**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 3** of a 3-game series vs **Dan Baker's** Phillies (0-2) and the final game of the Reds' first road trip of the **2018 championship season** that included 4 games in Pittsburgh (1-3)...the Reds are currently in a stretch of playing NL Central Division rivals **15** times over **18** games, with this series vs Phi as the interlude (1-0 vs Chi, 1-3 at Pit, 0-2 at Phi, 4g vs StL, 3g at Mil & 3g at StL)...the Reds opened the season at Great American Ball Park against Wsh (0-3) and Chi (1-0) and return there tomorrow to begin a brief 4-game homestand vs StL.

**IRON MAN:** Since **Ivan De Jesus Jr.** started at first base on **9/2/2016 vs StL**, **Joey Votto** has started each of the Reds' **last 201 games**...it's the longest **starts** streak by a Reds player since **Pete Rose** started **370 straight games** from 1973-1976 (courtesy *Elias Sports Bureau*)...in 2017 **Votto** became only the **fourth player** in franchise history to **start at least 162 games** in a season, joining **Rose** (1965, 163gs in 1974, 1975), **Leo Cardenas** (163gs in 1964) and **Vada Pinson** (1963)...**Votto's** is the Major League's **second-longest active streak** of starts in his team's games behind **Royals SS Alcides Escobar** (341g), who was the only other player in 2017 to start all of his team's games (162g)...**Votto** has **played** in 200 straight games for the **third time** in his career (**226**, 9/5/12-5/15/14; **204**, 5/10-11-6/30/12; **201**, 9/3/16-current) (courtesy *STATS*).

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS:** Yesterday, the Reds selected the contract from Class AAA Louisville **RHP Tanner Rainey** (#44) and designated for assignment **RHP Yovani Gallardo**...Rainey made his Major League debut last night against the Phillies...on Mon the Reds placed on the 10-day disabled list **3B Eugenio Suárez** (right thumb fracture) and **OF Scott Schebler** (retroactive to 4/6; right ulnar nerve contusion) and recalled from Class AAA Louisville **3B Alex Blandino** and **RHP Zack Weiss**...the injuries to both Schebler and Suárez resulted from being hit by pitches...Schebler was hit by a **Sean Doolittle** offering in the eighth inning on **4/1 vs Wsh** while Suárez was plunked by Pit's **Jameson Taillon** in the fourth inning on **Sun**.

**BROOKLYN 1914:** In Sunday's **5-0 loss** at PNC Park, Pit's **Jameson Taillon** pitched his first career Major League shutout when he blanked the Reds on 1 hit...Cin's only hit came from pitcher **Tyler Mahle**...Sun's game marked the first time since **9/19/14** that the Reds were shut out when their lone hit was produced by the pitcher...the **Brooklyn Robins' Jeff Pfeffer** shut out the Reds and earned the 6-0 victory on 9/19/14 at Ebbets Field...the Reds' only hit of the game that day came from **Earl Yingling** who pinch hit in the sixth inning and remained in the game as Cin's pitcher...Yingling went 1-for-2, with his hit coming in his second at-bat in the eighth inning while he was the Reds' pitcher. **SERIES NOTES:** The Reds are trying to avoid being swept in a **3-game series in Philadelphia** for the first time since **4/12-4/14, 1993**...with a **2-1 series win** from **5/26-5/28, 2017**, the Redlegs won a series at Phi's **Citizens Bank Park** for the first time since **August 2006**...in the **10 road series** prior to last May's win, the Reds went **0-9-1 at Phi** and **10-25 in 35 games** there...**Billy Hamilton** has reached base safely in each of the last **9 games** he's played in Philadelphia dating back to **5/18/14**...for more information see **Reds vs Phillies** on media guide Page 326.

**DOT, DOT, DOT...:** **Joey Votto** needs just **2 walks** to reach **1,000 in his career**...he has agreed to donate his **batting helmet** to the **National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum** in Cooperstown...**RHP Tyler Mahle** on 4/2 vs Chi at **23 years & 185** days became the **youngest** pitcher to record a win this season in the Major Leagues...he remains the youngest **starting** pitcher to earn a victory this season as Det's **Joe Jimenez (23 years, 78 days)** earned the win in relief Thursday night at CWS...**LHP Brandon Finnegan** (left biceps strain) on Monday began a rehabilitation assignment at AAA-Louisville and pitched **5.0 innings** vs Columbus (**0-1, 8h, 4r/3er, 5bb, 2k, 1hr, 96 pitches**).

**POSTPONED TWICE:** The Reds were **rained out twice** during their season-opening homestand, first on **Opening Day vs Wsh** and then on **Tuesday vs Chi**...it marked the first time since **6/11 & 6/12, 1985** at Riverfront Stadium (vs LAD) that the Reds endured **2 weather-related postponements** in the same homestand...Tue's rainout vs the Cubs will be made up as part of a day/night doubleheader at GABP on **5/19 at 1:10**...fans holding tickets for Tue's game may present their same ticket for the rescheduled 1:10 game on 5/19 with no exchange necessary...for more information fans are encouraged to visit **reds.com/rainout**...last Thursday's **postponement** was the first for the Reds on **Opening Day** because of **inclement weather** since the first 3 games of the **1966 season vs the Mets** all were rained out...the 2018 season-opener was rescheduled and played the following day (Wsh beat Cin, 6-5)...there have been a total of **15 postponements** in the **16 seasons** at GABP.

**YOUNGSTERS:** The Reds' **Opening Day roster** included **5 rookies:** **RHP Tyler Mahle**, **RHP Jackson Stephens**, **RHP Zack Weiss**, **OF Phillip Ervin** and **OF Jesse Winker**...it also included **21 players age 30 and under**, **17 players age 27 and under** and **11 players age 25 & under**...**Weiss**, who was optioned to Class AAA Louisville the day after **Opening Day** to make room on the roster for **RHP Yovani Gallardo**, was the only player on the **Opening Day roster** without a **Major League appearance**...according to **Elias Sports Bureau**, the average age for the Reds' 25-man **Opening Day roster (27 years, 196 days)** was the second-youngest in the Major Leagues behind the **Phillies (26.334)** and ahead of the **Marlins (27.351)**...in 2017, the Reds began a season with **7 rookies** on their **Opening Day roster** for the first time in researchable history, per **Elias**...last year's **Opening Day Reds roster** was the youngest in the Major Leagues (**26.355**).

**ROOKIE ARMS:** The Reds pitching staff currently includes rookie relievers **RHP Tanner Rainey** and **RHP Zack Weiss** and rookie starter **RHP Tyler Mahle**...Weiss has yet to make his Major League debut...the Reds' **Opening Day** pitching staff included Mahle, Weiss and **RHP Jackson Stephens**...Weiss, who was recalled on Mon, was optioned on 3/31 to Class AAA Louisville to make room on the roster for **RHP Yovani Gallardo**, who was signed to a 1-year contract...Stephens was optioned to Louisville on 4/1 when **RHP Raisel Iglesias** came off the 3-day disabled list...over the last 4 seasons, including 2018, **rookie pitchers** started **253** of the Reds' **496 games (51%)**, including a club record **110 games** in 2015, **56 games** in 2016, **84 games** last season and **2 games** so far this year...during **Bryan Price's** 5-year tenure as manager, including 2018, rookie pitchers have started **260** of Cin's **658 games (40%)**.

**THE SKIPPER...:** **Bryan Price** is in his fifth season as a Major League manager, accumulating a **278-380** overall record.

In last night's 6-1 loss at Citizens Bank Park, **3b Alex Blandino** and **RHP Tanner Rainey** each made his Major League debut...twice last season **2 Reds** made their first big league appearance in the same game (**8/27 vs Pit: RHP Tyler Mahle & C Chad Wallach; 4/6 vs Phi: RHP Rookie Davis & C Stuart Turner**)...Reds rookies made **17 Major League debuts** in 2017 and **31** over the last 3 seasons, including this one...when he pitches **RHP Zack Weiss** will be making his Major League debut.

**WITH 2 OUTS**  
The Reds entered **Wednesday** having allowed just **12** two-out runs over their first **10** games...the Phillies scored all **6** of their runs **last night** with 2 outs (2 RBI-singles & a grand slam)...the **18 total** two-out runs allowed by the Reds still ranks among the National League's lowest:

# Tonight's Pitcher - #58 Luis Castillo, RHP

## RED HOTS

**Luis Castillo** at just **25 years old** is in his second **Major League** season...tonight is making his third start of the season and his 18th **Major League** appearance and start...will be his first career appearance vs the **Phillies**...in 2017 led National League rookies in ERA and opponents' batting average (.202) while ranking eighth among rookies in strikeouts...the Reds went 7-8 in his 15 starts...with 8 quality starts ranked second on the staff behind **Scott Feldman's** 9 QS...produced all 8 quality starts in his last 12 apps beginning 7/8 (3-6, 2.84), including 6 QS in his last 8 apps beginning 7/30 (2-3, 2.37)...beginning 7/8 and among pitchers with at least 12 starts, his 2.84 ERA ranked seventh in the Major Leagues behind **Corey Kluber** (1.79), **Justin Verlander** (1.92), **Kyle Hendricks** (2.19), **Luis Severino** (2.40), **Jake Arrieta** (2.48) and **Marcus Stroman** (2.73)...during spring training, from 3/13-3/17 spent time in New York with wife **Delores** while celebrating the birth of their first child, **Brittany**.

## RED HOTS

**Sal Romano** at just **24 years old** is in his **second Major League** season...tomorrow vs StL will make his third start of the season and his 19th Major League appearance and start...will be his first career appearance vs the Cardinals...in 2017, in his Major League debut made 16 starts during 3 stints with the Reds...made spot starts in April and in early July before joining the rotation for good after the All-Star break...during the second half led Reds pitchers in innings (79.0) while tying Homer Bailey for the staff lead in starts (14)...in his last 8 starts of the season for the Reds went 3-3, 3.17 with 4 quality starts...overall after the All-Star break went 4-7, 4.44 in his 14 starts...the Reds went 7-9 in his 16 starts.

# Friday vs Cardinals - #30 Tyler Mahle, RHP

## RED HOTS

**Tyler Mahle's** last name rhymes with **RALLY**...at just **23 years old** is in his **second Major League** season...Fri vs StL will make his third start of 2018, the seventh appearance and start of his career...will be his second career appearance vs the **Cardinals**...was 1 of 5 rookies on the **Opening Day roster (RHP Jackson Stephens, RHP Zack Weiss, OF Phillip Ervin, OF Jesse Winker)** and the only rookie to begin this season in the Reds' starting rotation...when he earned the 1-0 win in his season debut on 4/2 vs Cubs was the youngest pitcher in the Major Leagues with a victory...in 2017 was a *Baseball America* Minor League All-Star, MLB Pipeline.com's Reds Minor League Pitcher of the Year, the organization's Minor League Pitcher of the year and a mid-season Southern League All-Star...in his Major League debut, from 8/27-9/13 made all his 4 starts for the Reds...spent most of the season at Pensacola and Louisville, where he combined to finish **10-7, 2.06 in 24 starts** (144.1ip, 109h, 30bb, 138k, 9hr)...led the organization in ERA while ranking T3rd in wins and fourth in strikeouts...among all minor league pitchers ranked eighth in ERA and sixth in WHIP (0.96)...when promoted to Louisville on 6/22 led the Southern League in innings pitched and WHIP (0.87) while ranking among the leaders in ERA (2nd), strikeouts (2nd), opponents' BA (.190, 2nd) and wins (3rd)...in a 1-0 win at Mobile on 4/22 threw the **first perfect game** Blue Wahoos history and the **second 9-inning perfect game** in Southern League history (8/14/1970, Montgomery's Charles Swanson vs Savannah).

- Is approaching 100 career runs (89) and 300 hits (275).

## 23 ADAM DUVALL, lf On the road trip: 6gs, 2-23, 1hr, 2bb

- On Mon at Phi went 1-for-4 to snap an 0-for-14 hitless skid.

- Is trying to join Hall of Famer Frank Robinson as the only players in Reds history to produce at least 70 extra-base hits in 3 straight seasons (courtesy TheAthletic.com).
- Is approaching 400 career apps (372), 200 runs (179) and 100 walks (91).

- Spring Training: 20g, .347, 1hr, 10rbi, 2sb... tied for the team lead in doubles (5) and ranked among the team leaders in hits (17)...hit safely in 13 of his 20 apps, including 10 of his last 14 apps (14-36, .389, 3 2b, 1hr, 8rbi) and each of his last 3 apps (3-9, .333, 1rbi)...made 9 starts in LF, 5 starts in RF and 4 starts at DH.
- Made his first Opening Day roster...was 1 of 5 rookies on the Opening Day roster.
- Started in LF on Opening Day.
- In 2017 at Louisville was an International League mid-season All-Star.
- Last season, in his Major League debut made 47 apps and 28 starts during 4 stints the Reds.
