





# HITTERS

**#13 • NICK AHMED • R/R** **6-2 • 195 • 28 (March 15, 1990)**  
**SD Series:** 4-9, HR, 3 RBI, R **Trip:** 8-22, 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBI, 4 R

- ◆ Boasts a career-high in home runs (14), doubles (21) and RBI (51).
- ◆ Is hitting .315 (28-for-89) with 7 doubles, 2 triples, 4 home runs and 20 RBI in his last 24 games.
- ◆ Is batting .280 (33-for-118) vs. left-handers.
- ◆ Hit his first career grand slam on July 26 @ Cubs.
- ◆ His 48 defensive runs saved at shortstop ranks third in the NL since 2015, behind Brandon Crawford (56) and Addison Russell (55).

**#5 • ALEX AVILA • R/L** **5-11 • 210 • 31 (Jan. 29, 1987)**  
**SD Series:** 1-1, 2B, RBI **Trip:** 3-8, 2B, HR, 3 RBI, R

- ◆ is hitting .360 (9-for-25)/.500 OBP/.840 SLG with 3 doubles, 3 home runs and 10 RBI in his last 10 games.
- ◆ Made his first appearance as a pitcher on July 11 @ Rockies (0 ER in 2.0 IP).
- ◆ Reached base a career-high-tying 5 times on July 7 vs. Padres, going 3-for-3 with a home run, 3 RBI, walk and hit-by-pitch.

**#3 • DANIEL DESCALSO • R/L** **5-10 • 190 • 30 (Oct. 19, 1986)**  
**SD Series:** 2-7, 2 BB, 3 R **Trip:** 4-12, 7 BB, 5 R

- ◆ **NL RANKINGS:** T-4th in GW RBI (9).
- ◆ Needs 1 home run to tie his career best (10 in 2017).
- ◆ Is batting .353 (12-for-34) in his last 20 games.
- ◆ Has reached base safely in 11 straight starts (.379; 11-for-29), including a walk in 8 consecutive starts.
- ◆ Made his fifth career pitching appearance on July 11 @ Rockies (3 ER in 2.2 IP)...his 2.2 innings were the most by a true position player since Jose Oquendo/STL on May 14, 1988 vs. Braves (4.0 IP).
- ◆ Has 33 games (26 starts) at third base, 32 games (29 starts) at second base, 8 games (3 starts) at first base, 5 games (3 starts) in left field, 3 at DH and 2 at pitcher.
- ◆ Since 2010, ranks among active NL pinch hitters in plate appearances (1st, 272), times on base (1st, 83), hits (1st, 52) and home runs (3rd, 6).

**#14 • EDUARDO ESCOBAR • R/L** **5-10 • 185 • 29 (Jan. 5, 1989)**  
**SD Series:** 2-4, 2B, BB, 2 R **Trip:** 2-4, 2B, BB, 2 R

- ◆ **MLB RANKINGS:** 1st in 2B (38).
- ◆ Is batting .321 (17-for-53) over his last 14 games.
- ◆ Acquired from the Twins on July 27 for RHP Jhoan Durán, OF Ernie De La Trinidad and OF Gabriel Maciel.
- ◆ Ranks fourth in MLB with a .390 (39-for-100) average with RISP.
- ◆ Has made 78 appearances (74 starts) this season at third base, 21 (20 starts) at short-stop and 1 start at second base.
- ◆ His .984 fielding pct. (3 E in 182 TC) is second best in MLB behind Anthony Rendon/WSH (.989).

**#44 • PAUL GOLDSCHMIDT • R/R** **6-3 • 225 • 30 (Sept. 10, 1987)**  
**SD Series:** 5-14, HR, 4 RBI, BB, 2 R **Trip:** 10-29, 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI, 5 BB, 5 R

- ◆ **NL RANKINGS:** 3rd in GW RBI (10), 3rd in Times On Base (177), T-6th in BB (63), 7th in OPS (.900), 7th in HR (22), T-7th in R (66), T-7th in EXB (46).
- ◆ Needs 1 home run for 200 in his career.
- ◆ Is batting .363 (33-for-91) with 8 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers and 18 RBI in his last 26 Interleague games.
- ◆ Is batting .330 (35-for-106) with 6 home runs and 17 RBI in his last 27 games.
- ◆ In 57 games since May 23, is hitting .342 (77-for-225)/1.088 OPS with 12 doubles, 18 homers, 45 RBI and 35 walks.
- ◆ Named to a club-record sixth NL All-Star Team...is the only NL player to make each of the last 6 All-Star teams, and 1 of 3 players in MLB to do so (also: Mike Trout and Salvador Perez).
- ◆ His 6 20-homer seasons are tied for the D-backs record (Luis Gonzalez).
- ◆ NL Player of the Month for June (first career monthly honor) after hitting .364 with 10 home runs and 23 RBI...NL Player of the Week for June 4-10 (.640, 4 HR, 11 RBI).

**SD Series:** 5-13, 2B, 4 RBI, 2 R **Trip:** 7-21, 2B, 3B, 5 RBI, BB, 4 R, HBP

- ◆ **MLB RANKINGS:** T-5th in 1B (87).
- ◆ Needs 2 RBI to match his 2017 total (34 in 141 games).
- ◆ Is hitting .367 (11-for-30) with 3 RBI in Interleague games this season.
- ◆ Leads the Majors with 12 HBP since his first game with the D-backs on June 8.
- ◆ Acquired from the Royals on June 6 for LHP Gabe Speier and RHP Elvis Luciano.

**#4 • KETEL MARTE • S/R (kuh-TELL)** **6-1 • 185 • 24 (Oct. 12, 1993)**  
**SD Series:** 3-11, 2 2B, RBI, 3 BB, 2 R **Trip:** 6-25, 2 2B, 3 RBI, 6 BB, 4 R

- ◆ **NL RANKINGS:** 1st in 3B (9).
- ◆ His 42 RBI are a career high, surpassing his 33 RBI in 2016.
- ◆ Is batting .333 (11-for-33) with 7 RBI and 7 walks (.463 OBP) over his last 10 games.
- ◆ Set a career high with 4 RBI on July 20 vs. Rockies.
- ◆ Became the sixth D-back to homer from both sides of the plate on June 1 vs. Marlins.

**#2 • JEFF MATHIS • R/R** **6-0 • 205 • 35 (March 31, 1983)**  
**SD Series:** 3-7, 2 2B, 2 RBI, BB, 3 R **Trip:** 4-11, 3 2B, 4 RBI, BB, 4 R

- ◆ Has a 5-game hitting streak (.368; 7-for-19)...has hit safely in 8 consecutive starts (.344; 11-for-32) with 6 doubles, 8 RBI and a .931 OPS.
- ◆ His 2.86 catcher ERA leads the NL [min. 200.0 IC].
- ◆ Has a 63-game errorless streak (588 TC) as catcher since June 22, 2017.
- ◆ Played in his first game at second base on July 11 @ Rockies.
- ◆ Made his third career pitching appearance on July 8 vs. Padres (L; 1 ER in 1.0 IP).

**#36 • JOHN RYAN MURPHY • R/R** **5-11 • 205 • 27 (May 13, 1991)**  
**SD Series:** 0-4 **Trip:** 0-7

- ◆ 9 home runs and 24 RBI are career highs (previous: 3 HR & 14 RBI in 2015).
- ◆ In 36 starts, is batting .241 (34-for-141) with 6 doubles, 9 homers and 23 RBI.
- ◆ His 9 homers are fourth among NL catchers [as catcher only], behind Yasmani Grandal/LAD (17), Yadier Molina/STL (14) and J.T. Realmuto/MIA (12).
- ◆ Homered in 4 games in a row as a catcher from May 23-June 1, tying a club mark at that position (also: Jarrod Saltalamacchia, Sept. 8-16, 2013).

**#16 • CHRIS OWINGS • R/R** **5-10 • 185 • 26 (Aug. 12, 1991)**  
**SD Series:** 1-4, 2B, 2 BB, R **Trip:** 2-9, 2B, 2 BB, R, SB

- ◆ Has made 39 appearances in right field, 13 in center field, 10 at third, 9 at second base and 3 in left field...has not committed an error in right field (55 TC).
- ◆ Since 2013, is fifth in MLB with 85.0 stolen base pct. [min. 50 attempts].

**#6 • DAVID PERALTA • L/L** **6-1 • 215 • 30 (Aug. 14, 1987)**  
**SD Series:** 0-6, 2 BB **Trip:** 6-25, 2 BB, 2 R

- ◆ Left game on July 29 @ Padres with right shoulder tightness.
- ◆ Is hitting .308 (28-for-91) with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer and 9 RBI in his last 23 games and .314 (59-for-188)/.923 OPS with 13 doubles, 3 triples, 9 home runs, 31 RBI and 13 walks in his last 48.
- ◆ Is hitting .324 (24-for-74) with 28 RBI with runners in scoring position.
- ◆ His 16 homers surpassed his 14 in 2017 and are 1 shy of his career high 17 in 2015.
- ◆ Tied his career high with 5 hits on July 7 vs. Padres (also: Aug. 9, 2015 vs. Reds).

**#11 • A.J. POLLOCK • R/R** **6-1 • 195 • 29 (Dec. 5, 1987)**  
**SD Series:** 4-14, 2B, HR, 2 RBI, 2 R **Trip:** 7-27, 2B, 2 HR, 4 RBI, BB, 4 R

- ◆ Is a career .345 (10-for-29) hitter with 1 double, 1 homer and 6 RBI vs. Rangers.
- ◆ Is batting .310 (49-for-158)/.941 OPS with 7 doubles, 2 triples, 10 home runs, 29 RBI and 13 walks in his last 43 games.
- ◆ Set a career high with 5 hits on July 20 vs. Rockies...also recorded his 100th career stolen base.
- ◆ On 10-day disabled list from May 15-July 2 (fractured left thumb).
- ◆ NL Player of the Week for April 30-May 6, hitting .423 with 4 homers, 8 RBI and 1.448 OPS, his fourth weekly honor...also named NL Player of the Month for April.
- ◆ Notched his first career 3-homer game on April 30 vs. Dodgers.

**#28 • STEVEN SOUZA JR. • R/R** **6-4 • 220 • 29 (April 24, 1989)**  
**SD Series:** 2-8, 2B, 2 RBI, 2 R **Trip:** 7-20, 2 2B, 3 RBI, BB, 3 R, HBP

- ◆ Is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with 2 doubles, 5 home runs, 13 RBI, 6 walks and 13 career games vs. Rangers.
- ◆ Has a .874 OPS in his last 15 starts, going 19-for-61 (.311) with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run and 11 RBI.
- ◆ Is batting .366 (15-for-41) with a .458 OBP and a .995 OPS on the road.
- ◆ On the 10-day disabled list from March 29-May 3 and May 22-July 5 with a strained right pectoral...suffered the original injury on March 21 diving for a ball.
