NATIONALS NEWS

WHISPERING SWEEP NOTHINGS

After taking the first two games of this series, the Washington Nationals look to complete their first home sweep of 2018 this afternoon...Washington last swept Atlanta, April 18-20, 2017 at ATL...Washington's last home sweep over the Braves came Sept. 5-7, 2016.

- The Nationals will cap this 10-game homestand by welcoming the Colorado Rockies to town for a four-game set starting Thursday.

ROSTER MOVES

Prior to today's game the Nationals recalled from rehab and reinstated catcher **Matt Wieters** from the 10-day disabled list and selected the contract of outfielder **Moisés Sierra**...They placed outfielder **Adam Eaton** on the 10-day disabled list (retroactive to April 9) with a bone bruise to his left ankle and designated catcher **Miguel Montero** for assignment.

A PAIR OF ACES

Mired in a five-game losing streak, the Nationals received tremendous outings from **Max Scherzer** on Monday and **Stephen Strasburg** on Tuesday helping the Nationals snap the losing streak.

- **Max Scherzer** tossed his ninth career complete game (fifth career shutout) on Monday night against Atlanta...He capped his evening with a strikeout of **Ender Inciarte**, giving him 10 strikeouts for the second time this season and the 66th time in his career.
- **Stephen Strasburg** allowed just three hits while striking out eight batters and walking two in 8.0 shutout innings on Tuesday...It was his longest outing since Sept. 10, 2017 at PHI (8.0 IP).

HOT STARTS

The Nationals have scored two runs in the first inning of each of the last three games...For the season, Washington's offense has scored at least one run in the first inning in nine of 11 games...In total, the Nationals have scored 18 runs in the first inning, ahead of the Arizona Diamondbacks (15) for the most in Major League Baseball.

HARPER'S HOMERS

Bryce Harper clubbed his sixth home run of the season on Sunday, a two-run shot in the first inning off **Matt Harvey**...His six home runs lead Major League Baseball, as do his 16 walks, .529 on-base percentage, .879 slugging percentage and 1.408 OPS...He is tied for second in MLB with 12 RBI.

- Of his 11 hits this season, six have been home runs...Moreover, Harper has 16 walks and just five strikeouts through the first 11 games of the season.

TONY! TONY! TONY!

Anthony Rendon has recorded multi-hit efforts in three of his last five games, going 8-for-18 (.444) with four doubles, one RBI, two walks and one run scored...He has hit safely in 10 of 11 games this season.

VOTE FOR PEDRO

Since being recalled on April 2, **Pedro Severino** has reached base safely in 13 of 25 plate appearances (.520 OBP, 7 H, 2 HBP, 4 BB)...He has hit safely in five of his seven games played...In six starts, he is hitting .389 (7-for-18) with two doubles, three RBI, four walks, one stolen base and two runs scored...He has recorded two multi-hit efforts and driven in runs in three of the six starts.

HOWIE'S DOIN' IT

Howie Kendrick has reached base safely in each of his first nine games of the season...He has hit safely in eight of the games and he was hit by a pitch on April 4 at Atlanta while serving as a pinch hitter...Kendrick has recorded four multi-hit efforts along the way, while five of his 12 hits have been doubles.

NO INHERITANCE TAX

Nationals relievers have allowed just two of 13 inherited runners to score this season...Their 15.4% inherited runners scored percent is fifth-best in the National League...They are one of five teams to allow two or fewer inherited runners to score.

STOLEN MOMENTS

Washington stole five bases on Saturday, the most in a game since July 27, 2017 vs. CHI and tied for the fourth most in a single game in Nationals history (2005-pres)...The Nationals lead MLB with 15 stolen bases.

- **Trea Turner** leads the National League (tied for 2nd in MLB) with five stolen bases this season.
- **Michael A. Taylor** ranks tied for second in the NL and is tied for fourth in MLB with four stolen bases.

NATIONALS HISTORY

April 11 (5-7 on this date)

2010 - A **Josh Willingham** grand slam in the top of the first was all of the offense the Nationals would need to top the Mets, 5-2 at Citi Field. Willingham also doubled and drove in a run in the third inning, finishing the day with five RBI. **Livan Hernandez** earned the win, tossing 7.0 innings of five-hit, shutout ball.

Dave Martinez capped his 16-year Major League career with Atlanta in 2001, hitting .287 in 12 games...**Matt Adams** clubbed 19 home runs in 100 games for the Braves in 2017...The Braves made Nationals Pitching Coach **Derek Lilliquist** their first-round selection (6th overall) back in the 1987 Amateur Draft.

THE SERIES

The Nationals went 10-9 against the Braves in 2017...Since 2015, Washington is 42-20 against Atlanta.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#22 - A.J. COLE - RHP

Tall right-hander has provided depth to Washington's starting rotation since making his debut in 2015...Has made 17 starts and five appearances out of the bullpen in his Major League career...Was dealt to Oakland in Dec. of 2012 in a deal that rendered Gio Gonzalez...Was then reacquired by Mike Rizzo as Michael Morse was dealt to OAK as part of three-team trade in Jan. of 2013.

AGAINST THE BRAVES: Has a 19.96 ERA in three appearances (two starts) against the Braves in his career...Made his first career start on April 28, 2015 at Turner Field (2.0 IP, 9 R, 4 ER, 9 H, BB, SO) and the Nationals came away with the 13-12 victory...His one relief appearance against the Braves came on Sept. 27, 2017 (2.0 IP, 3 ER, 5 H) in an 8-0 loss at Nationals Park.

LAST START: Made his first start of the season on April 3 at Atlanta...Allowed 10 earned runs on 10 hits in 3.2 innings of work...Clubbed his first career home run, a solo blast in the second inning off **Julio Teheran**.

2017 NOTES

- Posted a career-best 3.81 ERA across four Major League stints with the Washington Nationals.
- Began the season with Triple-A Syracuse before being recalled on May 2.
- Made first MLB start of 2017 on May 6 at PHI (6.0 IP, 6 H, ER, 2 SO).
- Capped 2017 strong, posting a 2.42 ERA (6 ER/22.1 IP) in his last four MLB starts...Tossed 3.2 IP of no-hit, shutout relief on Sept. 30 vs. PIT.
- Matched a career-high with eight strikeouts in his strongest start of the season, Aug. 25 vs. NYM (6.0 IP, 4 H, ER, 4 BB, 8 SO).
- Improved his ground ball percentage to 43.3% (up from 31.9% in 2016).
- Made four Minor League starts before his May 2 recall, striking out 14 and limiting opponents to two earned runs in two of his four starts.
- In four Triple-A starts from May 20 to June 8, went 2-1 with a 2.81 ERA (8 ER/25.2 IP).
- Allowed two earned runs in four of his final six Minor League starts.

2016 NOTES

- Made a career-high 30 total starts (22 with Triple-A Syracuse, 8 with Washington).
- Was promoted to Washington on Aug. 22... At the time of his promotion, led the Syracuse pitching staff in wins (8) and complete games (2).
- In five Minor-league starts from July 16-Aug. 11, he posted a 2.80 ERA (11 ER/35.1 IP), 8.4 strikeouts per nine innings and a 5.50 strikeout-to-walk ratio (33 SO/6 BB).
- Tossed at least 7.0 innings in five straight starts between Syracuse and Washington from July 22 to Aug. 22.
- Earned his first MLB win, Sept. 2 at NYM (6.0 IP, 3 H, ER, 2 BB, 5 SO).
- Recorded a career-high eight strikeouts on two occasions, Aug. 22 vs. Baltimore and Sept. 8 vs. Philadelphia.
- Struck out 9.2 batters per nine innings in his first extended Major League action (39 SO/38.1 IP).
- Following the season, was rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 20 prospect in the International League.
