CHICAGO CUBS NOTES

JAVIER BÁEZ (2-for-5, 2B, HR, R, 2 RBI) set a new career-high with his 24th homer of the season ... raised his batting average to .300, his highest post-game batting average since April 28 (.304).

ALBERT ALMORA JR. (2-for-4, R, RBI) recorded his first multi-hit game since July 25 vs. Arizona ... was 1-for-24 in his last nine games.

BEN ZOBRIST (2-for-2, HR, 2 R, RBI) hit a home run off the right field video board, the third Cubs homer to hit the RF board this season ... improved to 1-for-11 as a pinch-hitter this season with a seventh inning single.

ANTHONY RIZZO (1-for-2, RBI) notched a pinch-hit RBI single in the seventh inning, just his second-career hit as a pinch-hitter.

NOTES: The Cubs finished the season series against San Diego with a 5-2 record.

- © Willson Contreras (2-for-4) has reached in nine-straight games.
- © David Bote (2-for-3, 2B) collected his fifth multi-hit game.
- © Victor Caratini (0-for-4) went hitless but saw 33 combined pitches in his four plate appearances, including two 10-pitch at-bats.
- © Jon Lester allowed five runs for just the second time in 23 starts this season ... has gone at least 5.0 innings in 21 starts.
- © Jesse Chavez (2.0 IP, 2 H, 3 SO) has posted a 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) in eight games with the Cubs.

SAN DIEGO PADRES NOTES

HUNTER RENFROE (2-for-4, HR, R, 3 RBI) went 7-for-20 (.350) with three homers and seven RBI in six games vs. the Cubs this season.

FRANMIL REYES (2-for-3, HR, R, RBI) hit his first homer since June 5 vs. Atlanta and first multi-hit game since June 14 at Atlanta.

© ESPN Stats and Info notes that his 477-foot homer was the fifth-longest by any player this season according to Statcast.

ERIC HOSMER (3-for-5, 3B, R, 2 RBI) tied his season-high with three hits ... has reached in 12-straight games.

NOTES: The Padres improved to 4-1 when hitting at least three homers.

- © Christian Villanueva (2-for-3, 2B, BB) batted .435 (10-for-23) with two doubles and two homers in seven games vs. the Cubs this season.
- © Manuel Margot (2-for-5, R) is batting .436 (17-for-39) with nine runs scored in his last nine games.
- © Cory Spangenberg (1-for-2, 2B, RBI) picked up his second game-winning RBI of the season.
- © Travis Jankowski (1-for-1, BB, R, 2 RBI, SB) has hit safely in five-straight games.
- © Joey Lucchesi tied a career-high with nine strikeouts (also, April 15 vs. San Francisco).
