 ERA)...He fanned 25 batters, walked two, and opposing batters were just 19-for-75 (.200) against him.
- At the time of his injury, he ranked (among pitchers with at least eight starts) eighth in the National League with a 2.30 ERA...He also ranked among National League pitchers (min. 8 GS) in opp. OBP (4th, .261), WHIP (2nd, 0.93), walks per 9.0 IP (2nd, 1.26), and strikeout-to-walk ratio (6th, 5.67).
- Has allowed two earned runs or fewer in seven of his eight starts prior to his injury...Allowed one earned run or fewer in four of the eight.
- Was again efficient in 5.0 innings of work on May 29 at Baltimore...Allowed two earned runs on six hits...Earned his second win of the season and the Nationals improved to 6-2 in his starts, including five straight wins.
- Allowed one earned run for the second consecutive start on May 22 vs. San Diego...Allowed five hits, struck out five batters and issued just one walk in 5.1 innings of work...Did not factor in the decision as the Nationals walked-off the Padres.
- Allowed just one earned run on three hits in 5.0 innings of work in his second start of the season against the Diamondbacks on May 13...He struck out five batters while walking just one.
- On May 8 at San Diego, he took a perfect game into the seventh inning to earn his first win of the season...A single by **Franchy Cordero** in the seventh inning broke up the bid...Tossed 6.2 scoreless innings, giving up just two hits and striking out a season-high eight batters.
- Tossed 5.2 scoreless innings on May 3 against Pittsburgh to help Washington complete the four-game sweep...Surrendered just three hits while striking out four...Did not issue a walk.
- In his third start for the Nationals allowed two earned runs on five hits in 5.1 innings of work as Washington fell to Arizona, 4-3, on April 28...Both earned runs came via the home run.
- Allowed three earned runs on three hits in 5.2 innings on April 22 at LAD...Did not factor in the decision as the Dodgers took the lead in the 7th inn.
- Made his Nationals debut on April 16 at NYM...Allowed two earned runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings in Washington's 8-6 victory.
