**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners continue their penultimate homestand of the season – a 10-day, 8-game, 3-team set – with the finale (0-2) of 3 games vs. the Yankees...won 2-of-3 vs. the Orioles to open the homestand...after an off day tomorrow will play 2 games against the Padres...following this homestand, will embark on the final road trip of the season, an 11-day, 10-game, 3-city, 2-state trip to Los Angeles-AL (4 G), Houston (3 G) and Texas (3 G)...today's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **770 KTTH** and the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners are 13-14 in their last 27 games dating back to Aug. 9...are 23-33 in their last 56 games since July 4 after winning a season-high 8 straight games, spanning June 25 – July 3...the Mariners are 38-40 in their last 78 games since June 10...Seattle is 64-53 in its last 117 games (4/28-c) and 69-56 over its last 125 games (4/20-c)...Seattle is 23-24 during the day and 55-40 at night...Seattle is 40-31 at Safeco Field, 38-33 on the road.

- **Double Double** - since Aug. 4, **Mitch Haniger** is 2nd in the Majors with 15 doubles, trailing only Matt Chapman-OAK (16), while ranking ahead of Alex Bregman-HOU (13) and Justin Turner-LAD (13).
- **Close Games** - the Mariners are 50-24 (.676) this season in games decided by 1 or 2 runs, the highest winning percentage in the Majors...the Mariners are 34-18 (.654) in 1-run games (most 1-run wins in MLB) and 16-6 (.727) in games decided by exactly 2 runs (2nd-best 2-run winning percentage in MLB).
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 56-18 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 22-46 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 2 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (67-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining Oakland (71-0).
- **400** - **Nelson Cruz** has hit at least 400 RBI with both Seattle (402) and Texas (489)...he is 1 of 7 active players to record at least 400 RBI with 2 different teams, joining Adrián Beltré (LAD-510 & TEX-688), Miguel Cabrera (FLA-523 & DET-1,112), Adrián González (SD-501, LAD-448), Matt Holliday (STL-616 & COL-486), Víctor Martínez (CLE-518 & DET-538) and Albert Pujols (STL-1,329 & LAA-653).
- **Heating Up** - since Aug. 11, **Ryon Healy** is batting .338 (23x68) with 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 13 RBI and 4 walks in 19 games.

**ALEXANDER THE GREAT**...in his last 27 appearances, dating back to June 30, **Alex Colomé** is 3-0 with 17 holds and a 1.63 ERA (5 ER, 27.2 IP)...during this span, he has recorded 34 strikeouts and 8 walks, while limiting opposing batters to a .206 (21x102) average against...since making his Mariners debut on May 27, Colomé leads the Major Leagues with 26 holds...overall, he is 3-0 with 1 save, 26 holds and a 2.97 ERA (13 ER, 39.1 IP) with 44 strikeouts and 10 walks in 40 relief appearances with the Mariners...after striking out the side last night, he has recorded at least 1 strikeout in each of his last 8 games (8/18-c), including 5 outings with multiple strikeouts; has tallied 15 strikeouts over this span.

**SIMPLY SEAGER**...**Kyle Seager** is batting .257 (46x179) with 11 doubles, 6 home runs, 35 RBI, a .309 on-base percentage and a .419 slugging mark vs. left-handed pitchers this season...his 35 RBI vs. southpaws are tied for 2nd-most in the Majors (also: Nolan Arenado-COL and Freddie Freeman-ATL), trailing only Trevor Story-COL (42)...since 2012, Seager has hit 59 home runs off of lefties, tied with Paul Goldschmidt for 4th-most in the Majors over that span behind Nelson Cruz (69), Giancarlo Stanton (69) and Mark Trumbo (62); Seager's 59 home runs vs. left-handers are the most by a left-handed batter over the last 7 seasons, ranking ahead of Chris Davis (56) and Jay Bruce (48).

**GOOD TO BE HOME**...**Nelson Cruz** has hit 19 home runs at Safeco Field this season, which is T2nd-most all-time at Safeco Field, trailing only Richie Sexson's 21 home runs at Safeco Field in 2005...Cruz, who also hit 19 home runs at Safeco Field in 2017, is joined by Bret Boone (2001) and Edgar Martínez (19) as the only other players to hit 19 home runs at Safeco Field in a single season...overall this season, Cruz's 19 home run at home are T4th-most in the American League (also: José Ramírez-CLE), trailing only J.D. Martínez-BOS (22), Khris Davis-OAK (21) and Joey Gallo-TEX (21).

**ELECTRIC EDDIE**...**Edwin Díaz** is 6 strikeouts shy of recording his 300th career strikeout...his 294 career strikeouts are currently 7th-most in club history by a reliever, trailing only Jeff Nelson (471), Mike Jackson (383), Bobby Ayala (374), J.J. Putz (337), Arthur Rhodes (315) and Tom Wilhelmson (307)...**Díaz's** 294 strikeouts are 3rd-most among Major League relievers since his debut season of 2016, trailing only Dellin Betances (330) and Brad Hand (312), while ranking ahead of Craig Kimbrel (293) and Kenley Jansen (284).

**MULTI-HIT MADNESS**...**Jean Segura** has recorded 49 multi-hit games this season, T5th-most in the Majors (also: Mookie Betts-BOS and Nolan Arenado-COL)...with 1 more multi-hit game, Segura will become the 42nd player in club history with at least 50 multi-hit games in a single season and the first since **Robinson Canó** (59) and **Nelson Cruz** (52) in 2016...**Ichiro** holds the single-season franchise record with 80 multi-hit games in 2004...it will also mark Segura's 2nd career season with at least 50 multi-hit contests (also: 57 with ARI in 2016).

**THE CANÓ SHOW**...**Robinson Canó** has hit safely in 20 of 27 games vs. the Yankees, including reaching base safely in 23 of 25 games as a starter...overall, he is batting .323 (32x99) with 13 runs scored, 4 doubles, 4 home runs, 14 RBI, 2 HBP, 7 walks and 1 stolen base in 27 career games vs. the Yankees.

**THE EDWIN DÍAZ REPORT**...in 67 games this season, **Edwin Díaz** is 53-for-57 (92.98%) in save opportunities with a 1.87 ERA (14 ER, 67.1 IP) with 117 strikeouts and 16 walks...he has limited opposing batters to a .155 (36x233) average against with a 0.77 WHIP (16 BB, 36 H, 67.1 IP)...here are some notes on Díaz's standout season:

- Leads the Major Leagues with 53 saves...Wade Davis-COL is 2nd with 39.
- Is the 14th pitcher (done 17x) in ML history to record at least 50 saves in a season.
- Ranks 2nd among Major League relievers with 117 strikeouts...Josh Hader-MIL is 1st with 121.
- Is 26-for-29 (89.6%) in one-run save opportunities with a 0.92 ERA (3 ER, 29.1 IP) with 54 strikeouts and 5 walks...the Mariners are 29-0 this season when he enters with a one-run lead.
- Has struck out 46.2% (117 K, 253 BF) of batters faced this season, the top mark by a reliever this season and the 4th-best single-season strikeout rate by a reliever in Major League history.

**DID YOU KNOW?**...that **Mitch Haniger's** 32 doubles are the most by a Mariners outfielder since Raúl Ibáñez tallied 43 doubles in 2008?...Ibáñez's 43 doubles stand as the Mariners single-season record for doubles by an outfielder.

ABOUT RAMÍREZ...

- Making his 8th start of the season, his 189th career appearance, 89th career start and his 18th career appearance (5th start) vs. the Yankees.
- Signed with Seattle as a non-drafted free agent on Sept. 1, 2007.
- Made his MLB debut with the Mariners on April 9, 2012 at Texas.
- The native of Rivas, Nicaragua, is one of 14 Nicaraguan-born players in ML history...is one of 3 active players born in Nicaragua, joining Cheslor Cuthbert-KC and JC Ramirez-LAA.
- Is 3-6 with a 3.76 ERA (61 ER, 136.1 IP) in 33 G/20 GS in September.

LAST OUTING...

...earned his 2nd win of the season as the Mariners defeated the Orioles 2-1 on Sept. 3...allowed 1 run on 2 hits while striking out 5 batters across 5.1 innings...sole run came on a solo home run by Jonathan Villar in the 4th inning...marked the 4th start in which Ramirez has allowed 1-or-fewer earned runs this season.

LATELY AND GREATLY...

...in 5 starts since returning from the disabled list on Aug. 12, is 2-1 with a 3.70 ERA (10 ER, 24.1 IP), despite a 7-run, 3.0-inning loss in San Diego on Aug. 29...in each of the other 4 starts, has tossed 5.0-or-more innings and allowed 1-or-fewer earned runs...the Mariners are 4-1 in those 5 starts.

NOW THAT'S QUALITY...

...since 2012, ranks 5th in quality starts as a Mariner with 23 despite playing two-and-a-half seasons with Tampa Bay during this span...trails only Félix Hernández (118), Hisashi Iwakuma (82), James Paxton (55) and Taijuan Walker (28)...last season, his 7 quality starts with the Mariners were T3rd-most on the club (also: Hernández) despite being acquired midseason.

WELCOME BACK...

...was activated from the 10-day disabled list prior to the game on Aug. 12...was placed on the 10-day disabled list for the second time this season with a right Teres Major strain on May 1 after making 2 starts for the Mariners...opened the season on the 10-day DL with a right shoulder latissimus dorsi strain, March 28 (retro. to March 26) to April 22.

REHAB RECAP...

...made 7 rehab starts in 2018 with High-A Modesto (1), AA Arkansas (1) and AAA Tacoma (5)...across those starts, he was 0-2 with a 2.45 ERA (7 ER, 25.2 IP) with 26 strikeouts and 4 walks...he has allowed just 1 home run in the minor leagues this season.

WITH THE MARINERS...

...making 18th start since his return to Mariners (7/28/17)...was 1-3 with a 3.92 ERA (27 ER, 62.0 IP) with 54 strikeouts and 15 walks with Seattle in 2017...began his career with Mariners and was 7-12, 4.62 (106 ER, 206.2 IP) in 47 games, 35 GS, from 2012-2014...traded to TB in March of 2015.

2017 SEASON...

...went 5-6-1 in 37 appearances (19 starts) with a 4.39 ERA (64 ER, 131.1 IP) with 109 strikeouts and 31 walks...was acquired by the Mariners from Tampa Bay in exchange for RHP Steve Cishek on July 28, 2017...went 1-3 with a 3.92 ERA (27 ER, 62.0 IP) in 11 starts with the Mariners.

JEKYLL AND HYDE...

...in 15 games (9 starts) at his home ballpark last season, was 4-0 with a 2.49 ERA (17 ER, 61.1 IP) with 53 strikeouts and 12 walks...was 1-6 with 1 save and a 6.04 ERA (47 ER, 70.0 IP) with 56 strikeouts and 19 walks in 22 outings (10 starts) on the road...made 4 starts as a Mariner at Safeco Field last season and made 5 starts with the Rays at Tropicana Field earlier that year.

NICE TO SEE YOU AGAIN...

...became the 41st player in club history to have spent at least two different stints with the Mariners...the 44th and most recent to do so was LHP Roesnis Elías (2014-15, 2018-c)...Mike Blowers (1992-95, 1997, 1999), Raúl Ibañez (1996-2000, 2004-2008, 2013), Norm Charlton (1993, 1995-97, 2001) and Jeff Nelson (1992-95, 2001-03, 2005) are the only players who spent three separate stints with the Mariners.

START IT UP...

...as a starter in 2017, was 4-5 with a 4.74 ERA (50 ER, 95.2 IP) with 86 strikeouts and 25 walks in 19 starts combined between Seattle (11 GS) and Tampa Bay (8 GS)...went at least 5.0 innings and allowed 2-or-fewer runs in 10-of-his-18 starts.

TAMPA BAY RECAP...

...was 4-3 with 1 save, 6 holds and a 4.80 ERA (37 ER, 69.1 IP) in 26 games (8 starts)...recorded 55 strikeouts and 16 walks while limiting opponents to a .189 (20x106) average with a .232 on-base percentage...as a reliever, he went 1-1 with 1 save, 6 holds and a 3.23 ERA (11 ER, 30.2 IP) with 23 strikeouts and 6 walks in 18 appearances.

MLB CAREER...

...in seven Major League seasons with Seattle (2012-14, 2017-c) and Tampa Bay (2015-17), he is 32-38 with 3 saves and a 4.27 ERA (297 ER, 626.0 IP) with 488 strikeouts and 176 walks in 189 games (89 starts)...signed with the Mariners as a non-drafted free agent on Sept. 1, 2007.

Ramírez is making his 18th career appearance (5th start) against the Yankees...is 2-2 with a 3.66 ERA (16 ER, 39.1 IP) in 17 career games (4 starts) against New York-AL...is 2-0 with a 1.13 ERA (3 ER, 24.0 IP) with 2 quality starts, in his 4 starts vs. the Yankees, holding New York to a .139 average (11x79)...here is how Ramírez has fared against current Yankee hitters:

TUESDAY'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: LHP MARCO GONZALES (12-9, 4.32 ERA)

26-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 26th start of the 2018 season Tuesday vs. San Diego...is currently on the 10-day disabled list with a cervical (neck) muscle strain; was placed on the DL on 8/27 (retro to 8/24)...won 5 straight starts, 6/29-7/29, allowing just 6 earned runs across 34.1 IP (1.57 ERA) over that span...is one of 16 AL pitchers with at least 12 wins...L#9 in his last start, a 7-10 Mariners loss to Houston on 8/22 (3.0,11,8,8,0,3); marked a career-high in runs allowed...W#8 was the 1st complete game of his career, a 4-1 Mariners win on 6/29 vs. KC (9.0,6,1,1,0,7)...has tossed 6.0+ innings in 16 of his last 21 starts (4/24-c), going 11-7 with a 3.91 ERA (56 ER, 129.0 IP) with 109 strikeouts and 25 walks; has 11 quality starts over that span...2017: Went 1-1 with a 6.08 ERA (27 ER, 40.0 IP) with 32 strikeouts and 11 walks in 11 games (8 starts)...was acquired from STL on 7/21/17 in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill...posted a 5.40 ERA (22 ER, 36.2 IP) with 30 strikeouts and 11 walks in 10 games (7 starts) with Seattle. CAREER: Drafted by St. Louis with 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University...made MLB debut with the Cardinals on June 25, 2014 at Colorado...is 17-12 with a 4.72 ERA (117 ER, 223.0 IP) with 192 strikeouts in 47 games (39 starts) in parts of 4 Major League seasons with St. Louis (2014-15, 2017) and Seattle (2017-c)...missed the 2016 season while recovering from ligament replacement surgery on his left elbow...vs. SD: Will be making his 1st career start vs. San Diego.
