WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers beat the Royals last night, 1-0, and have a 2-0 record to begin this 10-day, 10-game road trip to KC (2-0), BAL (4 G), and TB (3 G)...team has won 2 straight, 5 of 6 and is 18-13 (.581) since 6/9, 5th-best in A.L. in that stretch and T7th in MLB...club has a 6-4 record in July and has dropped 7 of 13, 8 of 15, and 12 of 23...Texas has won 19 of 33 and 32 of 57...club has 40-35 (.533) record beginning 4/20, T4th-best in A.L./T9th in MLB.

• At 45-45 (.494), Rangers are 7th in the A.L. in winning percentage...club reached .500 mark with last night's win for 1st time since 6/28 (39-39)...Texas has had a winning record on just 3 occasions in the last 52 days, last 39-38 on 6/27...club was 54-36/54-37 thru 90/91 G in '16.

• Club has been season-high 3 G above .500 twice, last on 5/21 (24-21), and was a 2017 high 7 games under .500 (13-20) on 5/8...season best 10-G win streak 5/9-19 was 4th-longest in franchise history...Rangers are 6-3-2 in their last 11 overall series after securing a series win this weekend.

ON THE LINE: Texas enters today's finale with a chance to go undefeated against the Royals in the 2017 regular season, barring a tiebreaker game 163 in October...the only time the Rangers have ever gone undefeated in a season series of 4+ games against any opponent was in 1999, when club went 12-0 vs. MIN.

• TEX has won all games of a series 5 times in '17: 4/20-23 vs. KC (4-0), 5/10-11 vs. SD (2-0), 5/12-14 vs. OAK (3-0), 5/16-18 vs. PHI (3-0), 6/9-11 at WAS (3-0)...this marks 1st time to win series following AS break since 2012 (2-1 at SEA)...only times TEX has gone undefeated in a series of 3+ G following break came in 2011 (4-0 at SEA), 2004 (3-0 vs. TOR), and 1973 (3-0 vs. CAL).

IN THE STANDINGS: The Rangers are in 2nd place in the A.L. West, 15.5 games behind HOU...days in each position in 2017 (alone or tied): 1st-0 days, 2nd-35, 3rd-25, 4th-31, 5th-13...last night was 4th time in 28 contests to gain ground in the West...season-high 17.0-G deficit both 7/4-5, team's greatest at any point since end of the 2014 season (-31.0 GB)...still just 2.0 GB of a wild card spot in the A.L.

VS. KANSAS CITY: Rangers are 6-0 vs. KC in 2017 and have won a club-record 12 straight against the Royals since last loss 7/22/16 at KC...the 12-G win streak is T4th-longest against any opponent in TEX history (see chart), and T2nd-longest ever by any club against KC (23 by BAL, 1969-70)...team's 12-1 (.923) record vs. KC since start of '16 is highest win pct. for any team vs. another in span (min. 10 G)...Rangers are 8-2-2 in last 12 series at The K (incl. this weekend)...Texas leads all-time 259-255-1, but Royals have leads of 143-117-1 in KC and 138-113 at The K.

ON THE ROAD: The Rangers have won 2 straight and 3 of last 4 away games, but have dropped 4 of 7, 5 of 9, and 7 of last 13 road tilts since a season-best 6-G road win streak from 5/28-6/13...club is still 12-7 in road contests since 5/28...prior to this 11-7 span, the club had won just 6 of its previous 17 away contests...the Rangers' .444 (20-25) road winning percentage is T9th in the A.L...club was 25-20/25-21 in 2016.

BACK TO BALTIMORE: Rangers have played 17 opponents in 2017, 13 in the A.L. and 4 in the N.L., but have yet to face the Orioles ahead of this week's 4-G set in Baltimore...club was 4-3 vs. O's in '16 and Rangers have a 10-4 advantage in the past 2 seasons...Texas has gone 11-15 since 7/10/13, but leads 23-18 since start of 2011...club is 4-3 at Camden Yards in 2015-16, but is 4-9 there since 7/10/13...both series in '17 take place this month, also 7/28-30 in Arlington.

ONE-NIL: Texas posted its 2nd 1-0 win of the season last night (also 4/20 vs. KC), joining SD (3x) and KC (twice) as only ML teams with multiple on a single run in 2017...last night was the club's 2nd 1-0 road win since the start of 2015, the other also in the Show Me State on 6/17/16 at STL...last night marked the team's 1st 1-0 win when scoring lone run in the 9th-or-later since 6/13/14 at SEA...it was also just the Rangers' 3rd-ever 1-0 win in KC, the last on 7/27/93, when Rafael Palmeiro hit a solo HR off Kevin Appier in the 7th.

• Elias Sports Bureau notes last night was Rangers' 3rd game in '17 to be scoreless thru 8 inn., tied w/ KC for ML high...clubs were also scoreless thru 8 on 4/20 in Arlington, 1st time in WAS/TEX franchise history to win 2 G vs. same opponent that were scoreless thru 8 frames (credit Elias).

I'M YOUR ZERO: Last night was the Rangers' 5th shutout of the year, 2nd in the last 5 G (also 7/7 vs. LAA)...the 5 SHO are T5th-most in the A.L. and one shy of the club's 2016 total...Rangers enter today with 13.0 consecutive scoreless innings, one shy of the season-best streak of 14.0 IP done 3x.

• TEX pitching staff has allowed 3-or-fewer runs in 6 straight games, posting a 1.33 ERA (8 ER/54.0 IP) in that span to drop season ERA from 4.45 to 4.24, lowest since 6/25 (4.22).

HAMELS AGAIN: Cole Hamels posted 7.2 SHO IP for a 2nd consecutive start last night, joining Martin Perez (3 straight in April 2014) as only Rangers w/ back-to-back scoreless starts that long since 2012...his current scoreless streak of 21.0 IP is longest active in MLB, 5th-longest in A.L. in 2017, and longest for TEX since Yovani Gallardo (33.1 IP, 6/10-7/7/15).

• Last night was just 3rd start by a Ranger in last 12 seasons (2005-17) to pitch at least 7.2 SHO innings and not earn a win, the others by Yu Darvish on 4/11/14 vs. HOU and Colby Lewis on 4/30/10 at SEA, both extra-inning TEX victories.

TEXAS STARTERS have a 1.28 (6 ER/42.1 IP) ERA last 6 G to drop season ERA from 4.44 to 4.18, 7.0+ IP in 5 of the 6 G.

CLAUDIO CLOSES (AGAIN): Alex Claudio earned a save for a 2nd straight game last night, just 2nd time this season for the Rangers (as a team) to have saves in consecutive contests (also 5/13-14 vs. OAK, both by Bush)...last night marked just 3rd time since 2013 for a Texas save to feature a game-ending GDP while clinging to a one-run lead...others: 8/8/16 at COL (Diekmann) and 8/2/15 vs. SF (Dyson).

WHO NEEDS THE LONG BALL?: Last night was just 6th TEX win in '17 without a HR, 1st such win in 2 months (last 5/14 vs. OAK) and just 2nd such road win in '17 (4/17 at OAK)...all 6 wins have come vs. OAK (3), KC (2), and SD (1).

THESE DAYS: Rangers own a 15-10 record in day games this season despite losing 2 straight and 3 of last 4...club is 9-6 in road day tilts, winning 6 of last 8...Rangers' 1.68 HR/G in daytime is 2nd-best in MLB (HOU-2.04 HR/G), while 5.64 R/G ranks 3rd (HOU-6.92, LAD-5.85).

SHORTS: Jose Leclerc's 3 strikes thrown last night were fewest by a TEX winning pitcher since 9/10/16 at LAA (2 by Tanner Scheppers)...TEX has scored a total of one run with Yu Darvish on the mound in his last 4 starts...Darvish in career w/ 3+ runs of support?: 44-4 (.917).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#11 Yu Darvish, RHP (6-8, 3.49)

TODAY: The 30-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 20th start of the season this afternoon in the series finale against KC...the 2017 A.L. All-Star has taken the loss in 3 consecutive starts, and is 0-4, 4.85 (16 ER/29.2 IP) last 5 starts to raise season ERA from 3.03 to 3.49, still 9th in the A.L....is also 2-6, 4.20 (28 ER/60.0 IP) last 10 GS to rise from 2.76, with minimal run support of late (see below)...marks just 2nd time to lose 3 straight starts in career and 4-G losing skid matches longest of his career (lost 4x in 4 starts, 8/30-9/14/13)...his current 8 losses are T6th-most in A.L. and just one shy of his career high (9 in 2012-13)...current span include loss last Sun. vs. LAA in club's 1st 'half' finale, as he is starting back-to-back Sundays...was named an A.L. All-Star for the 4th time in his career (also 2012-13-14), most for a pitcher in Texas history...will be working on 6 days' rest as he was replaced for Tuesday's ASG in Miami after pitching last Sunday...was the Rangers' Opening Day starter for the 1st time in his career this season...is seeking his 1st full season since 2013...returned in 2016 from 3/17/15 'Tommy John' surgery on right elbow...has twice been Rangers Pitcher of the Year (2013-14)...has averaged 11.03 SO/9 in his career, highest in ML history among starters w/ 500+ IP...his 937 SO rank 5th in Rangers history, 2 shy of matching Nolan Ryan (939) for 4th place...Rangers are 8-11 in his starts and have lost 8 of last 9.

DO YOU STILL LOVE ME?: The Rangers have scored a total of one run with Darvish on the mound in his last 4 starts, providing 3 total runs of support in last 5 starts and 2-or-fewer runs in 7 of his last 8 outings...his run support average of 3.49 runs per 9 innings while he is on the mound ranks as 5th-lowest among MLB qualifiers: LAA's Ricky Nolasco (2.82), SF's Matt Moore (3.29), LAA's JC Ramirez (3.30), KC's Jason Hammel (3.41) have lower marks...in last start Sun. vs. LAA, received zero run support for the 19th time in 119 career starts, with quality starts in 12 of those 19 contests...9 of his 38 career losses (23.7%) have come in quality starts in which he has received zero run support while in the game...he has received 3+ runs of support 61 times in his career, posting a 44-4 record (.917) in those games, with Texas going 50-11 (.820).

ALL-STAR STATUS: Ranks among A.L. leaders in starts (T2nd, 19), opp. avg. (4th, .215), strikeouts (5th, 125), innings (7th, 118.2), ERA (9th, 3.49), and SO/9 (10th, 9.5)... opponents are batting just .198 (19-96) with RISP, 8th-lowest avg. in A.L...has a club-best 13 quality starts in 19 outings in 2017, T3rd-most in the A.L. • Since the 2016 All-Star break, when Darvish returned from a DL stint for the remainder of the year, he ranks among A.L. leaders (min. 162 IP) in SO/9 (3rd, 10.53), strikeouts (4th, 238), opp. avg. (4th, .215), WHIP (4th, 1.12), and ERA (8th, 3.50).

LAST START: Took loss last Sun. vs. LAA in 1st 'half' finale, a 3-0 Texas loss in which the offense was 2-hit (7.1 IP, 3 H, 2 R-ER, 4 BB, 6 SO, 1 HR, 102 pitches/65 strikes)...gave up a solo HR to Pujols in the 1st, and a sac fly in the 5th, but faced more than 4 batters in just one inning (5 BF in 5th)...Claudio/Leclerc stranded Darvish's 2 baserunners in the 8th...committed 3rd career balk in the 3rd inning (others 6/18/13 vs. OAK and 7/23/14 at NYY).

VS. KANSAS CITY: Has gone 2-1, 2.25 (7 ER/28.0 IP) in 4 G/GS career vs. KC, permitting a .178/.224/.317/.541 slash line with a 0.82 WHIP and 9.96 SO/9...earned win on 4/23 in Arlington - also a day game series finale (W, 8.0 IP, 5 H, 2 R-ER, 1 BB, 8 SO, 2 HR, 113 pitches/79 strikes)...in that 5-2 Texas win, which completed a 4-G sweep, he permitted 2 HR in a span of 3 pitches in the 3rd inning (to Moustakas and Jorge Bonifacio - 1st career for the latter), the only runs he allowed all day...retired each of last 7, and 15 of final 16 batters faced, including a shutdown inning in the 5th after Texas took a 3-2 lead...is 1-1, 3.46 (5 ER/13.0 IP) in 2 G/GS career in KC, lone career loss to Royals on 7/22/16 at The K (6.0 IP, 3 R-2 ER), when he was outduelled by Danny Duffy during Duffy's span of 2nd-half dominance.

ON THE ROAD: Will be making 1st road start since 6/28 at CLE (L, 6.0 IP, 3 R-2 ER)... has a 3-3 record despite a 2.32 ERA (13 ER/50.1 IP) in 8 road starts, 3rd-lowest away ERA in the A.L....quality starts in 6 of 8...in his 5 non-wins on road in '17 (3 L's, 2 ND's), he has received a total of 5 runs of support, and club has scored a total of 10 runs in those 5 contests...road ERA is over 2 runs lower than at home (4.35)...last 12 road starts beginning 8/7/16: 4-3, 1.99 (17 ER/77.0 IP) with .177/.258/.255/.513 opponents slash line in that span.

THE DAY I TRIED TO LIVE: Has gone 15-9 w/ 2.82 ERA (68 ER/217.0 IP) in 33 career starts in day games, 4th-lowest day ERA among active pitchers w/ 30+ GS to only Jacob DeGrom (1.69), Clayton Kershaw (2.40), and Johnny Cueto (2.76)...last 17 day starts: 8-6, 2.26 (28 ER/111.2 IP).

BY THE NUMBERS: Has issued 41 BB, T6th-most in A.L., and 8 wild pitches are T3rd-most in the A.L...has 11 GIDPs this season, this after 10 GIDP induced over 39 GS from 2014-16...opponents batting .131 (33-252) in counts w/ 2 strikes w/ 9 XBH (6 2B, 3 HR)...batters leading off an inning: .120 (13-108) w/ 12 BB and 36 SO...opposition batting .170 (26-153) in 1st PA; .265 (41-155) in 2nd PA; .210 (25-119) in 3rd PA; 1-for-6 in 4th PA...Lucroy has caught 8 starts (3.08 ERA), and Chirinos (3.78 ERA) has caught 11 total starts - including 7 straight from 5/16-6/18...has allowed 25 of his 47 runs overall this season on home runs...allowed a 3-R HR in back-to-back starts on 5/27 at TOR (Bautista) and 6/2 vs. HOU (Correa) to account for his only runs allowed in those 2 defeats...prior to those outings, had allowed just 2 3-R HR in his 1st 110 career starts (has never allowed a grand slam)...retired 15 of final 16 BF in win on 4/23 vs. KC...threw 73.7% strikes (70 of 95) on 5/16 vs. PHI, 2nd-highest pct. of his career...outing 6/12 at HOU was 4th career start of 7.0+ IP, one-or-zero hits allowed - all against the Astros...only pitcher since 1900 whose 1st 4 starts allowing one-or-fewer hits all came against same opponent (credit Elias)...matchup w/ Masahiro Tanaka on 6/23 at NYY was 2nd time since 1893 for both SPs to allow no runs and 3 or fewer hits with at least 9 SO...on 7/4 vs. BOS, matched career highs in hits (11), R (7), and ER (7).

STRIKEOUTS: Has averaged 11.03 SO/9 in his career, highest in ML history among starters w/ 500+ IP...next-closest starter on the list is Randy Johnson (10.61)...his 937 SO rank 5th in Rangers history, 2 shy of matching Nolan Ryan (939) for 4th on club list...holds club single-month strikeout records for 4 of the 6 months (April, May, June, August)...has averaged 9.48 SO/9 this season, which would be his lowest figure in any season by nearly a full strikeout (current low is 10.40 in 2012). • Has all 3 10-K games by Rangers in 2017...his 31 10+ SO games rank 2nd in franchise history (Nolan Ryan - 34)...fanned a career-high 15 on 8/12/13 at HOU.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER — RHP ANDREW CASHNER (4-7, 3.54 in 14 games/starts)

The 30-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 15th start of the season in Monday night's series opener in Baltimore...earned the win in an 8-2 Texas victory on 7/5 vs. Boston (7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R-0 ER, 3 BB, 4 SO, 1 HR, 110 pitches/71 strikes)...did not allow a hit until a Xander Bogaerts 2 out, 2-run home run in the 6th inning...eclipsed the 100-pitch mark for the 1st time this season, tossing a season-high 110 pitches...was his 5th career start of 7.0+ IP, 0 ER, and 3-or-fewer hits, 1st since 9/15/14 vs. PHI...was 2nd outing this season of allowing zero earned runs, but he still has gone 2-3 with a 4.66 ERA (15 ER/29.0 IP) in his last 5 starts (beg. 6/3) to raise season ERA from 2.92 to 3.54...was on the disabled list since 6/15-28 with a left oblique strain...did not require a rehab assignment, completing a 41-pitch bullpen on 6/24 in New York...also was struck by a piece of a broken bat on 6/29 at CLE, but did not miss a start...still has quality starts in 7 of last 11 outings and his 8 overall, including 4 straight from 5/1-17...has gone 2-5 with a 4.37 ERA (22 ER/45.1 IP) over 8 road starts...opponents have batted .263/.344/.333/.677 on the road compared to .261/.340/.433/.773 in Arlington...has lost each of his last 2 road starts (9.00, 9 ER/9.0 IP), this after consecutive road wins against Blue Jays and Nationals...remains the only A.L. starter to not allow a home run on the road (min. 25.0 IP)...in only career start vs. Baltimore, took no decision for Padres on 5/14/13 at Camden Yards (7.1 IP, 5 H, 2 R-1 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR, 92 pitches/57 strikes)...opposed Chris Tillman and allowed solo home run to Ryan Flaherty...was his 5th start after being installed as a full-time starter that season...has allowed 2-ER-or-less in 9 of 14 starts...has earned wins in 4 of his last 8 starts after a span of 10 straight winless starts dating to 2016...Texas is 6-8 in Cashner's starts this season...began the season on the DL with upper right biceps soreness and was activated on 4/15 prior to start at SEA...signed as a free agent on 11/21/16 after spending '16 w/ Padres and Marlins.
