GREETINGS FROM GOODYEAR

» The Cleveland Indians return to the Goodyear Development Complex for their 10th year of Spring Training in the Cactus League...after 16 seasons in Winter Haven, Florida from 1993-2008, the Tribe became the 14th organization to make its Spring Training home in Arizona beginning in 2009, while the Cincinnati Reds made it an even 15-15 split of teams between the Cactus and Grapefruit circuits after joining the Indians here in Goodyear for the 2010 campaign.

» Cleveland is 145-137-24 (.514) all-time in the Cactus League.

TODAY'S MATCHUP VS. SAN FRANCISCO

» The Indians play host to a split-squad Giants club today in the first of two Cactus League matchups between the teams...the Tribe will travel to Scottsdale to take on San Francisco March 19.

» The two clubs have played 19 all-time Cactus League contests to a draw, going 9-9-1 against each other...the Giants were victorious in two of the three spring contests between the clubs in 2017, and Cleveland has overall dropped four of their last five against San Francisco.

» The Indians and Giants saw their first regular-season action since 2014 when they played a three-game set at AT&T Park in July 2017...San Francisco took two out of three contests, dropping Cleveland's record against their Interleague foes to 5-10 (.333) all-time...the Indians have lost eight of their last nine regular-season games against the Giants, all coming in San Francisco (have not met at Progressive Field since 2008).

» Under MLB's current Interleague rotation, the two teams are not scheduled to meet again in regular season play until 2020.

ATHLETIC TRAINER'S TABLE

» **OF MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (Oct. 18 right ankle surgery) is unrestricted offensively, as he has been a full participant in BP and cage-work; continues to progress toward full baseball activity, and began working on defensive lateral movements on Friday...he will take a day off today from activities.

» **OF BRANDON GUYER** (Oct. 11 extensor tendon surgery) re-aggravated his left wrist injury; received an MRI on Feb. 22 and began his return to baseball activities on Tuesday...he continues to progress and hit off a tee on Friday.

» **RHP DANNY SALAZAR** (right shoulder inflammation) remains a few weeks behind in his throwing program; he has progressed to throwing 90 feet.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians extended their Cactus League winning streak to five games as they turned in a commanding 9-4 victory over Texas...marks the club's longest winning streak in spring since winning their final five Cactus League contests in 2016 (March 29-April 2; including a tie, finished 7-0-1 in final eight games).

» The Tribe offense cranked out 12 hits, reaching double digits for a sixth straight game (seven times total in nine contests)...seven of those 12 hits went for extra bases, including three home runs.

» **C ROBERTO PÉREZ** opened the scoring with an RBI double in the bottom of the 2nd inning...he tacked on a solo homer, his first of the spring, in the 6th inning and was 2-for-3 on the afternoon.

» **2B JASON KIPNIS** continued his torrid start to spring, breaking a 2-2 tie in the 5th inning with a three-run homer, his fourth longball in just 11 at-bats.

» **OF ABRAHAM ALMONTE** also homered for Cleveland, launching a solo shot for his first spring homer in the 6th inning...**OF LONNIE CHISENHALL** was 2-for-3 with a pair of run-scoring hits, including an RBI double in the 5th.

» **RHP TREVOR BAUER** was effective in his second start of the spring, allowing one run on three hits over 3.0 innings of work, fanning four batters...**RHP CARLOS CARRASCO** and **LHP ANDREW MILLER** each allowed a run in their 1.0-inning spring debuts, while **RHP CODY ALLEN** worked a 1-2-3 inning in his.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

» The Indians currently have a total of 64 players in Major League camp; this includes 24 non-roster invitees in addition to players on the 40-man roster.

» The club has 31 pitchers, including 24 right-handers (11 non-roster) and 7 lefties (3 non-roster), 6 catchers (2 non-roster), 17 infielders (5 non-roster) and 10 outfielders (3 non-roster).

MEDIA INFORMATION: The Press Room at the Goodyear Complex opens at 7:30AM on game days...The Indians clubhouse is open to members of the media with proper credentials for roughly 50 minutes prior to morning workouts and again from 11:15AM-Noon on game days...The clubhouse may close at certain times for team meetings, etc...For all games played at Goodyear Ballpark, a shuttle is available from the Indians Player Development Complex to Goodyear Ballpark beginning at NOON and will run for approximately 30 minutes after the final out...Goodyear Ballpark media dining room is located behind the press box and serves lunch for \$7 on game days...While the game is in progress, upon request, players that have been removed from the game can be made available near the Indians clubhouse located in the RF corner after exiting the game...Indians Manager Terry Francona will be available every morning around 9:10AM (subject to change) in the Press Room.

ON THE MOUND: JOSH TOMLIN

» Indians **RHP JOSH TOMLIN** is set to take the mound for his second spring start of 2018...he made his Cactus League debut on February 26 at Milwaukee, working 2.0 scoreless innings (1H, 2K).

» Tomlin's last appearance against San Francisco came on July 17, 2017...earning the win at AT&T Park, Tomlin pitched into the 8th inning, allowing three runs on six hits with no walks and five strikeouts in a 5-3 Tribe victory.

» In 2017, Tomlin enjoyed another solid campaign in the Tribe rotation, leading MLB in fewest walks per 9.0IP (0.89) by walking 14 of 585 batters faced in 141.0IP...overall posted a 10-9 record with a 4.98 ERA (78ER/141.0IP) in 26 starts...after starting the season 4-9 with a 6.17 ERA through July 1, Tomlin did not drop another decision, finishing the year 6-0 with a 3.11 ERA in his final 10 starts of 2017...earned the victory in Game 2 of the 2017 ALDS, entering in the 12th inning working 2.0 perfect frames as the Tribe went on to win 9-8.

» Tomlin started three times during the Indians' 22-game win streak, going 2-0 with a 2.76 ERA (5ER/16.1IP)...also extended his club record streak of 129 consecutive starts allowing three-or-fewer walks...his streak is 3rd longest in MLB history...missed time on the disabled list from July 31-August 31 with a left hamstring strain.

TRIBE ON TOP

» **INF JASON KIPNIS** continues to impress in early Cactus League action, tying for the MLB lead with four home runs in just 11 spring at-bats...his .636 batting average (7-11) is T3rd in MLB among players with at least 10 at-bats, while his eight RBI also rank T3rd.

» **INF RICHIE SHAFFER** holds the team lead with nine RBI (2nd in MLB), as three of his four hits have gone for at least three bases (1 3B, 2 HR).

» **RHP TREVOR BAUER** leads the team with seven strikeouts (T4th in the Cactus League) and has thrown a team-high 5.0 innings (tied with **RHP STEPHEN FIFE**)...**RHP ZACH McALLISTER** paces the Tribe with 4.0 scoreless innings.

» The Tribe as a team lead MLB in virtually every offensive category, including batting average (.337), runs (75), hits (115), doubles (25), triples (5, T1st), home runs (17), RBI (74), slugging percentage (.589), on-base percentage (.406) and OPS (.995)...not to be outdone, the Tribe pitching staff's 3.71 ERA ranks 2nd in the Cactus League, while their 75 strikeouts are T6th.

COMING SOON

» **RHP COREY KLUBER** is slated to make his second start of the spring as the Tribe head to Maryvale to face the Milwaukee Brewers in tomorrow's contest...Kluber allowed one run on one hit (1BB, 3K) over 2.0 innings in his spring debut vs. Oakland on February 27.

#46 - RHP MATT BELISLE: Signed with the Tribe on Feb. 25 and is in camp as a non-roster invitee...spent last season with Minnesota, where he went 2-2 with a 4.03 ERA (27ER/60.1IP) in 62 games...tied career best (fourth time) with four SO in relief on May 28 vs. TB...did not allow earned run in 14 consecutive appearances (15.1IP) July 1-August 9, a new career high...was the Twins' primary closer for the second half of the season, and converted 9 of 11 save opportunities in the role...ranks ninth among active pitchers with 660 career appearances.
