### 2018 SEASON

Added to **Los Angeles Angels** 25-man roster on June 28.

In 29 games for Triple-A **Salt Lake**, owns a 3-0 record with a 4.39 ERA (47.2 IP - 24 ER) while recording six saves and 55 strikeouts...Has held right-handed hitters to a .202 average.

In month of June, appeared in 10 games, allowing nine hits across 13.0 IP and recording four saves...Held opponents to a .200 average for the month.

At the time he was called up to the Majors, had helped Bees to 44-35 record and first place in the Southern Division of the Pacific Coast League.

Signed minor league contract with the **Los Angeles Angels** on Mar. 5...Assigned to Triple-A **Salt Lake**.

### 2017 SEASON

Made Major League debut on Aug. 9 vs. the Yankees...Struck out Aaron Judge for first career strikeout...Recorded one inning in relief, allowing six hits, one walk and four earned runs.

In debut, broke his toe on a comebacker from Didi Gregorius...Placed on the DL for the remainder of the season.

Went a combined 0-0, with a 0.00 ERA (12.2 IP - 0 ER) with 16 strikeouts, two walks, and six hits allowed in nine games across three minor league levels of the Toronto system.

Started season on the disabled list and began rehab assignment with GCL Blue Jays on July 5...Started three games, pitching a combined 4.0 innings and recording six strikeouts.

Promoted to Single-A **Dunedin**, on July 16...Made two appearances, one start and one in relief...Scattered four hits across 3.0 IP and tallied four strikeouts.

On July 21, was moved to Triple-A **Buffalo**...Appeared four times (all in relief), and did not allow a hit through 5.2 IP...Contract selected by the **Toronto Blue Jays** on Aug. 5.

## PERSONAL:

- William Deck McGuire.
- Attended Deep Run High School in Glen Allen, Virginia.
- Played baseball in high school and lettered four years in football as starting quarterback...Established school records for strikeouts in a game (17), strikeouts in a season (129) and strikeouts in a career (320).
- Pitched three seasons at Georgia Tech where he went 28-7 with 306 strikeouts over 291 innings...Was a Collegiate Baseball first-team Freshman All-American in 2008, first-team All-American in 2009 and third-team All-American in 2010...As a junior, led the ACC in innings pitched (112.1) and strikeouts (118).
- Originally selected by the Blue Jays in the 1st round (11th overall) of the 2010 First-Year Player Draft, the 2nd pitcher (Kevin Brown) and 9th player in Georgia Tech history to be drafted in the 1st round.

## LAST SEASON:

- Played the entire season with Double-A Pensacola where he went 9-9 with a 2.79 ERA (168.0 IP, .208 AVG, 57BB/170K).
- Posted a 1.41 ERA in July, the best of any AA pitcher that month...Was named a Southern League Mid-Season All-Star.
- Finished the year with the league lead in opp. avg., and WHIP (1.08) while ranking 3rd in ERA.
- Allowed 10.06 baserunners per nine innings (2nd fewest among Southern League starters) and recorded 8.89 K/9 (3rd best in the SL).
- Started Game 1 of the SL's Southern Division Championship and earned a 2-0 win vs. Jacksonville...Became Pensacola's 1st pitcher ever to record 8.0 shutout innings with no walks and at least 13 strikeouts.
- Was promoted to the Reds on Sept. 12 and made his **MLB debut** that night in St. Louis (1.2 IP, 1H, 1K)...Came into the game in the 7th inning with the bases loaded and one out...Induced a double play from the 1st batter he faced (Harrison Bader) and then pitched a scoreless 8th inning, which included his 1st career strikeout (Greg Garcia).
- After four scoreless relief appearances (5.2 IP, OBB, 4K), joined Cincinnati's starting rotation.
- In his 1st start on Sept. 26 at MIL, lasted just three innings while allowing six hits and six runs (4ER, HR, 2BB, 5K).
- Earned his 1st career win on Oct. 1 at CHC, hurling 5.0 shutout innings while striking out two batters and allowing just two hits.

## PROFESSIONAL CAREER:

- Started 2011 with Advanced-A Dunedin and was a Mid-Season All-Star...Posted a 2.75 ERA over 19 games before playing his final four contests with Double-A New Hampshire (4.35 ERA).
- Spent all of 2012 with the Fisher Cats and tied for the Eastern League lead in starts...Following the season, pitched for Salt River in the Arizona Fall League (2-1, 3.95 ERA, 13.2 IP, 11K).
- Ranked 14th among Blue Jays prospects by MLB.com entering the 2013 season...Spent the entire year with New Hampshire and led the team with 143 strikeouts...Ranked 2nd in the Eastern League in innings pitched (157.1) and 4th in strikeouts...16 of his 26 starts were quality starts.
- Started 2014 in Double-A and after 10 games with a 2.98 ERA was promoted to Triple-A Buffalo...Went 3-5 with a 5.56 ERA before his trade to the Athletics...Went 2-4 with an 8.05 ERA in seven games for Triple-A Sacramento.

## 2017 SEASON

- Began the season with the Mets...Was optioned to Las Vegas (AAA) of the Pacific Coast League on May 23... Recalled on July 17 and remained with the team the rest of the year.
- Was tied for sixth in the majors among all relievers with seven wins in relief...Was tied for third on the team in victories...Was 6-1 after the game on July 22...Finished the season 1-4.
- Had back-to-back seasons with six or more wins in relief (six wins in 2016)...The last Mets reliever to do that was Dennis Cook (1998-2000).
- Allowed 10 home runs in 56.2 innings.
- Suffered five losses, including three walk-off losses (August 3 at Colorado, August 1 at Colorado and May 15 at Arizona)...Was tied for 10th among NL relievers in losses.
- Lefthanded batters hit .189 (14-74), the 14th-lowest mark in the NL (min. 60 batters faced)...Righthanders hit .246 (33-134).
- Tossed a career-best 14.1 scoreless innings from April 12-May 10...Struck out 16 and allowed seven hits during that stretch.
- Struck out 60 in 56.2 innings (9.53 strikeouts per nine innings).
- Went 4-0 with a 3.00 ERA (11 earned runs/33.0 innings) at home.
- Allowed 12 earned runs in 2.2 innings (40.50 ERA) including four homers in three outings from May 13-21...Was optioned to Las Vegas (AAA) on May 23.
- Pitched in four games for the Dominican Republic in the WBC posting a 2.45 ERA (one earned run/3.2 innings).

## 2016 SEASON

- Made a career-high 68 appearances.
- Had 85 strikeouts in 77.2 innings...Ranked ninth among NL relievers in strikeouts.
- His six relief wins led the Mets bullpen and was tied for fourth in the NL.
- Collected his first major league save with 2.2 scoreless innings on September 23 vs. Philadelphia.
- Worked a career-high 3.2 innings with a career-best six strikeouts on June 21 vs. Kansas City.
- Was suspended the first two games of the year for throwing at Philadelphia's Cameron Rupp on September 30, 2015.

## 2015 SEASON

- Recalled from Las Vegas (AAA) of the Pacific Coast League on April 21 and spent the remainder of the season with the Mets.
- Made his major league debut April 24 at Yankee Stadium with 1.0 scoreless inning while stranding two runners.
