BOSTON RED SOX (2-0) at LOS ANGELES DODGERS (0-2) World Series Workout Day Notes • Thursday, October 25, 2018

Dodger Stadium • Los Angeles, CA

TWO DOWN: The Red Sox lead the Dodgers in MLB's 114th World Series, 2 games to none...The Sox are the 55th team to take a 2-0 lead in the Fall Classic.

- Prior to 2018, each of the last 10 teams to hold a 2-games-to-none lead in the World Series went on to win the title, as well as 16 of the last 17, and 43 of 54 overall.
- This is the 5th time the Sox have held a 2-0 lead in the World Series, also doing so in 1916 (won, 4-1), 1986 (lost, 3-4), 2004 (won, 4-0), and 2007 (won, 4-0).

SIX FOR THE SOX: The Red Sox have won each of their last 6 postseason games (ALCS Games 2-5, WS Games 1-2)...The only other years in which they won 6+ consecutive games in a single postseason are 2004 (8 straight) and 2007 (7).

SWEET 16: The Red Sox are 14-2 in their last 16 World Series games, dating back to Game 1 of the 2004 Fall Classic...In those games, they have out-scored opponents, 92-42.

The Yankees are the only other team ever to go 14-2 or better in any 16-game stretch of World Series play (most recently: 1996-2001).

WHERE WE LEFT OFF: Last night, the Red Sox earned a 4-2 win over the Dodgers at Fenway Park...BOS trailed in the 5th inning, 2-1, with 2 outs and an 0-2 count on No. 9 hitter Christian Vázquez, who singled...Mookie Betts (single) and Andrew Benintendi (8-pitch BB) then loaded the bases, Steve Pearce walked to tie the score, and J.D. Martinez hit a 2-RBI single.

The Dodgers had 3 hits, the fewest allowed by Red Sox pitchers in a World Series game since 1967 (3 hits, Game 5 at STL)...The Sox retired each of their final 16 batters faced (Price-7, Kelly-3, Eovaldi-3, Kimbrel-3).

FOR THE 100TH TIME: Wednesday marked the 100th postseason win in Red Sox history, 4th-most among MLB franchises behind only the Yankees, Cardinals, and Dodgers.

The Sox are 100-85-1 all-time in postseason play...They are 21-15 in 36 postseason series, having gone 7-6 in 13 trips to the ALDS (23-25 in DS play), 6-5 in the ALCS (30-32), and 8-4 in the World Series (47-28-1).

START ME UP: In 8 of 11 games this postseason, the Red Sox have held a lead at the time they pulled their starting pitcher (tied once, trailing twice).

- Sox starters are 6-1 with a 4.02 ERA (24 ER/53.2 IP) in the postseason, including 5-0 with a 3.66 ERA (19 ER/46.2 IP) in the last 9 games.
- In 6 of their 11 games, Sox starters have thrown at least 5.0 innings and allowed 2 runs or fewer...They have thrown 6.0+ innings 4 times and 7.0+ innings once.

RELIEF CORE: In the World Series, Craig Kimbrel, Nathan Eovaldi, and Joe Kelly have retired all 18 batters faced (7 SO).

- Sox relievers have posted a 3.18 ERA and held opponents to a .181 AVG this postseason (45.1 IP, 29 H, 16 ER).
- Beginning with Game 2 of the ALDS, Red Sox relievers have stranded 16 of their last 17 inherited runners

GRAB A BAT: In the 2018 regular season, Red Sox pitchers

- led the majors in AVG, OBP, and SLG (.211/.250/.316)...They also led AL clubs in RBI (3), XBH (2), and runs (tied, 3).

 Rick Porcello was 3-for-7 with 2 2B in 2018, including a 3-run double off Max Scherzer on 7/2 at WSH...All other AL pitchers combined for 6 XBH in 2018.
 - Red Sox pitchers have had 192 PA in the World Series, going 24-for-169 (.142) with 2 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR, 12 BB, 1 HBP, and 10 sac bunts...They are 4 for their last 54 (.074) in the Fall Classic, including 0 for their last 10.
 - The last Sox pitchers to record a hit in the World Series were Daisuke Matsuzaka (2007 Game 3), Bill Lee (1975 Game 7), and Luis Tiant (1975 Game 4)... The only BOS pitcher to hit a HR in the World Series is Jose Santiago (1967 Game 1 off Bob Gibson).

END OF THE LINE: The Red Sox have played 207 games in the last 245 days, including 2 exhibition games against Northeastern University and Boston College (2-0), 32 Grapefruit League games (22-9-1), 162 regular season games (108-54), and 11 postseason games (9-2)...All together, the Sox are 141-65-1 (.681) in 2018.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Red Sox are 5-0 on the road in the postseason, having out-scored opponents by a combined 40-13 margin away from Fenway Park...This is the Sox' longest road winning streak in postseason history.

The Sox are 1 of 7 teams ever to win 5+ consecutive road games in a single postseason (last: 2014 Royals)... The only teams to win as many as 6 straight road games in a single postseason are the 2005 White Sox (6-0) and 1996 Yankees (8-0), who both won the World Series.

RECIPES FOR SUCCESS: The Red Sox are 9-0 this postseason when scoring the game's 1st run...They have scored multiple runs in the 1st inning 5 times (ALDS Game 1, ALCS Games 2-4, World Series Game 1).

The Sox are 9-0 when scoring 3+ runs and 5-0 in games decided by either 1 or 2 runs...They have come from behind to win 3 games (ALCS 1 and 2, WS 1).

HERE'S THE SITUATION: With RISP this postseason, the Red Sox have a .363/.492/.626 batting line (33-for-91, 13 XBH, 23 BB, 3 HBP)...With RISP and 2 outs, they have posted a .415/.564/.756 line (17-for-41, 7 XBH, 11 BB, 3 HBP).

34 of the Sox' 65 RBI have come with 2 outs.

QUALITY CONTROL: Only 1 pitcher has thrown a quality start vs. BOS this postseason (Verlander, ALCS-G1)...Opposing starters have a 7.47 ERA (39 ER/47.0 IP) against the Sox.

The Sox are 5-0 this postseason when facing a lefthanded starting pitcher...They have won games started by J.A. Happ, Luis Severino, CC Sabathia, Gerrit Cole, Dallas Keuchel, Charlie Morton, Justin Verlander, Clayton Kershaw, and Hyun-Jin Ryu

RING BEARER: The only member of the Red Sox' active roster to win a World Series is Xander Bogaerts...He started all 6 games of the 2013 Fall Classic at 3B at the age of 21.

In 2011 with TEX, Ian Kinsler and Mitch Moreland came within 1 strike of winning the World Series...In 2013, Joe Kelly and STL held a 2-games-to-1 lead over the Red Sox, but BOS won the next 3 games.

WORLD STAGE: The Red Sox are making their 13th World Series appearance, having gone 8-4 in the previous 12... They won championships in 1903, 1912, 1915-16, 1918, 2004, 2007, and 2013...They lost in 7 games in each of their other 4 appearances (1946, 1967, 1975, 1986).

The Sox are 47-28-1 (.627) in the Fall Classic, marking MLB's highest win % among teams that have played in at least 3 World Series...Among <u>all</u> teams, only the Blue Jays (.667, 8-4) have a higher World Series win %.

CENTURY SUCCESS: This is the Red Sox' 4th World Series appearance in the last 15 years (2004-18), tied with STL for the most in that time...The Sox' 3 World Series titles since 2000 are tied with the Giants (2010, '12, '14) for the most this century.
