**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Dodgers continue a three-game set tonight with the second meeting between the clubs this season...Los Angeles will visit SunTrust Park, July 26-29, for four games to complete the teams' season series.

*A* The Braves have lost 11 of their last 14 games here, dating to the start of the 2014 season, after last night's series-opening 7-3 defeat...When factoring in postseason play, the Braves have lost 13 of 16 at Dodger Stadium, as the club dropped game 3 and game 4 of the 2013 Division Series here... Including those two playoff games, the Braves have been outscored 90-57 over this skid.

*A* The last time the Braves took a series at Dodger Stadium was April 23-25, 2012, when Atlanta won two-of-three games.

*A* RHP Aníbal Sánchez is set to face the Dodgers for the first time since 2014...The right-hander is winless in five career games, all starts, against Los Angeles, going 0-1 with a 3.21 ERA.

*A* LHP Alex Wood is set to face the Braves for the fourth time in his career...Wood is 1-2 with a 6.75 ERA (11 ER/14.2 IP) against the Braves... He allowed a career-high nine runs, seven earned, to Atlanta in a 12-3 loss here on July 21, 2017.

**SERIES OPENER:** The Braves dropped their fourth consecutive road series opener last night, losing 7-3 to Los Angeles...The Braves are now .500 at 11-11 in series openers this season, but have gone 12-5-4 in series play.

*A* The Braves did not collect their 12th series win last season until sweeping three games at Oakland, June 30-July 2.

**FREEMAN:** 1B Freddie Freeman collected his N.L. high-tying 19th double of the season, driving home SS Dansby Swanson with a drive to right field off of left-hander Pat Venditte in the sixth inning.

*A* Since Freeman's first full season of 2011, he is third in the majors with 259 two-base hits, trailing only Seattle's Robinson Canó (282) and Washington's Daniel Murphy (271).

*A* Freeman is hitting .368 (32-for-87) against left-handed pitching this season, the best mark by any left-handed batter...Among all hitters, Freeman's average is eighth-best in the majors

*A* Among National Leaguers, Freeman ranks first in on-base percentage (.430) and OPS (.990), tied for first in doubles (19), second in hits (81), fourth in slugging percentage (.560) and tied for seventh in runs scored (39).

**SLUGGING SWANSON:** SS Dansby Swanson collected his 20th extra-base hit of the season last night, doubling in the sixth inning...In seven games this month, Swanson is slugging at a .731 clip.

**OUTFIELD ASSIST:** OF Ender Inciarte collected his third outfield assist of the season last night, helping to get Max Muncy at third base in the seventh inning... Inciarte is one behind right-fielder Nick Markakis for the team lead.

*A* Since entering the league in 2014, Inciarte has 44 assists, the fifth most in the majors and six off the lead of Pittsburgh's Starling Marte.

*A* Markakis is second all-time among active players with 112 outfield assists...The only other active player with triple-digit assists is Melky Cabrera, who has 116.

**TWO-OUT RUNS:** 1B Freddie Freeman drove home SS Dansby Swanson with two outs in the sixth inning last night and the Braves now have a MLB-most 133 two-out runs this season.

*A* The Braves also lead the majors with a .282 batting average and a .368 on-base percentage with two outs.

*A* The club's 81 extra-base hits with two outs also lead the National League.

*A* Among National League qualifiers, Freeman's two-out batting average (.398) and on-base percentage (.491) both rank second.

**VS. LEFTIES:** The Braves are set to face LHP Alex Wood today, the 22nd left-handed starter to oppose the club this season.

*A* The Braves are hitting .272 (176-for-647) against all lefties this season, the best mark in the National League.

*A* Atlanta is averaging a homer every 23.96 at-bats against lefties this season (27 home runs/647 at-bats), and that mark is the third best in baseball... That ratio trails only the Yankees' 20.68 mark and the Cardinals' 22.06 average.

*A* The Braves also have a 5.52 plate appearance per strikeout ratio against left-handers, the best mark in all of baseball.

**VS. THE N.L. WEST:** The Braves dropped to 3-7 against the National League West this season, having won two of three from Colorado in April for their only series win against the division this season...They were swept by San Francisco at SunTrust Park in May before losing two-of-three to San Diego earlier on this road trip.

*A* The Braves went 19-15 against the N.L. West last season for the club's first winning season against the division since 2013...From 2014 through 2016, the Braves went 35-64 (.354) against the N.L. West.

**PICKOFFS:** RHP Brandon McCarthy picked off Yasiel Puig in the first inning last night, giving the Braves 11 total this season...That total is the second most in the majors, and one off the lead of San Diego.

#### Tonight's Game

- A* Makes his fifth start of the season (sixth appearance) and the 267th (290th appearance) of his career.
- A* Is 0-1 with a 3.21 ERA (10 ER/28.0 IP) in five career starts against the Dodgers... Has not faced them since 2014 while with Detroit.
- A* Is winless against just three major league franchises in his career and all three play in California, including both clubs in Los Angeles...Is 0-1 in five career starts against the Dodgers, 0-4 in seven career games versus the Angels, and 0-2 in five turns against the San Diego Padres.
- A* Last started against Los Angeles-NL on 4/9/14 at Dodger Stadium while with the Tigers...Allowed six hits and three runs (one earned) over 5.0 innings in a no-decision.
- A* Has allowed just one earned run in 11.0 career innings at Dodger Stadium (0.82 ERA)...Allowed nine hits and issued five walks in two starts here.
- A* Surrendered a two-run home run to Trea Turner in his last start, 6/3 vs. WSH, to account for the only two runs he allowed on the game...Has allowed 20 home runs in his last 18 appearances.
- A* Among pitchers with at least 75.0 innings since 7/16/17, Sánchez's rate of 2.09 home runs per 9.0 innings is third highest in the majors.
- A* Has allowed two runs or less in four of his five appearances on the season...Atlanta has won each of his last three starts.

#### 2018 Recap

- A* Allowed a pair of unearned runs over a season-most 7.0 innings in his last start, 6/3 vs. WSH...Allowed just four total baserunners.
- A* His 2.01 career ERA (33 ER/147.2 IP) against the Nationals/Expos is the lowest all-time mark by a qualifying pitcher against the franchise...His .900 (9-1) winning percentage is tied for the best mark all-time against the Nationals/Expos (minimum 10 decisions).
- A* Returned from the disabled list, 5/29, and started that night vs. NYM...Allowed five hits and four runs over 4.0 innings in a no-decision.
- A* Missed 37 games after suffering a right hamstring strain on 4/18.
- A* Began a rehabilitation assignment with Triple-A Gwinnett on 5/21 and made two rehab starts with the Stripers...Combined to go 0-1 with a 10.80 ERA (8 ER/6.2 IP).
- A* Suffered a right hamstring strain during pregame warmups on 4/18 and was placed on the 10-day disabled list that night.
- A* Snapped a career-long six-game losing streak, 4/13 at CHI...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts, allowing just three hits and one walk in the Braves' 4-0 shutout of the Cubs.
- A* Went 0-6 with a 6.51 ERA (34 ER/47.0 IP) during the losing streak, which dated to 8/6/17 at BAL and spanned 11 games (10 starts)...Received just 13 runs of support during the stretch, an average of 1.18 runs per turn...Received either one or zero runs of support in eight of the 11 games.
- A* Made his first start of the season and went 5.0 innings and allowed seven hits and two runs, 4/7 at COL...Atlanta lost 3-2 in the 10th inning.
- A* Is undefeated in six career starts against the Rockies...Sánchez is one of nine pitchers in history to make at least five starts against the Rockies and log an ERA under 2.00...Only five of those pitchers -- Sánchez, Jacob deGrom, Tom Koehler, Mark Prior and Bill Swift -- have done so without taking a loss
- A* Made his Braves debut with 3.0 innings of scoreless relief on 4/2 vs. WSH...Allowed one hit and three walks after having his contract selected from Triple-A Gwinnett that afternoon.
- A* Signed by Atlanta to a minor-league contract on 3/16 after spending the bulk of spring training in camp with the Twins...Signed a one-year major league contract with Minnesota on 2/22 before the club granted him his unconditional release on 3/13.
- A* Made two spring starts with Atlanta after signing with the club and went 1-0 with a 5.00 ERA (5 ER/9.0 IP)...Earned the win with 4.0 inning of two-run baseball on 3/18 at HOU in his first appearance with the Braves.
- A* Went 1-1 with a 7.62 ERA (11 ER/13.0 IP) in total on the spring.

#### 2017 Recap

- A* Split the season between Detroit and Triple-A Toledo...Made 28 big league appearances, including 17 starts, and compiled a 3-7 record with a 6.41 ERA (75 ER/105.1IP) and 104 strikeouts.
- A* Surpassed 1,500 career innings with 4.0 innings on 4/26 vs. SEA...His 1592.2 innings pitched in his career are sixth-most by a Venezuelan-born pitcher in MLB history.

#### Career Recap

- A* 2018 marks his 13th major league campaign...Played the first six-and-a-half seasons (2006-12) of his career with the Marlins, before spending the last five-and-a-half seasons (2012-17) with Detroit.
- A* Led the American League with a 2.57 ERA in 2013.

**Season Long Streak:** 8 games, 5/3-5/11 (11-36, .306, 3 HR)

- Has just three hits in his last 31 at-bats...His double in Monday's (6/4) seventh inning at SD snapped a 0-for-16 hitless spell.
- Despite his current offensive slump, still leads the N.L. in extra-base hits (35) and runs (51)...Is tied for the lead in doubles (19) and total bases (135), tied for third in home runs (14) and is tied for ninth in hits (70).
- Ranks tied for second in MLB with nine games with multiple extra-base hits...Is over half way to the Atlanta franchise record for most such games in a season, shared by Chipper Jones and Javy Lopez (17).
- Is hitting .355 (22-for-62) in the first inning this season...His 22 hits and 12 extra base-hits in the first inning are the most in the N.L, while his six home runs are tied for the most in the N.L.
- Set the franchise record for most extra-base hits (22) by the end of April and tied for the second most in MLB history...Broke the Atlanta record of 17 held by Dale Murphy, Chipper Jones and Justin Upton...Finished one shy of Jermaine Dye's 2000 record.
- Hit his first career grand slam, 5/10 at MIA, becoming the youngest Braves player (21 years, 123 days) to hit one since fellow Curaçao native Andruw Jones, 8/31/97 at BOS.

- Hit .277 (26-for-94) in 24 games with the Strippers.

- Homered again last night, 6/8 at LAD and has four home runs in his last 10 games (dating to 5/29)...Three of those home runs came in a five-game span, 5/29-6/2.
- Drove the first pitch of his ninth-inning at-bat over the wall in right field, 5/29 vs. NYM, for his first career game-ending RBI.
- His 24 walks this season already surpassed his total from last season.
- Has homered in consecutive games twice this season, 4/29 and 5/2 and 5/29 and 5/20.
- Returned from his rehab assignment, 4/18...Missed 16 games with a right oblique strain.

- Ended his season-high hitting streak at seven games last night (0-for-3), 6/8 at LAD.. Hit .400 (10-for-25) with a .640 slugging pct. during the seven-game run.
- Over his last 13 games, dating to 5/19, has a .325 average with five extra base-hits and nine RBI...In his 25 games prior to 5/19, hit .191 (9-for-47).
- Homered with a runner aboard for his fourth career game-ending home run last Sunday, 6/3 vs. WSH...Also hit a game-ending pinch-home run on 5/28 vs. NYM (G1) for his first home run with the Braves...Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1996, the only other Braves player to hit a game-ending pinch-hit home run for his first homer with the team was Keith Lockhart on 5/21/97.
- With last Sunday's (6/3) home run, he became the first player in Atlanta-era history with two pinch-hit game-ending home runs in the same season...In fact, only one Braves player, Brian Hunter, had two such homers over his career...The last major league player with two such homers in a season was Jason Giambi for the 2013 Indians.
- All of Culberson's game-ending RBI have come on home runs and four of his eight career home runs have been game-ending shots.
- Has made 17 starts (8 in LF, 7 at 3B, 2 at SS)...The team is 10-6 when he starts.
