THE TWINS: The Twins completed their 10-game roadtrip out of the break, going 4-6; 0-3 in Kansas City, 3-0 in Toronto and 1-4 in Boston...tonight they will begin a six-game seven-day homestand with three vs. Cleveland through Wednesday, enjoy and off-day Thursday, and three vs. Kansas City from Friday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 13-8 in their last 21.

TWINS SHUTOUT AND SHIPPED OUT OF BOSTON: The Twins lost to the Red Sox yesterday afternoon at Fenway Park by a score of 3-0, suffering their fourth shutout this season and 15th series defeat (12-15-6)...Jose Berrios (10-8) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on nine hits in 4.2 innings pitched...Adalberto Mejia made his second career relief appearance, pitching 3.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...the offense drew one walk and recorded just four hits, two leaving the infield.

TWINS AND TRIBE: The Twins are playing the Indians for the 10th of 19 scheduled meeting this season...they have gone 6-3 vs. the Tribe, 3-1 at Target Field, 1-1 in Puerto Rico and 2-1 at Cleveland...they have won five of their last six over the Indians, dating back to June 1, averaging 6.2 runs-per-game in that span...they have won three straight home games over the Indians, their longest streak since winning four straight at Target Field August 15-September 23, 2015.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .323 (230-for-712) with 51 doubles, 14 home runs, 78 RBI, 100 walks, 110 runs scored and .405 on-base percentage in 187 career games vs. the Indians... among actives vs. Cleveland, he ranks first in doubles and walks and second in hits.

EDDIE'S TRIBE: Eddie Rosario is hitting .353 (76-for-215) with 10 doubles, three triples, 15 home runs, 34 RBI and 39 runs scored in 57 career games vs. Cleveland; the homers, hits and RBI all being his personal most vs. any opponent...he is hitting .438 (28-for-64) in last 15 vs. Tribe...he has hit safely in nine straight vs. Indians and in 17 straight home games vs. Tribe, dating back to September 10, 2016...his 76 hits vs. CLE since 2015 lead baseball.

REMEMBER US?: After the four-game All-Star break and 10-game roadtrip, the Twins are playing at Target Field for the first time since July 15 vs. Tampa Bay, a span of 14 games in between...leading up to the break they had gone 10-2 since their game on June 24 vs. Texas...notable numbers during that span at home:

☞ Offense is hitting .303 (125-for-413) with 23 doubles, 13 home runs, 6.3 runs-per-game and a .367 on-base percentage.

☞ Individuals: Eddie Rosario is hitting .346 (18-for-52)...Brian Dozier is hitting .292 (14-for-48) with three doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI...Joe Mauer is hitting .311 (14-for-45)... Jake Cave is hitting .452 (14-for-31)...Robbie Grossman is hitting .448 (13-for-29) with a .500 on-base percentage.

MAUER HEATING: Joe Mauer is hitting .326 (35-for-108) with eight doubles, two home runs, 20 RBI and a .357 on-base percentage in his last 26 games (since June 29)...since that date, he ranks tied for third in the AL in hits, tied for sixth in doubles, tied for ninth in RBI and 11th in batting average.

OTHERS HEATING UP THE SUMMER: In 22 games this month, Robbie Grossman is hitting .319 (22-for-69) with six doubles, eight walks, 11 RBI and a .390 on-base percentage...in 23 games this month, Jake Cave is hitting .313 (20-for-64) with six doubles, two triples, one home run, nine RBI and a .343 on-base percentage.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, SHELTY!: Twins bench coach Derek Shelton is celebrating his 48th birthday today...he shares a birthday with Pirates manager Clint Hurdle and former MLB Commissioner Bud Selig...Shelton managed the club for two games over the weekend while Paul Molitor attended the Hall of Fame festivities in Cooperstown...Shelton is in his first season as Twins bench coach...he was Cleveland's hitting coach under Eric Wedge for five seasons from 2005-09.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1966, Dave Boswell threw the third one-hitter (17 now) in Twins history against Baltimore, the lone hit being a seventh inning single by Russ Snyder... in 2001, the Twins acquired right-handed starter Rick Reed for outfielder Matt Lawton...Reed went 4-6, 5.19 ERA (67.2 IP, 39 ER) in 12 starts for the Twins that season.

LAST START: Santana made his season debut at Toronto on July 25 after spending time on the 60-day DL recovering from off season surgery on his right middle finger...did not factor into the decision after allowing three runs on seven hits and one walk with five strikeouts...was in line to earn the win after leaving with a 4-3 lead, but the Blue Jays tied the game 6-6 in the 8th inning...Twins scored six runs in the top of the 11th to seal the win.

AGAINST THE INDIANS: Santana is making his 26th career start against the Indians, is 7-11, 3.70 ERA (146.0 IP, 60 ER) with 46 walks and 114 strikeouts...last start against Cleveland was September 28, 2017, did not factor into the decision after shutting out the Indians over 5.0 innings, allowing four hits with one strikeout...last win against Cleveland was June 25, 2017, shut out Cleveland over 6.0 innings on nine hits with seven strikeouts...he is 4-1 with a 1.28 ERA in 42.1 innings against the Indians over his last seven starts...Santana has not allowed a home run against the Tribe in his past eight starts, his longest streak of consecutive starts in his career against any team without allowing a home run.

SANTANA ON TARGET: Ervin Santana is 76-60 over his career at home and 14-14 at Target Field...last season he went 6-5 at home with a 3.90 ERA (101.2 IP, 44 ER) and a .235 opponent average against...his last start at Target Field was September 13 of last season vs. San Diego where he did not factor in the decision after 6.0 shutout inning, allowing just three hits and one walk while striking out seven...Santana recorded four complete games at Target Field from 2015-2017 and 23 of his 38 starts were quality starts.

ERV IS THE WORD: Santana is the veteran of the Twins rotation and has accumulated 2388.1 innings in his career, more than any other starter by more than 1000.0 innings (closest, Lance Lynn with 1074.1 career-innings)...ranks fifth in baseball in innings pitched from 2005-2017...ranks fifth in strikeouts (1731), sixth in complete games (21), and fifth in wins (135) in the American League during his career...since joining the Twins in 2015 has recorded seven complete games, third most in the American League from 2015-2017.

2017 RECAP:

- Started the AL Wild Card Game against New York-AL for the Twins...went 2.0 innings and allowed four runs on three hits, two home runs and two walks.
- Was Twins Opening Day starter for the second time in his career; allowed one run on two hits in 7.0 innings pitched and earned the win April 3 vs. Kansas City.
- Began the season 5-0, 0.66 ERA (41.0 IP, 3 ER) in first six starts April 3-May 2; held opponents scoreless three times and allowed exactly one run in each of the other three...according to Elias, he became the second pitcher in franchise history to allow no more than one run in each of his first six starts of a season...Walter Johnson started 1913 with a streak of seven straight such starts for the Washington Senators.
- Pitched five complete games on the season: April 15 vs. Chicago-AL, May 23 at Baltimore, June 9 at San Francisco, July 5 vs. Los Angeles-AL and August 2 at San Diego...tied for the most complete games in baseball with Corey Kluber and had more than 27 different teams.
- Held left-handed hitters to a .215 batting average and right-handers to a .234 average.
- His 3.28 ERA was the lowest for a Twins pitcher who made 30 or more starts in a season since Johan Santana's 2.77 in 2006.
- Made 30 starts for the ninth time in career and 200.0+ innings pitched for the sixth time in career.

ROAD TO RECOVERY: Santana has spent most of the season recovering from surgery on his right middle finger, which he underwent in the offseason...his season debut was July 25 at Toronto...he had rehab stints with Fort Meyers, Chattanooga and Rochester...in his last start for Rochester went 6.0 innings and allowed just one run, using 66 pitches.

TWINS ARE COMPLETE: Santana recorded five complete games during the 2017 season...he tied with Cleveland's Corey Kluber for the highest mark in all of baseball...Santana marks the first pitcher in the Twins organization to have five complete games since Carl Pavano had seven in 2010.

- Signed a four-year contract with the Twins December 13, 2014.
- Signed as a free agent with the Atlanta Braves March 12, 2014, spending his only season in the National League...his 14 wins tied for the team lead with Julio Teheran.
- Recorded his 100th career win, June 8, 2013 vs. Houston, in his only season in Kansas City.
- Traded to Kansas City October 31, 2012...left the Angels organization in the club's all-time top 10 in wins (7th, 96), innings (6th, 1,475.2) and strikeouts (6th, 1,167).
- Pitched no-hitter July 27, 2011 at Cleveland, allowing an unearned run and a walk with 10 strikeouts, marking the eighth individual no-hitter in Angels history.
- Selected to his second career All-Star Game in 2017, his first since 2008...finished year second in AL in innings (211.1), fifth in AL in ERA (3.28), and seventh in wins (16).
- Signed by the Anaheim Angels as an undrafted free agent September 2, 2000.
