**NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES**

- The Yankees improved to 3-2 on their final regular season homestand...have won two straight after going 1-4 in their previous 5G...on Thursday, will seek their first three-game winning streak since a four-game sweep at Baltimore from 8/24-26...are 18-12 in their last 30G and 25-16 in 41G since 8/6...are 35G over .500, 1G below their season-high watermark...marked their eighth win by at least 9R this season.
  - Are 7-8 vs. the Red Sox, including 6-2 at Yankee Stadium...have won all three home series vs. Boston this season, and have won 7-of-9 home series vs. Boston since the start of 2016...have not swept the Red Sox in the Bronx since 8/6-9/09 (four-game sweep)...are 9.5G behind Boston in the AL East (Boston's magic number is 2)...is their second-largest win over the Red Sox in the last three seasons (11-1 win on 7/1/18 at home).
- **RHP Luis Severino** (7.0IP, 6H, 1ER, 1BB, 6K, 1WP) started and earned his 18th win...ranks third in the Majors in wins behind Blake Snell (20-5) and Corey Kluber (19-7)...are the most in a season by a Yankees pitcher since CC Sabathia went 19-8 in 2011...marked his 31st start of the season, tying his career high (31 in 2017)...was just his second start of 7.0IP since the start of July (14GS total), also 8/8 at Chicago-AL...has permitted 1R in consecutive starts (12.2IP, 2ER, 1.42 ERA) after allowing at least 2R in 11 consecutive starts.
  - Is 10-2 with a 2.74 ERA (92.0IP, 74H, 28ER, 22BB, 110K, 8HR) in 15 starts at Yankee Stadium this season, one of four pitchers with at least 10 home wins in 2018: Corey Kluber (11-3), Blake Snell (10-1), J.A. Happ (10-4)...is the fourth pitcher to earn at least 10 wins in a season at the current Yankee Stadium: CC Sabathia (11-2 in 2010, 10-5 in 2013), Phil Hughes (11-4 in 2010, 11-4 in 2012), Hiroki Kuroda (11-6).
  - Induced seven pop-ups, including three apiece by Bogaerts and Kinsler...is tied for the most pop-ups by a Yankees pitcher in a single game in the last 11 seasons (since 2008), also Bartolo Colon, 8/11/11 vs. Los Angeles-AL.
- **Yankees starting pitchers** have allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 10 of their last 11 starts, going 5-3 with a 2.10 ERA (60.0IP, 51H, 16R/14ER, 11BB, 55K, 4HR) over the span.
- **LHP Justus Sheffield** (1.0IP, 2H, 1BB) escaped a bases-loaded, one-out jam to throw a scoreless ninth inning in his **Major League debut**.
- **Yankees batters** hit 3HR, giving them **245HR this season to tie the franchise's single-season home run record set in 2012**...is tied for the eighth-highest HR total in Major League history, most since Baltimore hit 253HR in 2016...are on pace to hit 263HR (the MLB record is 264HR by Seattle in 1997)...have scored at least 10R twice on the homestand (also 11-0 win on Fri. vs. Toronto)...
  - The Yankees have 11 players with double-digit home runs, tied for the Major League record (also the 2017 Houston Astros, 2016 Minnesota Twins, 2015 Houston Astros and the 2004 Detroit Tigers)...one more HR by Voit would give the Yankees the new Major League record.
  - Andújar became the fourth Yankee with at least 25HR this season (Stanton-34, Judge-26, Gregorius-26, Andújar-25)...is the fourth time in club history with four players hitting at least 25HR (5 in 2009, 4 in 2010, 4 in 1938).
  - With Voit's 2HR tonight, the Yankees now have 23 individual multi-HR games, tied for the fourth-most in Major League history...need one more to tie the 1966 Braves and 1961 Yankees (24 each) for the record...Aaron Judge does not have a multi-HR game in 2018.
  - Have hit 11HR in the last 5G...have homered in 22-of-25G since 8/24 (43HR total).
  - Have hit 31HR in their last 15 home games (since 8/17), with at least 2HR in nine of those games.
  - Have hit 14HR in their last 5G at home vs. Boston (since 6/29).
  - Have scored at least 5R in 7-of-11 games vs. David Price since the start of 2016, batting .335 (83-for-248) with 16HR against him...over the same span, Price has gone 2-7 with a 7.71 ERA (58.1IP, 50ER) in his 11 starts against the Yankees...Price has allowed 8HR in his last two starts at Yankee Stadium and 13HR in his last four here.

- **1B Luke Voit** (4-for-4, 4R, 2HR, 3RBI) collected a career-high 4H and recorded his second career 2HR game (also 8/24/18 at Baltimore)...has 9HR as a Yankee and 10HR overall this season...entered the game 2-for-15 in his previous 5G.
- Since joining the Yankees on 8/2, is hitting .323/.400/.634 (30-for-93) with 20R, 2 doubles, 9HR, 20RBI and 11BB in 29G...since 8/24, has hit 9HR in 22G, second-most HRs in the Majors in that span (Christian Yelich-10).
- Is one of 10 Yankees with a multi-HR game in 2018, one of eight with at least two multi-HR games.
- Is the fourth Yankee this season with at least 4H and 2HR in a game, joining Brett Gardner (5/29 vs. Houston), Gary Sánchez (5/19 at Kansas City) and Didi Gregorius (4/3 vs. Tampa Bay)...just one Yankee had such a game in the previous five seasons (2013-17): Aaron Judge on 6/11/17 vs. Baltimore.
- **3B Miguel Andújar** (2-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 1HR) hit his 25th HR of the season, a solo shot in the second...is the fourth Yankees rookie to hit 25HR in a season, joining Aaron Judge (52HR in 2017), Joe DiMaggio (29HR in 1936) and Joe Gordon (25HR in 1938)...is one of four Yankees with 25HR this season (see above)...also doubled in the third inning, his 41st of the season, most among MLB rookies.
- Has 68XBH this season (41 doubles, 2 triples, 25HR), most among MLB rookies...joins DiMaggio (44 doubles, 29HR in 1936) as the only Yankees rookies with at least 25 doubles and 25HR in a season.
- Is one of 28 players in Major League history to record at least 70XBH in his first 144 career games, and the fourth Yankee (Joe DiMaggio-89, Bob Meusel-72, Gary Sánchez-70).
- Marked his 15th game this season with at least 2XBH, his first since 8/18 vs. Toronto...is the seventh player this season with at least 15 multi-XBH games (Báez, J. Ramirez, Lindor, Betts, K. Davis, Carpenter)...is one of 10 players all-time to record at least 2XBH in 15-or-more of their first 144 career games.
- **2B Gleyber Torres** (1-for-4, 1R) has hit safely in each of his last 16 home games (since 8/16), the longest home hitting streak by a Yankee in 2018.
- **LF Andrew McCutchen** (1-for-3, 1R, 2BB) walked in the first and second innings...has 15BB in his last 13G.
- **DH Aaron Judge** (1-for-4, 1R) hit a single in the sixth, his first hit since 7/26 vs. Kansas City.

### BOSTON RED SOX NOTES

- The Red Sox dropped to 0-2 to start their six-game road trip...are 6-3 in their last nine games and 13-7 in their last 19...their magic number to clinch the division remains at two...clinched just their third series loss in their last 22 series since the start of July, going 14-3-5 in series play...fell to 23-29 when hitting 0HR.
- Fell to 8-7 vs. the Yankees this season...have lost three straight games at Yankee Stadium (since 7/1) and are 2-6 at the Stadium this season...are 6-16 in their last 22 games in the Bronx (since 7/17/16)...have been held to 2R-or-fewer in seven of their last 10 games at Yankee Stadium...have not homered in their last three games in the Bronx (since 7/1).
- **Red Sox batters** went 1-for-5 with RISP tonight...are 2-for-15 through the first two games of the series with RISP...have stranded 17 baserunners.
- **Red Sox pitchers** allowed 10R for the fifth time this season, with two-of-five coming against the Yankees (also 7/1 at Yankee Stadium).
- **LHP David Price** (5.1IP, 5H, 6R/4ER, 4BB, 2K, 3HR) had his 11-start unbeaten streak snapped tonight...tied his season high with 4BB (fourth time, last on 5/28 vs. Toronto)...had just 4BB in his last 37.1IP (since 8/11)...had his streak of 10 starts of allowing 3ER-or-fewer snapped.
- Allowed his third, fourth and fifth home runs since the All-Star break tonight...had not allowed a home run in his last 15.1IP (since the second inning on 8/29 vs. Miami)...was his first start since 7/12 vs. Toronto giving up multiple home runs...has allowed multiple home runs in five starts this season, with two coming against the Yankees.
- Has given up 9HR in four starts vs. the Yankees this season and 15HR in his last eight starts vs. the Yankees (since 9/17/16)...seven different Yankees have homered off him this season.
- Fell to 0-3 with a 10.34 ERA (15.2IP, 18ER) in four starts vs. the Yankees this season, and 0-2 with a 12.46 ERA (8.2IP, 12ER) in two starts at Yankee Stadium.
- Since joining the Red Sox in 2016, is 0-6 with a 9.79 ERA (30.1IP, 33ER) in six starts at Yankee Stadium and 2-7 with a 7.71 ERA (58.1IP, 50ER) in 11 overall starts vs. the Yankees.
- **RF J.D. Martinez** (3-for-3) had his Major League-leading 57<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season tonight.
- Has hit safely in six straight games vs. the Yankees (since 8/2)...is hitting .339/.369/.610 (20-for-59) with 8R, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 3HR and 16RBI in 15 games vs. the Yankees this season...has three 3H games vs. the Yankees this season.
- **DH Eduardo Núñez** (2-for-4, 1R, 1 double) has hit safely in six consecutive games, batting .400 (8-for-20) over the span.
- **RHP Joe Kelly** (0.1IP, 3H, 2ER) has allowed runs in three of his last five outings (since 9/7), pitching to a 20.25 ERA (2.2IP, 6ER) over the span.
- **Red Sox relievers** have a 6.95 ERA (44.0IP, 34ER) vs. the Yankees this season, compared to a 3.30 ERA (488.0IP, 179ER) vs. all other opponents.
- **LF Sam Travis** was removed from tonight's game due to precautionary reasons after colliding with the outfield wall and will be evaluated further.
