OAKLAND NOTES

- The A's improved to 86-57 with the win today and are 29 games over .500 for the first time since finishing the 2013 season 30 over (96-66)...the 86 wins are a 11-win improvement over last year...have the fourth best record in the American League and the majors.
- The A's have won eight of their last nine games against the Rangers...12-6 on the season.
- Khris Davis** launched his 41st home run of the season in the bottom of the first inning. Davis' 10 home runs off Rangers pitching this season matches his single season best vs. any team in a season (10 vs. Rangers in 2016)...Davis tied Frank Thomas' single season mark for the home runs by an Athletic designated hitter with 39.
- Edwin Jackson** went three innings for his shortest outing of the season. Jackson has not won a game vs. the Rangers since 5/21/09 when he was a member of the Detroit Tigers.
- Jed Lowrie's** 36 doubles tie Nick Swisher for third most for switch hitters in Athletics history.
- Stephen Piscotty** doubled in the seventh inning to extend his hitting streak to 10 games... is 13-for-36 (.361) during the streak.
- Matt Olson** connected for his 25th homer of the season, which leads the AL for most homers by a first baseman.

- Adrián Beltré** had his first two-homer game of the season and the 33rd of his career... now has 474 career home runs, moving him past Carlos Delgado for 32nd all-time...has 5279 total bases, moving him past Frank Robinson for 13th all-time...has 3152 hits, tying him with Paul Waner for 16th all-time.
- Shin-Soo Choo** has reached base safely in 17 of 39 career plate appearances vs. Edwin Jackson. He has reached base in 15 out of 17 games vs. the Athletics.
