FISH BITES

Miami begins its final road trip of the year with a three-game series at Washington. Following Thursday's off day, will wrap up the season with a three-game set at the Mets. Are scheduled to play a makeup game at Pittsburgh on Monday, October 1. The Marlins completed their final homestand of the season, going 4-2 after splitting a two-game series vs. Washington and taking three of four from Cincinnati.

- **RHP Sandy Alcantara** is making his fifth start of the season, and his career, and second straight against the Nationals. Allowed three runs on six hits in 4.0 ip last Tuesday at Marlins Park in a 4-2 loss - his first career defeat. Is facing off against RHP Stephen Strasburg who has gone 17-7 with a 3.04 ERA in 30 starts vs. the Marlins and has won his last eight starts against Miami dating back to September 20, 2015.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Marlins recorded their 12th shutout of the season, defeating the Reds, 6-0. **RHP Trevor Richards** tossed 7.0 shutout innings and held Cincinnati to three hits with nine strikeouts. **C Chad Wallach** had a career-high three hits, including his first career homer - a three-run shot in the third inning. **SS JT Riddle** (2x5), **3B Brian Anderson** (3x4), **CF Lewis Brinson** (2x4), and **OF Magneuris Sierra** (2x3) each recorded multi-hit games as well.

SHUTOUT SHOUTOUT

The Marlins recorded their 12th shutout of the season yesterday vs. Cincinnati. Is five more shutouts than all of last season and is tied for the 7th-most in a single season in Club history (most since recording 12 shutouts in both 2015 and '16).

- Marlins pitchers held opponents to one or no runs 21 times at home this season. Among NL clubs, only Pittsburgh's pitching staff has recorded more such games (22).

FOR STARTERS

Marlins starters have not allowed a run in the team's last three games (Friday: Wei-Yin Chen - 7.0ip, 3h, 0bb, 8k; Saturday: Jose Urena - 5.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 2k; Sunday: Trevor Richards - 7.0ip, 3h, 1bb, 9k), and currently have a 21.2 inning scoreless stretch dating back to Thursday. Last had three straight games without allowing a run from July 25-27, 2016 vs. Philadelphia (Jared Cosart - 5.0ip, 3h, 1bb, 3k; Tom Koehler - 6.0ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k; Adam Conley - 6.2ip, 8h, 3bb, 6k).

REASON TO CELEBRATE HERITAGE

With Miami's shutout yesterday on Mexican Heritage Day at Marlins Park, the Marlins improved to 7-1 on heritage celebration days this season. The only loss came on Colombian Heritage night on July 27, when the Marlins dropped a 9-1 decision to the Nationals.

HOME IMPROVEMENTS

Over their final 53 home games beginning June 8, Miami went 28-25. This after beginning the year 10-18 over the first 28 games at Marlins Park. The Marlins posted a 3.33 ERA (503.0 ip/186 er) over the stretch, which is the fourth-best among Major League teams behind the Rays (2.72), Dodgers (2.99) and Giants (3.18).

VS. THE NATIONALS

The Marlins and Nationals are squaring off in a three-game series at Nationals Park beginning tonight. After dropping eight of the first nine games of the season series, Miami has taken five of the last seven to run close the gap at 6-10. The two teams met last Monday and Tuesday at Marlins Park, splitting a two-game series. Miami is 3-4 at Nationals Park this season, and 57-69 all-time in D.C. The overall series belongs to Miami, including a 128-126 mark since 2005.

- The Marlins have hit .276 and scored 78 runs against the Nats this season, their highest offensive marks against any team this season.

SIX F's OF FIELDING

The Marlins ave committed just 80 errors this season, fifth fewest among National League clubs. Marks the fourth-fewest errors in Club history. Only the 2017 (73), 2015 (77) and 2003 (78) teams committed fewer errors. Miami's current .986 fielding pct. would go down as the fourth-highest in Franchise history, behind 2017 (.988), 2015 (.987) and 2003 (.987).

ALL AROUND ANDY

Brian Anderson leads all Major League rookies in games (151), at-bats (571), runs (85), and average with RISP (.359); ranks second in hits (155), doubles (32), walks (60), multi-hit games (44), and on-base percentage (.355); ranks third in average (.271) and slugging (.394); ranks tied for fourth in triples (4); and ranks fifth in RBI (60).

- His 155 hits are the most by a Marlins rookie since Gaby Sanchez in 2010 (156); His 85 runs are fourth-most all time among Marlins rookies behind Hanley Ramirez (119 in 2006), Dan Uggla (105 in 2006) and Quilvio Veras (86 in 1995); His avg. with RISP currently ranks as the third-best in club history behind Miguel Cabrera (2003) at .375 and Kevin Millar (1999) at .367.

LEARN: TO TAKE INSTRUCTION

The Marlins' 2018 Instructional League team will host the Washington Nationals Instructional League team at Marlins Park on Wednesday at 1:10 p.m. **The event is not open to the public, but is open to the media.** Miami's Instructional League roster includes several of the Marlins' top prospects, including OF **Connor Scott** (Marlins No. 4 prospect, per MLB.com; 2018 1st round pick); RHP **Jorge Guzman** (No. 5; 2017 trade acquisition); RHP **Edward Cabrera** (No. 6; international free agent); C **Will Banfield** (No. 7; 2018 Competitive Balance Round B); INF **Jose Devers** (No. 12; 2017 trade acquisition); INF **Osiris Johnson** (No. 13; 2018 2nd round); and OF **Tristan Pompey** (No. 15; 2018 3rd round).

A LOOK AHEAD TO '19

The Marlins will open 2019 Spring Training with pitchers and catchers reporting to Jupiter on Feb. 13. The first full squad workout is scheduled for Feb. 18, and the first game is slated for Sat., Feb. 23 against the Cardinals. The Marlins will open their 2019 regular season campaign at home on Thur., March 28 vs. Colorado at 4:10 p.m. Miami's first homestand will run March 28-April 3, with the Rockies (March 28-31) and Mets (April 1-3) visiting Marlins Park. The Marlins will face off against the American League Central during Interleague Play in 2019, playing host to Cleveland (April 30-May 1), Minnesota (July 30-August 1), and Kansas City (September 6-8), and traveling to Cleveland (April 23-24), Detroit (May 21-13), and the White Sox (July 22-24).
