



# SAN DIEGO PADRES 2018 GAME NOTES

**STORMIN' IN CINCY:** The Padres fell 12-6 last night to the Cincinnati Reds in Game 2 of the four-game set...the Friars enter today's contest having won six of their last 10 games...last night, starter **Brett Kennedy** worked just 1.2 innings, and while he allowed just one hit, he also allotted four runs (earned) on four walks and a pair of strikeouts... **Eric Hosmer** and **Hunter Renfroe** homered in the contest...Renfroe's two-run shot was his team-leading 21st of the season, and he is chasing his career high of 26, set last season.

**HIS NAME IS ERL:** Among those who have made at least 35 appearances this season, starter **Robbie Erlin** has a .028 walks per batters faced ratio, which is the fourth-best mark in the majors and second in the NL to only WSH's Sean Doolittle (.023)...his 0.99 walks per nine innings is the third-best mark in the majors, behind CLE's Dan Otero (0.70) and Doolittle (0.72).

**ALL GOOD THINGS:** Last night, the Padres bullpen combined to allow 10 hits, the most since they gave up 11 on July 7 @ ARI, and it was just the third time this season in which they allowed eight-or-more earned runs in single game (previous: 10 on July 7 @ ARI)...despite last night, the SD bullpen has the second-best ERA in the NL since the All-Star break (3.44) behind just PIT's 3.12, and they've held opposing bats to a .227 clips in the second half of the season.

**SEEING RED:** The Padres have won three of their last four games against CIN since June 2...they've gone 3-1 vs. the Redlegs this year, and since the start of the 2017 season, the Friars have slashed .288/.329/.489 and have scored an average of 5.3 runs per game vs. CIN, which are their most against any single opponent in that time.

**HOMER HUNTING:** **Hunter Renfroe** has gone 11.07 at bats per homer since the All-Star break, which is the best mark on the Padres, the third-best in the NL (behind Ronald Acuña Jr.'s 10.76 and Matt Carpenter's 10.81) and the fifth-best in the majors...owns a team-leading .895 OPS in the second half of the season.

**WELCOME TO THE GROUNDER GAMES:** At the plate, the Padres rank second in the majors this season in ground ball percentage (47.2) behind MIA's 48.5...on the mound, the Friar hurlers have induced a 45.4 grounder percentage, which is the seventh-best in both the NL and in the ML.

**GETTING AHEAD:** SD relievers lead the major leagues in first-pitch strike percentage (64.0).

**GOING DEEP IN SEPTEMBER:** The Friars have hit 1.50 homers per game in the month of September, which is the fourth-highest rate this month of any NL team (Cincinnati's 1.57 hr/g rank third-most in the NL in that time).

**PADRES ON DECK:** Last night for El Paso (AAA), RHP **Cal Quantrill** allowed two hits and a walk with seven strikeouts over 6.0 scoreless innings to earn the win as Triple-A El Paso scored a 2-0 win in Fresno to stay alive in the Pacific Coast League's Pacific Conference Championship Series...DH **Allen Craig** was 1-for-2 with a walk and a two-run double in the first for the game's only runs, 2B **Carlos Asuaje** was 3-for-4 and RF **Forrestt Allday** went 2-for-5...yesterday, the third game of the best-of-five Double-A Texas League Southern Division Championship Series was suspended by unplayable grounds in the bottom of the 11th at San Antonio with the game tied at 8-8...when play resumes this afternoon, San Antonio (AA) CF **Buddy Reed** will be on second with no one out after walking and stealing second to open the 11th.

## STARTING PITCHER NOTES

**#41 LHP Robbie Erlin (3-5, 3.87)**

**HURLIN' ERLIN:** 27-year-old **Robbie Erlin** is set to make his ninth start of the season and 34th of his career today against the Reds...it'll be his 36th overall appearance this season, having made 27 appearances out of the SD bullpen.

- It'll be his second career appearance and first career start against the Reds...his only other appearance against Cincinnati came earlier this season on 6/1 (1.1 IP, H, ER, HR).

**LAST TIME OUT:** In his last outing on 9/1 vs. COL, he was saddled with the loss in consecutive starts for the second time this season (also: 4/16 vs. LAD and 5/21 vs. WSH)...he allowed four runs (earned) and seven hits across 5.1 IP while striking out a career-high-tying seven (7x) in SD's 4-2 loss.

**ERLIN'S ARSENAL:** This season, he's relied on five pitches: sinker (31.2%), four seamer (29.7%), curve (18.9%), changeup (17%) and slider (3.3%).

**SPIN RATE:** His curveball this season has an average spin rate of 2471 rpm (revolutions per minute), which is the highest spin rate of any pitch in a single season in his career.

**FEW FREE PASSES:** Has walked just 10 of the 359 batters he has faced this season...his 0.99 walks per nine innings this season is the third-best mark of any pitcher this year who has made at least 35 appearances.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** In his last six appearances since August 2, opposing bats have hit .308 vs. Robbie with RISP (8-for-26)...in his career, opponents are hitting .289 (54-for-187) with RISP.

**HOT AS SUMMER:** Since July 1, he has posted a 3.56 ERA (17 er, 43.0 IP) with 35 strikeouts against five walks across 13 appearances (six starts)...he has a 1.12 WHIP in that time, and his 7.00 SO/BB ratio ranks third-best among NL hurlers in that time (with at least 13 appearances).

**GOOD 'PENMANSHIP:** Prior to making six consecutive starts, he worked primarily out of the bullpen earlier this season, making 18 scoreless appearances out of his 27 relief outings and posting a 2.05 ERA (12 er, 52.2 ip) with 44 strikeouts against four walks...Erlin has made five separate long relief outings of at least 3.1 ip, including a career-high scoreless 5.2 ip of relief on May 28 vs. MIA.

**GIVE ME A BREAK:** In his career, Erlin posted a 4.63 ERA (72 er, 140.0 ip) before the All-Star Break...he's settled into a 3.81 mark (42 er, 99.1 ip) in his career post-All-Star Break...this season, he had a 3.83 ERA (23 ER, 54.0 IP) prior to the break, and he's fostered a 3.93 ERA since (16 er, 36.2 ip).

**LONGEST TENURED PADRE:** Erlin was originally acquired by the Padres along with RHP Joe Wieland from the Texas Ranges in exchange for RHP Mike Adams on July 31, 2011...he made his ML debut on April 30, 2013 at CHC...he is the longest tenured pitcher who has appeared for the Padres at the big league level.

**LONG ROAD BACK:** Began the 2016 season with El Paso (AAA) but did not pitch in a game before being called up by SD on April 8, 2016, making three starts before undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery on his left elbow on May 17, 2016.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER — #63 RHP Jacob Nix (2-3, 4.85) — juicy\_jake33

**NIX'N NOD:** RHP **Jacob Nix** is set to make his sixth-career start and his first against the Cincinnati Reds tomorrow...allowed a career-high-tying five runs his last time out on 9/2 vs. COL in SD's 7-3 defeat.

- On Aug. 28 vs. SEA, he tossed 8.1 IP of one-run ball on no strikeouts and no walks, tossing just 79 pitches en route to his second career victory.
- In his Major League debut on Aug. 10 vs. PHI, he worked 6.0 innings of four-hit, scoreless ball, accruing four strikeouts on two walks and leading the Padres to their 2-0 victory over the Phillies, becoming the first Padre to toss 6.0-or-more scoreless innings in his debut since Odrisamer Despaigne on June 23, 2014 @ SF (7.0 innings).
