#### Chase the Ace

With his win last night, **Chase Anderson** improved to 18-6 with a 2.70 ERA over his last 41 starts dating back to 7/25/16 (223.1ip, 67er)....he has produced 3 of the team's 4 quality starts this season.

#### Homer Happy

The Brewers have smacked 3 HR in each of the last 2 games, coming from six different players: Pérez, Braun, Shaw, Villar, Bandy and Arcia.

#### April Powers

**Eric Thames** has 16 HR in the month of April over the last two seasons (11/5), which is the most in the Major Leagues.

#### A Star is Braun

**Ryan Braun** needs just 3 RBI for 1,000 in his MLB career....his 997 RBI since 5/25/07 (his MLB debut) leads all players in the National League (5th in MLB).

**COACHES:** Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made two replay challenges, going 0-2....their last challenge came last Sunday vs. Chicago-NL as an out call at first base involving Domingo Santana was confirmed....team was 17-27 in 44 replay challenges in 2017.
