#### TODAY IN YANKEES HISTORY

**Oct. 8, 1960:** Bobby Richardson sets a World Series record (since tied by Hideki Matsui, Albert Pujols and Addison Russell) with 6RBI in Game 3 vs. Pittsburgh, hitting a grand slam in the first inning and a two-run single in the fourth inning of a 10-0 Yankees win.

**Oct. 8, 1956:** Don Larsen throws the only perfect game in MLB postseason history as the Yankees take a 3-games-to-2 lead over the Brooklyn Dodgers with a 2-0 victory in Game 5 of the World Series.

#### TOMORROW IN YANKEES HISTORY

**Oct. 9, 1996:** Derek Jeter hits a controversial home run in Game 1 of the ALCS at Yankee Stadium, as a young fan reaches over the wall and deflects the ball. Jeter's home run ties the game at 4-4 in the eighth inning, and Bernie Williams later leads off the 11th with a "walk-off" homer.

**Oct. 9, 1977:** The Yankees rally for one run in the eighth inning and three in the ninth for a 5-3, series-clinching win in the decisive Game 5 of the ALCS at Kansas City.

**Oct. 9, 1961:** Hector Lopez homers and drives in five runs during a 13-5 win at Cincinnati, wrapping up a 4-games-to-1 victory for the Yankees' 19th World Series title.

**ON TO THE NEXT ONE:** The Yankees are tied at one game apiece in their best-of-five ALDS vs. Boston...the series shifts to the Bronx for Game 3 tonight...are 2-1 in their 54th postseason in club history.

▶ Marks their 20th appearance in the ALDS, their 19th in 24 postseasons since the playoffs were expanded to eight teams in 1995 (for full list, see p. 145 of Yankees' 2018 Postseason Media Guide or p. 326 of 2018 Media Guide)...are 12-7 in 19 series in the ALDS.

**TURNING POINT:** When entering ALDS Game 3 tied 1-1, the Yankees have gone 6-4 in Game 3 (2-1 at home, 4-3 on the road)...won in 2012 after losing in 2005, '06 and '11...in those 10 ALDS, the team that won Game 3 has won 9-of-10 series (the Yankees lost 1997 ALDS vs. Cleveland after winning Game 3)...are 13-6 all-time in ALDS Game 3's (5-2 at home, 8-4 on the road).

▶ Have advanced in six of the seven ALDS in which they lost Game 1 (advanced in 1996, 2000-01, '03-04, '17; did not in 2007).

**WHERE WE LEFT OFF:** The Yankees won Game 2 of the ALDS on Saturday at Boston, 6-2, leveling the series at a game apiece...**RHP Masahiro Tanaka** (5.0IP, 3H, 1ER, 1BB, 4K, 1HR) retired 15-of-19 batters to earn the win...**C Gary Sánchez** (2-for-5, 2R, 2HR, 4RBI) recorded his first postseason multi-HR game...**RF Aaron Judge** (2-for-4, 2R, 1HR, 1RBI, 1BB) homered for the third straight game to begin the 2018 postseason...**1B Luke Voit** (0-for-2) walked three times...**LF Andrew McCutchen** (1-for-5) collected his first career postseason RBI with a second-inning single off the Green Monster...**Yankees relievers** allowed 1ER in 4.0IP (2H, 2BB, 2K).

**SEEING RED:** The ALDS marks only the fourth time that the Yankees will face the Red Sox in a postseason series (won 1999 ALCS, won 2003 ALCS, lost 2004 ALCS)...the Yankees are 12-9 in 21 postseason games (6-4 at home, 6-5 in Boston).

▶ Is the first postseason meeting of 100-win teams prior to the World Series since 1977, when the Yankees defeated Kansas City in the ALCS...is the second consecutive postseason with a matchup of 100-win teams, following the 2017 World Series between Houston and Los Angeles-NL.

▶ The ALDS Game 2 win snapped a streak of five consecutive postseason losses vs. Boston.

**TANAKA TIME:** With his win in ALDS Game 2, **RHP Masahiro Tanaka** improved to 3-2 with a 1.50 ERA (30.0IP, 17H, 5ER, 7BB, 25K, 3HR) in five career postseason starts...is the Majors' third-lowest postseason ERA (min. 5GS) since earned runs became an official statistic in 1913, behind only Sandy Koufax (0.95) and Wild Bill Hallahan (1.36).

**OLD FACE, NEW PLACE:** *Elias* confirms that with Nathan Eovaldi starting tonight, this marks the seventh time that a former Yankees pitcher will make a postseason start against the Yankees as a visitor, joining Cleveland's Jake Westbrook (in the 2007 ALDS), the Mets' Al Leiter (in the 2000 World Series), Kansas City's Larry Gura (in the 1977 ALCS) and the Milwaukee Braves' Lew Burdette (3x: once in the 1958 World Series, twice in the 1957 World Series).

**HOME COOKING:** The Yankees are 7-0 at Yankee Stadium in the last two postseasons...marks the fourth time in franchise history that they have won at least seven consecutive home postseason games (10 straight over 1998-2000, eight straight over 1927-36, seven straight over 1937-41)...are 19-9 in 28 postseason games at the current Yankee Stadium.

▶ Is tied for the Majors' longest postseason home winning streak since Philadelphia won eight straight from 2008 ALDS Game 1 to 2009 ALDS Game 1.

▶ With a 53-28 (.654) regular season record at Yankee Stadium, the Yankees had the second-best home record in the Majors in 2018 (Boston, 57-24, .704)...was their second-best record in a season at the current Yankee Stadium (57-24 in 2009).

**ALL RISE: RF Aaron Judge** went 2-for-4 with 2R, 1BB and a first-inning solo HR in ALDS Game 2 at Boston.

▶ Has homered in all 3G this postseason, joining Hank Bauer (1958 World Series Games 1-3) as the only Yankees to homer in each of the team's first three postseason games in a year (note: Johnny Mize homered in 1952 World Series Games 3-5 after missing the first 2G of the Series).

▶ Is the eighth postseason HR streak of at least 3G in Yankees history, and the first since Alex Rodriguez in 2009 ALCS Games 2-4 (3G)...the others: Reggie Jackson (4G in 1977-78), Lou Gehrig (4G in 1928-32), Bernie Williams (1996, 2001), Hank Bauer (1958), Johnny Mize (1952)...no Yankee has homered in four straight games in a single postseason...has homered in five of his last seven postseason games (since 2017 ALCS Game 4)...hit just 1HR in his final 17 regular season games (since 7/23).

▶ Also hit 4HR in the 2017 postseason...is the second Yankee to hit at least three postseason HRs in consecutive years (Reggie Jackson: 5HR in 1977, 4HR in 1978).

▶ Is one of 10 players all-time to hit at least 7HR in his first 16 postseason games (one of two Yankees – Bernie Williams-7HR).

▶ 11 of his 16 career postseason hits are extra-base hits, including nine of his last 12...is the third Yankee to record at least 11XBH in his first 16 postseason games (Lou Gehrig-12, Bernie Williams-12).

▶ Is hitting .583/.643/1.417 (7-for-12) with 5R, 1 double, 3HR, 4RBI and 2BB in 3G this postseason...is the third player to begin a postseason with 3G with at least 2H and 1HR, joining St. Louis' Matt Carpenter in 2014 and the Yankees' Hank Bauer in 1958.

▶ Is batting .267/.380/.683 (16-for-60) with 14R, 4 doubles, 7HR, 15RBI and 11BB in 16 postseason games...his 1.064 OPS is the third-highest among active players (min. 50PA), behind Chris Young (1.138) and A.J. Ellis (1.065).

▶ In seven postseason games at Yankee Stadium, is hitting .375/.500/1.042 (9-for-24) with 9R, 4 doubles, 4HR, 12RBI and 6BB...is tied with Robinson Canó (4HR in 20G) for the most postseason HRs at the current Yankee Stadium...has at least 1XBH and 1RBI in five straight postseason home games.

**THE SANCHINO:** **C Gary Sánchez** hit 2HR and had 4RBI in ALDS Game 2 at Boston...is the second Yankees catcher to hit multiple HRs in a postseason game, joining Yogi Berra, who hit 2HR in the 1956 World Series-clinching Game 7 win at Brooklyn on 10/10/56...is one of only 10 catchers with a postseason multi-HR game in Major League history.

▶ Was just the fourth multi-HR game by a right-handed batter in Yankees postseason history, joining Chad Curtis (1999 WS Game 3 vs. Atlanta), Scott Brosius (1998 WS Game 3 at San Diego) and Tony Lazzari (1932 WS Game 4 at Chicago-NL).

▶ In 16 postseason games, is batting .203 (13-for-64) with 7R, 2 doubles, 5HR and 12RBI...are the most HRs as a catcher through 16 postseason games in Major League history.

▶ Has 4HR in his last 7G overall (since 9/25), hitting .261/.414/.826 (6-for-23) with 6R, 1 double, 9RBI, 5BB and 1HP.

**BRONX BOMBERS:** **Yankees batters** have hit 6HR in their first 3G this postseason...broke the single-season Major League home run record with 267HR in 2018, surpassing the 1997 Mariners (264HR)...also broke the Yankees' previous club record of 245HR in 2012.

▶ Hit 2HR in the AL Wild Card Game and have hit 11HR in seven postseason home games in 2017-18...hit a Yankees-record 144HR at home in 2018 (81G), tied for the fifth-highest home HR total in Major League history.

**PEN PALS:** **Yankees relievers** have posted a 1.80 ERA (15.0IP, 9H, 3ER, 5BB/11BB, 13K, 1HR) in three postseason games...have a .176 opponents' BA (9-for-51).

**FAN FAVORITES:** The Yankees (3,482,865 total / 42,998 per game) ranked second in the Majors in total and average attendance in 2018 to the Dodgers (3,857,500 / 47,043).

▶ Drew 3 million fans for the MLB-record 20th straight year.

#68 DELLIN BETANCES—RHP

- Is making his third career postseason (2015, '17-18)...has tossed 2.0 innings in each of his appearances this postseason...threw 2.0 innings-or-more only three times during the 2018 regular season...retired all 6BF to earn the win in Wednesday's Wild Card Game vs. Oakland (2.0IP, 3K).

#53 ZACH BRITTON—LHP

- Has made the postseason for the third time in his career (2014, '16 and '18)...has appeared in all three playoff games for the Yankees this season.

#54 AROLDIS CHAPMAN—LHP

- Has made the postseason for the sixth time in his career (2010, '12 and '13 w/ the Reds, '16 w/ the Cubs, '17-18 w/ the Yankees)...won the 2016 World Series w/ the Cubs...has a 0.90 ERA (10.0IP, 1ER) with 19K in eight postseason games as a Yankee.

#57 CHAD GREEN—RHP

- Has made the postseason for the second time in his career (also 2017)...made his playoff debut in 2017 AL Wild Card Game win (2.0IP, 1H, 1ER, 2BB, 4K)...became the first Yankee to strike out his first four playoff batters faced and first Major League pitcher to do so since Colorado's Jeff Francis in 2007 NLDS Game 1 at Philadelphia.

#56 JONATHAN HOLDER—RHP

- Will be making his postseason debut.

#36 LANCE LYNN—LHP

- Has made his sixth trip to the postseason (also 2011-15 w/ St. Louis).

#30 DAVID ROBERTSON—RHP

- Has made the postseason for the sixth time in his career, all with the Yankees (2009-12, '17-18)...has held opponents scoreless in 23-of-29 career playoff relief apps.

#71 STEPHEN TARPLEY—LHP

- Is making a postseason roster for the first time in his career.

YANKEES AT BOSTON

POSTSEASON TRENDS/FACTS: The Yankees are 1-1 in their current ALDS vs. Boston... IN POSTSEASON: This is the fourth time the clubs are meeting in the postseason and the first time in a Division Series...are 12-9 in games and 2-1 in series (2004 ALCS, 3-4; 2003 ALCS, 4-3; 1999 ALCS, 4-1).

REGULAR SEASON TRENDS/FACTS: In 2018, the Yankees went 9-10 vs. the Red Sox (6-3 at Yankee Stadium, 3-7 at Fenway Park)...are 23-18 in 41G vs. Boston since 9/27/16... SEASON SERIES: Have won four of the last seven season series (2012-18)...have lost just five of 19 season series between the clubs since 2000, going 11-5-3 over the span... AT FENWAY PARK: The Yankees went 3-7 at Fenway Park in 2018...are just 10-19 at Fenway Park since the start of 2016, but are 33-32 there since the start of 2012...have won 9-of-15 series at Fenway Park since the start of 2014 (9-5-1)...are 500-483-4 (.509) all-time at Fenway Park, the only visiting AL team with a winning record there... AT YANKEE STADIUM: Went 6-3 at Yankee Stadium vs. Boston this year...have won at least six games between the clubs in the Bronx in five of the last seven seasons...are 16-7 in the Bronx since 7/17/16 and 50-44 at the current Yankee Stadium, their most losses to any team at the Stadium.
