**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants will try to snap their season-long five game losing streak tonight with game two against the Pittsburgh Pirates...SF has been outscored 43-10 over those five contests, allowing 11 runs in three of the games.

**WITH THE BATS:** During their current losing skid, San Francisco is hitting .211 and has struck out 69 times...over that stretch the Giants have just three hits in 34 at-bats (.088) with runners in scoring position and are averaging 2.0 runs per game.

**TIME FOR A HOME RUN: C Buster Posey** is hitting .298 (48-for-161) with 14 doubles and 24 RBI in 42 career games against Pittsburgh...none of his 48 hits against the Pirates have left the yard...the Pirates are the only National League team that Posey does not have a home run against (he has two-or-more homers versus every other National League opponent) (Stats, LLC).

**ON THE MOUND: RHP Jeff Samardzija** has posted a 6-4 record against the Pirates with a 2.80 ERA (33er, 106.0ip) in 25 games (14 starts)...his 2.80 ERA against Pittsburgh is the second-lowest among active pitchers (min. 75.0ip) behind teammate Johnny Cueto (2.19 ERA).

**AGAINST RIGHTIES:** Tonight marks the ninth-consecutive right-handed starter the Giants have faced...prior to this road trip the Giants had faced a right-handed starter just 13 times in 31 games...the Giants have posted a 8-13 record overall this season versus right-handed starters and are scheduled to face a righty in each of their next four contests.

**WELCOME BACK:** Former Pirate **OF Andrew McCutchen** is just five hits away from reaching the 1,500 career hit milestone...he hit safely in 10-straight games, batting .382 (13-for-34) and has reached base safely in each of his last 21 contests (20 hits, 17 walks).

**TOO MANY LONG BALLS:** SF pitchers have surrendered 18 home runs in their last 10 games, including 13 homers in their past five contests...Giants' pitchers allowed just 20 homers over their first 29 contests this season.

**PITCHING STRUGGLES:** Giants' starting pitchers struggled the last time through the rotation, allowing 23 runs in 22.0 innings (9.41 ERA) in five starts...no SF starter made it past the fifth inning in their last outing.

**JUST SCORE FOUR:** San Francisco is 17-3 this season when scoring at least four runs in a game, compared to a 2-17 record when scoring fewer than four.

**TOO MANY MISCUES:** The Giants have committed 14 errors in their past nine games...San Francisco's 31 errors overall this season rank as the second most in the Majors behind the Texas Rangers (36).

**WITH THE GLOVES:** The Giants have turned 13 double plays over their past 10 games...their 43 double plays this season are tied with the Texas Rangers for the most in the Majors.

### This Date in Giants History: May 12, 1958

**Willie Mays** hit the first grand slam in the history of the San Francisco Giants...Mays also hit another home run in a 12-3 victory over the Los Angeles Dodgers...the Giants moved from New York to San Francisco prior to the season.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#29 RHP Jeff Samardzija**  
**6-5, 240, 33 years old (January 23, 1985)**  
**1-2 Record, 6.62 ERA**

- 2014 NL All-Star enters his third season in a Giants uniform and is slated to make his fifth start of the year...began the season on the disabled list with a pectoral strain he suffered during spring training.
- Took the loss in his last outing this past Monday in the Giants' 11-0 loss at Philadelphia...allowed five runs on four hits and three walks with three strikeouts.
- Since throwing 5.0-scoreless innings in his first outing of the season, he has surrendered 13 earned runs in 12.2 innings over his last three starts (9.24 ERA).
- Has not thrown more than 5.0 innings in any of his starts this season...reached the 200.0 inning mark for the fifth-consecutive season last year and is one of only two pitchers in the Majors to throw at least 200.0 frames in each of the last five seasons.
- Has allowed 13 walks compared to just 15 strikeouts in his first three starts...his 1.15 strikeouts per walk is the lowest in the National League.
- Left-handed batters are hitting .400 (12-for-30) against him...righties are just 7-for-42 (.167) against him.
- Opponents are hitting .350 (7-for-20) against him in the first inning and just .231 (12-for-52) in all other innings.
- Owns a 6-4 record against the Pirates with a 2.80 ERA (33er, 106.0ip) in 25 games (14 starts)...his 2.80 ERA against Pittsburgh is the second-lowest among active pitchers (min. 75.0ip) behind teammate **Johnny Cueto** (2.19 ERA).
- Made 32 starts in 2017 with San Francisco and posted a 9-15 record with a 4.42 ERA (102er, 207.2ip) over 32 outings.

**NOTES:** The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his eighth start in a Giants uniform...SF is 2-5 in his outings this year, going 0-4 on the road... last pitched Tuesday at Philadelphia and was tagged for his fourth loss in seven starts in the Giants' 4-2 defeat...logged 5.0 innings while allowing three runs on six hits...has pitched past the 5th inning just twice in seven starts this year and has allowed at least three runs in all but one game...is 0-3 with a 5.66 ERA (13er, 20.2ip) in four starts on the road...in fact, dating back to last season, he's gone winless in his last 12 road outings, going 0-9 with a 10.53 ERA...his last road win came nearly one year ago on May 21 at Seattle while pitching for Chicago-AL.
