**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants and Mets conclude their three-game series today... **RHP Chris Stratton** will duel Mets RHP Noah Syndergaard in the series finale, with each team having won three times in the seven-game season series.

**GIANTS ROSTER MOVE:** The Giants made the following roster move prior to today's game: **IF Kelby Tomlinson** (#37) has been recalled from triple-A Sacramento...the Giants now have 27 active players on their roster (13 pitchers, two catchers, seven infielders and five outfielders).

**STARTING STRONG:** Giants starting pitchers have each allowed three runs or fewer in 11 of their last 12 games, posting a combined ERA of 1.51 (13er, 77.2ip) and a .185 opponents average against...the starting staff has combined for a 0.97 ERA (5er, 46.1ip) in their last seven games.

**GOING EXTRA:** Yesterday's game was the Giants' 19th this season that went extra innings, the most in the Majors...SF is 10-9 this season in extra-innings.

**GIANT SHUTOUTS:** SF's 13 shutout wins are tied with the Red Sox for the fourth-most in MLB behind the Cubs (15), Indians (14) and Pirates (14).

**SOLID PITCHING:** Beginning June 1, Giants pitchers have posted a 3.24 ERA, which ranks as the best figure in the Majors (Dodgers are second with a 3.31 ERA).

**WINNING BY ONE:** The Giants' 24 one-run victories this season are tied with Tampa Bay for the fourth-most in the Majors behind Seattle (33), Oakland (27) and Milwaukee (27)...SF has played a total of 48 games decided by one run or fewer, the third-most in MLB behind Tampa Bay (52) and Seattle (51).

**SCORE AT LEAST FOUR:** San Francisco is 19-53 (.264) when scoring three runs or fewer compared to 49-16 (.754) when plating four-or-more runs.

**ON DECK:** Following today's game the Giants will embark on a six-game, two-city road trip to Denver and Milwaukee...the Giants are 5-8 against the Rockies this season, going 1-5 at Coors Field...SF lost three of four to the Brewers at the end of July...they are 8-5 against the Brew Crew at Miller Park since 2014.

**GIANTS BULLPEN LAST 10 GAMES:** 1.75 ERA (5er, 25.2ip), .204 average against, 28 strikeouts, nine walks allowed and 4-for-5 in save chances.

**FOR WHAT'S IT'S WORTH:** The Giants are 15-7 (.682) on Sunday, their best winning percentage for any day of the week.

**HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE:** SF has the fourth-best home winning percentage in the NL this season at .574 (39-29)...only the Cubs (.647, 44-24), Phillies (.632, 43-25) and Brewers (.606, 40-26) have a better home record than the Giants.

**CLOSE CALLS:** The Giants have played 76 games this season that have been decided by just two runs or fewer, the most in MLB (SF is 38-38 in such games).

**WITH THE BATS:** Beginning Aug. 1, the Giants rank last among MLB teams in OPS (.584), home runs (16), batting average (.212) and runs per game (3.36).

**HITTING WITH RUNNERS IN SCORING POSITION:** San Francisco is hitting just .213 (29-for-136) with runners in scoring position in their last 20 games.

**CATCH ME IF YOU CAN:** The Giants have been successful in their last 12 stolen bases attempts.

#### This Date in Giants History: September 2, 2011

The Giants defeated the Diamondbacks by a 6-2 count...**Carlos Beltran** went 4-for-4 with a homer and **Cody Ross** homered as well while **Matt Cain** outdueled Joe Saunders...the win pulled San Francisco to within 5.0 games of Arizona.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#34 RHP Chris Stratton**  
**6-2, 211, 28 years old (August 22, 1990)**  
**9-7 Record, 4.99 ERA**

- The 28-year-old right-hander is making his 23rd appearance (22nd start) of the season...was recalled from double-A Richmond Aug. 21, the second time he's been recalled in 2018.
- Since his most recent recall from the minors, he's made two starts with the Giants, going 1-0 with a 1.26 ERA (2er, 14.1ip) and .216 opponents average against.
- His career-high of nine wins are the most on the Giants' starting staff.
- Is coming off one of the best starts of his career in a 2-0 win against the Diamondbacks this past Monday...logged a career-high 8.0 innings while throwing a career-best 117 pitches...allowed just five hits.
- Stratton's changeup was really good in his last start against Arizona...he threw 17 of 21 for strikes, got eight outs and allowed only one baserunner (the triple)...the eight outs was a career-high (previous high was four)...18% changeup usage was also a career high (Baseball Info Solutions).
- Was optioned to triple-A following his start Aug. 3 after he allowed six runs on 10 hits in 3.0 innings at Arizona.
- Former Giants All-Star **Ryan Vogelsong**, now a part-time roving instructor in the minors, worked with Stratton when he was sent back to triple-A...Stratton was rotating too much with his delivery, causing his fastball to flatten out and cut back over the heart of the plate.
- Faced the Mets in New York just 13 days ago and did not factor into the decision of a 6-3 Giants loss...threw 6.1 innings while allowing two runs on six hits...that was his first career start against New York-NL.
- Went 3-0 with a 3.00 ERA (8er, 24.0ip) in four starts at triple-A Sacramento.
- Drafted by the Giants in the first round (20th overall) in the 2012 draft out of Mississippi State University...since making his MLB debut in 2016, the Giants have gone 18-13 (.581) in his starting assignments.

**Last HR: 7/21/18 at OAK (off RHP Trevor Cahill)...AB's since last HR: 73...Career HRs: 112**

- Is just 7-for-his-last-50 (.140) and is 10-for-58 (.172) since coming off the DL on Aug. 14.
- Went 2x4 with a double, triple and two RBI on Aug. 31 vs. New York, his first game with multiple extra-base hits since May 18 vs. Colorado...was also his first multi-RBI game since July 7 vs. STL...has four extra-base hits (two doubles, one, triple, one home run) over his last 26 games.
- Missed 17 games with a hyperextended right knee and was reinstated from the 10-day DL on Aug. 14.
