SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Robbie Erlin** tallied a career-high tying seven strikeouts in tonight's contest (6x, last: April 12, 2016 at PHI)...has posted a 3.56 ERA (17 ER, 43.0 IP) with 35 strikeouts against five walks across 13 appearances (six starts) since July 1.
- **Hunter Renfro** logged his fifth career multi-home run game and first of this season (last: Sept. 20, 2017 vs. ARI)...is riding a career-high nine-game hitting streak, batting .368 (14-for-38) over that span with two doubles, five home runs and 11 RBI since August 23 at COL.
 - Has four multi-homer games at Petco Park, tying Adrian Gonzalez and Justin Upton for the most of any player.
- **Franmil Reyes** is riding a career-high seven-game hitting streak, batting .400 (8-for-20) with four home runs in that time...is hitting .391 (9-for-23) in his career vs. COL.
- **Wil Myers** is batting .346 (9-for-26) with three doubles, one home run and two walks in his career vs. Jon Gray.
 - Logged his 17th double of the season.
- **Eric Hosmer** has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 home games, batting .333 (17-for-51).
- **Travis Jankowski** snapped his hitting streak of 14-straight games, which is the longest such streak by a Padre this season.

COLORADO NOTES

- **Jon Gray** has gone 4-0 with a 3.08 ERA (21 ER, 61.1 IP), 11 walks and 45 strikeouts in nine starts since being recalled from Triple-A Albuquerque on July 14...in 15 career starts vs. the Padres, owns a 8-3 record with a 2.69 ERA (27 ER, 90.1 IP), 15 walks and 112 strikeouts...his wins, starts, innings and strikeouts are career highs against any opponent.
 - Allowed a season-high tying two home runs (2x, last: Aug. 27 at LAA).
- **DJ LeMahieu** recorded his 13th homer of the season, which snapped the Rockies 21.0-inning scoreless streak (since 6th inning on Thursday)...his home run also ended the club's 28.0-inning extra-base hit drought (dating back to the 7th inning on Aug. 28 at LAA) and snapped his personal 0-for-14 streak at the plate.
- **Matt Holliday** is riding a five-game hitting streak, going 6-for-13 (.462) with a home run and two RBI in that time.
- **Trevor Story** is batting .356 on the road since June 6, going 52-for-146, hitting safely in 31 of those 37 contests.
 - Tallied his 37th double of the season...entering the game, his 36 doubles ranked third in the National League.
- **Nolan Arenado** went 2-for-4 tonight...his single in the fourth inning snapped his career-high tying 0-for-19 hitless streak (also went 0-for-19 from June 8-15 of this year).
