THE PENULTIMATE ROAD SERIES: The Padres fell 14-0 yesterday afternoon to the Los Angeles Dodgers, dropping their final game in Chavez Ravine this season...starter **Joey Lucchesi** was saddled with the loss (now 8-9) in his first-career appearance @ Dodger Stadium, working just 3.2 innings of 7-hit and 7-run ball with 3 home runs allowed...the Padres bullpen conceded 7 earned runs, which were the most since Sept. 7 @ CIN (8 er), and it was the 5th time this season in which Padres relievers allowed 7+ earned runs in game...at the plate, **Wil Myers** added his 23rd double of the season.

THE FINAL ROAD SERIES: San Diego has yet to win the 1st game of a series vs. SF in 2018, with the last win to lead off a series coming on July 20, 2017 @ SF...the Padres have a 2-5 record @ AT&T Park this season, following last year's 6-4 record.

AT&T SUBSCRIBED: Since the inception of the 2017 season, the Padres have hit 18 homers and logged 159 hits, the most HR and hits @ AT&T of any visiting team.

JOVEN OUTFIELD HOMERS: San Diego rookie outfielders have combined to hit 23 home runs thus far in 2018 (16 from **Franmil Reyes** and 7 from **Franchy Cordero**), a mark which ties with WSH for the 3rd-most of any NL team (behind MIA and ATL's 38)...the Giants, meanwhile, have seen 4 rookie homers via an outfielder this year.

AND ON MONDAYS, WE MITCHELL: The Padres have won 2 of the last 3 starts made by **Bryan Mitchell**, in which he's owned 3.38 ERA (6 er, 16.0 ip) and a .250 opponent clip...he made his 1st appearance vs. SF earlier this season on April 12 in SD, and in 2 appearances (both starts), he is 0-2 opposite the Giants with a 7.88 ERA (7 er, 8.0 ip).

THE YEAR OF THE ROOKIES: **Bryan Mitchell** will make his 11th start this season, and it'll be the 93rd start by a non-rookie Padre...the 64 starts by rookies this season for SD are 3rd in the majors, trailing just TB (67) and MIA (69)...SD rookie starters have worked 307.2 innings and in 2017, they made just 27 starts and worked just 136.0 innings.

HR HUNTER: **Hunter Renfro**'s 8 HR in September tie for the Major League lead this month (also NYM's Michael Conforto and CWS's Daniel Palka), and his 17 HR since the beginning of August tie with MIL's Christian Yelich for the ML-lead.

GET IT, GET OUT: Padres relievers have used an average of 16.2 pitches per inning this season, which are the 2nd-fewest in the National League behind WHS's 16.0 p/ip...they've done this while also working the most innings of any NL club (605.0 ip).

TREVOR HOFFMAN WAY: Today, The San Diego City Council approved the renaming of a street outside Petco Park in honor of Padres legend and Hall of Fame closer **Trevor Hoffman**...the stretch of Park Boulevard between Imperial Avenue and Tony Gwynn Drive will be officially changed to **Trevor Hoffman Way** on Friday, Sept. 28, prior to the final home stand of the 2018 season vs Arizona.

THIS DATE IN PADRES HISTORY: On Sept. 24, 1971, RHP **Clay Kirby** pitched 15.0 innings in a 2-1, 21-inning loss vs. HOU in the 1st game of a doubleheader @ San Diego Stadium....Kirby allowed 1 run on 8 hits and 3 walks with 15 strikeouts, setting individual Padres records that still stand for IP in a game and SO in an extra-inning game...the 21-inning marathon remains the 2nd-longest in Padres history by innings, and the Padres and Astros played a total of 30 innings (a Padres' record for a doubleheader) in 7 hours and 40 minutes with the Padres winning the 2nd game 5-4...on Sept. 24, 1997, **Tony Gwynn** collected his 219th and 220th hits of the season, establishing a single-season Padres' record, and on Sept. 24, 2006, **Trevor Hoffman** passed Lee Smith as the all-time saves leader with No. 479.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#50 RHP Bryan Mitchell (1-4, 6.16)

BRYAN'S TURN: 27-year-old RHP Bryan Mitchell is set to make his 11th start of the season tonight to begin this three-game set against the Giants...it will be his second consecutive start against San Francisco...has faced the Giants twice this season (and in his career) and is a combined 0-2 with a 7.88 ERA against the Bay Area foe.

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed 5.0 IP of four-run ball in his last outing on 9/17 vs. SF and was tagged with the loss... did not allow a walk in a start for just the third time in his career...it was the first time he has not issued a free pass in a start that lasted at least 3.0 innings.

- In his three starts since being reinstated from the 10-day DL, he is now 1-1 with a 3.38 ERA (6 ER, 16.0 IP) while limiting the opposition to a .250 average.

WHAT'S HE GOT?: This season, he's relied on five pitches: four seamer (58.8%), curve (19.7%), cutter (15.6%), changeup (5.4%) and sinker (0.6%)...his fastball this season has averaged at 94 mph.

IN THE WIN COLUMN: Earned his first win as a Padre and his first since 4/2/17 while with NYY his last time out on 9/3 at ARI...tossed 5.0 IP of one-run ball, allowing just two hits in the Padres' 6-2 victory.

BRY-GUY: The Padres have won four of Mitchell's last six starts, dating back to April 23...the club is 4-6 overall this season when Mitchell starts.

- Prior to his last start, the Padres had won his last three starts (5/5, 9/3 and 9/11), marking the longest team win streak in his starts in his career.

WHILE YOU WERE AWAY While on the DL, Mitchell made six rehab appearances (all starts) with Lake Elsinore (A) from 8/2-27, posting a combined 4.13 ERA (13 ER, 28.1 IP) and a 1-3 record with 28 strikeouts against 12 walks.

- He most recently had tossed a season-high 7.0 IP in his last outing on 8/27 at Lancaster, allowing five runs (four earned) with five strikeouts and two walks.

STARTER VS. RELIEVER: Mitchell made seven starts to begin the season from 4/2 to 5/5, going 0-3 with a 6.47 ERA (23 ER, 32.0 IP) as a starter...was moved to bullpen after his start on 5/5 and made five relief appearances, posting an 8.27 ERA (15 ER, 16.1 IP)...after his most recent start, he is now 1-4 with a 5.44 ERA (29 ER, 48.0 IP).

BACK ME UP: Has received more than two runs of support on just two occasions (four on 4/17 vs. LAD and 9/3 at ARI).

- His 17 total runs of support as a starter (runs scored while he's in the game) are the third-fewest among pitchers with at least 48.0 IP...his 3.19 run support average is the fifth-lowest among such NL starters.

NO FREE PASSES: Mitchell has issued 40 walks compared to 31 strikeouts...his 0.78 SO/BB ratio is the lowest in the majors and his 5.60 BB/9.0 IP ratio is the third-highest in the majors (min 64.0 total IP).

KEPT IN CHECK: Mitchell and the rest of the Padres pitching staff didn't surrender an extra-base hit to the Astros in the first two games of their series on 4/6 & 4/7...it was the first time Houston was held without an extra-base hit in back-to-back contests since September 17-18, 2014 vs. CLE.

- Mitchell tossed 5.2-shutout innings on 4/7 at HOU, allowing just three hits but a career-high six walks in SD's 1-0 extra-inning defeat.

ARE YOU READY TO ROBBIE: LHP Robbie Erlin is set to make his 12th start of the season and 39th overall appearance of the season tomorrow...it will be his ninth career appearance and sixth start against the Giants.

- This year, he's relied on five pitches: four seamer (30.4%), sinker (29.7%), curve (18.3%), changeup (16.9%), slider (4.6%) and cutter (0.1%)
- Snapped his career-high-tying four consecutive loss streak in his last start on 9/19 vs. SF...tossed 5.0 IP of three-run ball in the Padres' 8-4 victory.
