**FLANNERY BEHIND THE MIC:** Renel Brooks-Moon will be emceeding the inauguration of San Francisco Mayor Elect, London Breed at City Hall today at 11am... pinch hitting for Renel will be former Giants Third Base Coach, **Tim Flannery**, filling in as Guest Public Address Announcer.

**TODAY'S GAME:** RHP **Johnny Cueto** (3-1, 1.95), who will make his second start since April, is expected to duel Cubs LHP Mike Montgomery (3-3, 3.68) in the rubber game of a series in which the teams have split 2-1 and 2-0 games...Cueto is 9-9 with a 3.35 ERA in 25 career starts against the Cubs...he'll be seeking his first win over Chicago since 2014.

**#BELTTHEBALLOT:** IF **Brandon Belt** is currently in second place in the NL Final Vote...Milwaukee first baseman Jesús Aguilar is the current NL leader...voting is open until 1 p.m. PST today...vote for Brandon at [sfgiants.com/vote](http://sfgiants.com/vote).

**ALL-STAR MATERIAL:** IF **Brandon Belt** would make a good All-Star because he leads all first basemen in defensive runs saved with eight, so he's an ideal defensive replacement...he's also a middle-inning hitter, batting .381 with a .430 on-base pct. and .600 slugging pct. in innings 4-6...he also hits relief pitchers well, batting .311 this season (*Baseball Info Solutions*).

**ON THE SHORES OF McCOVEY COVE:** The Giants are 29-17 (.630) here at home this season, the third-best home record in the NL behind Philadelphia (30-16, .652) and Chicago (28-15, .651)...the Giants have won seven of their last 11 home games and 17 of their last 24.

**HOME SERIES WINS:** The Giants need a win today to keep their home series win streak alive...SF has gone 9-0-2 (win-lost-split) in their last 11 home series...they haven't lost a home set since dropping two of three to Arizona from April 8-10.

**THREE IS BETTER THAN TWO:** The Giants have been held to two runs or fewer in 35 of their 94 games this season, going 7-28 (.200) in those games...when the Giants score three-or-more runs they are 41-18 (.695).

**ON DECK:** Following this series with the Cubs, the Giants will host their cross-town rival, the Oakland Athletics for three games this weekend...the Giants will end the first-half against the A's and then start the second half with three at Oakland, July 20-22...according to Stats, LLC, it's the first time the Giants will play six-straight against the same opponent in a single season since they played six in a row against Atlanta between July 3-6, 1969 (July 4 and 6 were doubleheaders).

**LEANING LEFT:** San Francisco has lost 11 of their last 16 games with an opposing starting left-handed pitcher on the mound...the Giants are hitting just .235 against lefties this year with an OPS of .678.

**STRETCH DRIVE:** The Giants Community Fund and **Willie McCovey** will hold the 10th annual Junior Giants Stretch Drive this week: Friday, July 13 - Sunday, July 15...the Stretch Drive is an organization-wide campaign dedicated to raising funds for the Junior Giants Program.

**MUCH NEEDED DAY OFF:** Tomorrow, the Giants will enjoy their first off day in over two weeks, ending a stretch today in which they will have played 16-consecutive games...beginning June 8 and leading up to this Sunday's game, the Giants will have played 36 games in 38 days.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** **C Joey Bart**, the second overall selection by the Giants in this year's draft, has gone 7-for-23 (.304) with four home runs and 11 RBI in his first five games with the Salem-Keizer Volcanoes.

#### This Date in Giants History: July 11, 1961

Candlestick Park's notoriously vicious winds dominated the first of 1961's two All-Star Games...a capacity crowd witnessed a record seven errors, not to mention hometown hero Stu Miller's wind-induced balk, enabling the American League to forge a 3 - 3 tie before losing, 5 - 4, in 10 innings...Roberto Clemente tripled and scored the game's first run, drove in the second run with a sacrifice fly, and delivered a walk-off single, off knuckleballer Hoyt Wilhelm.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#47 RHP Johnny Cueto**  
**5-11, 229, 32 years old (February 15, 1986)**  
**3-1 Record, 1.95 ERA**

- The two-time All-Star (2014 & 2016) returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the disabled list on July 5...is scheduled to make his seventh start of the season.
- Was placed on the DL on May 1 with right elbow inflammation...saw Dr. James Andrews on May 7 and was diagnosed with an elbow sprain..missed 61 games.
- Struggled in his first start back from the disabled list last Friday...allowed five runs on 10 hits in 5.0 innings of work in the Giants' 11-2 loss to the Cardinals...his 10 hits allowed marked the most he's given up in a game since Oct. 1, 2017 vs. SD (12).
- Prior to landing on the DL, Cueto had allowed just three runs in 32.0 innings of work (0.84 ERA), covering his five starts.
- Made his first rehab start with triple-A Sacramento Saturday, June 23 and tossed 3.2-scoreless innings, allowing one hit with four strikeouts (threw 48 pitches, 33 strikes)...made his second rehab start with triple-A Sacramento June 29 and tossed 4.0-scoreless innings, allowing four hits and one walk with six strikeouts (69 pitches, 44 strikes).
- The Giants are 4-2 in his starts this year and 41-22 (.651) overall since he joined the team in 2016.
- Has posted a 4.24 ERA (8er, 17.0ip) and a .313 (21-for-67) opponents average in three starts at AT&T Park this season...in three starts on the road, he's tossed 20.0-scoreless innings and allowed just five hits (.079 opponents average).
- Also missed nine games from April 10-17 with a left ankle sprain, an injury he suffered while working out in the Giants' gym...missed just one start.

• Cueto is one of seven SF Giants pitchers to hold opponents to run or fewer in each of his first four starts of a season.

- Was in Giants big league camp in 2016 and 2017...was designated for assignment prior to the 2017 season.
- The 28-year-old was originally drafted by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2011 draft.
- Missed his first two professional seasons (2012-13) after undergoing shoulder surgery to repair a torn labrum.
- Underwent an arthroscopic elbow cleanout last year that limited him to just three end-of-season appearances.
