SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Joey Lucchesi** earned his first win since April 28 vs. NYM...has tossed at least 5.0 IP and allowed three runs or less in eight of his 12 starts this season...when he works at least five innings, he has a 2.64 ERA (14 ER, 47.2 IP).
 - Allowed a career-high-tying four walks in tonight's game.
- **Wil Myers** tallied a season-high three RBI and belted his second homer of the season and first since April 2 vs. COL... is hitting .318 (7-for-22) in his last six games with three multi-hit efforts.
- **Christian Villanueva** logged his 10th double of the season...has hit safely in six of his last seven games, batting .304 (7-for-23) during that time.
- **Kirby Yates** extended his career-long scoreless streak to 14.0 innings (12 games), the longest by a Padre since Craig Stammen's 15.0-inning streak (Aug. 17- Sept. 18, 2017).
- **Austin Hedges** snapped his season-high three-game hitting streak.

PITTSBURGH NOTES

- **Gregory Polanco** recorded his second triple of the season...owns an average of .400 (14-for-35) with two home runs in nine career games at Petco Park...extended his hitting streak to five games and is batting .500 (15-for-30) with a .625 OBP in his last 12 games.
- **David Freese** went 2-for-4 tonight and recorded fifth double and sixth multi-hit game of the season... is hitting .286 (34-for-119) in 33 career games against the Padres.
- **Austin Meadows** logged his seventh-career double...has hit safely in 23 of his 29 Major League starts, going 38-for-115 (.330) with five home runs and 13 RBI.
- **Josh Bell** has reached base safely in 18 of his last 19 games and has hit safely in 12 of his last 15 games, batting .286 (14-for-49) over that time.
