## NATIONALS NEWS

### STATS ABOUT SOTO

Outfielder **Juan Soto** clubbed his 10th home run of the season on Friday night, a two-run shot off left-handed pitcher **Jessie Biddle**. Atlanta Braves left fielder **Ronald Acuña Jr.** also homered on Friday. According to *Elias Sports Bureau*, the two became the first opposing players to homer in the same game prior to turning 21 years old since May 19, 1887 (**Egyptian Healy**, Indianapolis Hoosiers and **Mike Tiernan**, New York Giants).

- Soto ranks among all MLB rookies (min. 210 PA), in on-base percentage (1st, .413), OPS (1st, .944), batting average (2nd, .302) and slugging percentage (2nd, .532).
- Even though he was called up on May 20, he ranks among NL rookies in home runs (T2nd, 10), walks (3rd, 34), RBI (T5th, 30), runs (6th, 33), hits (T7th, 54) and doubles (T7th, 11).
- The left-handed Soto is 19-for-50 (.380) with two doubles, five homers and 12 RBI against left-handed pitching. His .720 slugging percentage against lefties is the best in Major League Baseball among left-handed batters (8th among all MLB hitters) with at least 50 plate appearances.
- With 10 home runs in hand, Soto is the ninth player in Major League history to record at least 10 home runs as a teenager.

### MAX APPROACHING HISTORY

With 2,331 strikeouts in hand, **Max Scherzer** is five strikeouts away from tying **Cole Hamels** (2,336) and entering the top 50 in strikeouts in Major League history. Scherzer currently sits at No. 52, with H.O.F. **Early Wynn** (2,334) in between him and Hamels.

- With 182 strikeouts this season, Scherzer is on the verge of recording his seventh consecutive 200+ strikeout season. He is the only active player in Major League Baseball with a streak this long. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Scherzer's streak of seven 200+ strikeout seasons would be tied for second in Major League history:

### MATT'S BAT

Including his 16th home run of the season on Friday night, **Matt Adams** has homered in three of his last four games since prior to the All-Star Break. Of his 16 home runs, 15 have come off right-handed pitchers. His 15 homers against righties are seventh-most in the National League, while his .607 slugging percentage (6 2B, 15 HR) against right-handers is tops in the NL (min. 180 PA vs. RHP).

- Adams is 14-for-42 (.333) with one double, three homers, four RBI, four walks and nine runs scored in 12 games since returning from the disabled list. He has hit safely in 10 of the 12 games.

### ADAM AND ANTHONY

- Adam Eaton** has hit safely in five of his last seven games, going 11-for-27 (.407) with two doubles, three RBI, two walks and three runs scored. Over his last 15 games, he is hitting .351 (20-for-57) with a .439 on-base percentage (20 H, 7 BB). He has reached base safely in 14 of the 15 games.
- Anthony Rendon** has hit safely in nine straight games. Since June 15, Rendon is hitting .331 with a .382 on-base percentage and a .653 slugging percentage. He is tied for third in the National League with 20 extra-base hits (11 2B, 9 HR) and his .653 slugging percentage is good for fifth over this stretch.

### WHAT A RELIEF

Washington's bullpen has pitched to a 1.44 ERA (4 ER/25.0 IP) with a .204 opp. batting average (19-for-93) in eight games dating to July 9. Over this stretch, they have inherited five runners without allowing any to score.

- On the season, Nationals relievers rank in the NL in opp. OBP (2nd, .300), WHIP (1st, 1.18), walks/9.0 IP (2nd, 2.96), SO/BB ratio (2nd, 2.94), opp. AVG (4th, .229), H/9.0 IP (4th, 7.64), and opp. OPS (6th, .699).
- Nationals relievers have allowed just 22.8% of inherited runners to score (26-for-114), the second-best mark in the National League and the fourth-best mark in Major League Baseball.

### ALL-STAR RECAP

Outfielder **Bryce Harper** - with the help of father **Ron Harper** and motivation from teammates **Max Scherzer**, **Sean Doolittle** as well as former teammates **Wilson Ramos** and **Felipe Vasquez** - claimed victory in the T-Mobile Home Run Derby on Monday at Nationals Park.

- Harper beat ATL **Freddie Freeman** (1st rd.), LAD **Max Muncy** (2nd rd.) and CHI **Kyle Schwarber** (final) en route to becoming the third player ever to win the Derby in his home ballpark, joining Hall of Famer **Ryne Sandberg** (1990, Wrigley Field) and **Todd Frazier** (2015, Great American Ball Park).
- In the final round, Harper clubbed nine home runs in the final minute and a half before receiving an additional 30 seconds of time. He hit his 19th home run of the round on his second swing, giving him the title.
- On Tuesday, the American League topped the National League, 8-6, in the 89th All-Star Game presented by Mastercard. 13 of the 14 runs came via an All-Star Game record 10 home runs. HOU **Alex Bregman** was awarded the Ted Williams Most Valuable Player Award presented by Chevrolet after leading off the 10th inning with a solo home run to give the American League the 6-5 lead.

## NATIONALS HISTORY

### July 22 (9-4 on this date)

2017 - **Tanner Roark** struck out a season-high 11 batters in 7.0 innings of three-hit, two-run ball as the Nationals topped the Diamondbacks, 4-3, at Chase Field. **Bryce Harper** clubbed his 25th home run of the season in the first inning. Washington held off a rally by Arizona in the ninth inning. After allowing the first two batters to reach via walk and throwing error, **Sean Doolittle** allowed a sacrifice fly to **Paul Goldschmidt** before inducing a fly out and striking out **Ketel Marte** to end the game.

## OPPONENT

### ATLANTA BRAVES

**Dave Martinez** capped his 16-year Major League career with Atlanta in 2001, hitting .287 in 12 games. **Matt Adams** clubbed 19 home runs in 100 games for the Braves in 2017. The Braves made Nationals pitching coach **Derek Lilliquist** their first-round selection (6th overall) out of the University of Georgia in the 1987 Amateur Draft.

### THE SERIES

Since the start of 2017 season, the Nationals are 30-14 against the Braves at Nationals Park.

## DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

### #31 - MAX SCHERZER - RHP

Polished veteran right-hander, three-time Cy Young Award Winner and five-time consecutive All-Star signed a historic seven-year contract with Washington on Jan. 21, 2015...Joined the Nationals after seven Major League seasons with the Detroit Tigers (2010-14) and Arizona Diamondbacks (2008-09)...Is one of just 10 pitchers in Major League history to take home the Cy Young Award three or more times.

**AGAINST THE BRAVES:** Faces the Braves for the third time this season after squaring off twice in the first week of 2018...Tossed a two-hit, 10-strikeout shutout in his last start against the Braves on April 9 at Nationals Park...Has pitched to a 1.71 ERA (4 ER/21.0 IP) with 24 strikeouts and just three walks in his last three starts against Atlanta.

**LAST START:** Earned his second win in a row in Washington's 5-4 win at New York on July 12...Allowed three earned runs on five hits in 7.0 IP.

- Ranks among NL pitchers in strikeouts (1st, 182), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (1st, 12.16), WHIP (1st, 0.90), opp. AVG (1st, .180), opp. OBP (1st, .244), hits per 9.0 IP (1st, 5.81), wins (11st, 12), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 5.35), opp. OPS (3rd, .585), ERA (3rd, 2.41) and opp. SLG (6th, .341).
- Has tossed at least 7.0 innings in 11 starts, tied for the third-most in MLB and second-most in the National League.
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout as a member of the Nationals on July 2 vs. BOS, becoming the 11th pitcher in MLB history to collect at least 1,000 strikeouts with two different clubs...The list, according to  *Elias* :  **Jim Bunning**  (DET/PHI),  **Roger Clemens**  (BOS/NYY),  **Randy Johnson**  (ARI/SEA),  **Mark Langston**  (ANA/SEA),  **Greg Maddux**  (CHI/ATL),  **Mike Mussina**  (BAL/NYY),  **Nolan Ryan**  (CAL/HOU),  **CC Sabathia**  (CLE/NYY),  **Luis Tiant**  (BOS/CLE) and  **Cy Young**  (BOS/CLE)
- Recorded a nine-game winning streak from (4/9-6/5) which tied the second-longest streak of his career (13 G; 4/6-7/3/13 and 9 G; 8/20/16-4/7/17)...It is the longest winning streak in Major League Baseball in 2018.
- Struck out at least 10 batters in three consecutive starts from May 6-19, tied for the the third-longest streak of his career (6 G; 5/26-6/21/17).
- Did not earn the win, but struck out a season-high 15 batters on May 6 vs. PHI...It was his fifth career 15+ strikeout game...He became the first pitcher in Major League history (since 1913) to strike out at least 15 batters in no more than 6.1 IP according to Baseball-Reference.com.
- Was named National League Pitcher of the Month for April (5-0, 1.62 ERA, 57 SO, 9 BB, .165 opp. AVG) and May (4-0, 2.21 ERA, 63 SO, 10 BB).
- Was named National League Player of the Week for the week of April 9 through 15 (2-0, 1.13 ERA, 21 SO, BB, 3 H).

#### CAREER NOTES

- His 74 games of 10+ strikeouts are tied for eighth-most in MLB history (since 1913) and most among active pitchers...He is tied with  **Bob Gibson**  (H.O.F., 1981) and  **Sam McDowell** .  **Steve Carlton**  (H.O.F., 1994) is next on the list with 84 10+ strikeout games.
- His 39 games of 10+ strikeouts and one earned run or fewer allowed are tied for eighth-most in MLB history (since 1913) and most among active pitchers... **Walter Johnson**  (H.O.F., 1936) is next on the list with 40 games.
- His 20 games of 10+ strikeouts and zero earned runs allowed are tied for eighth-most in MLB history (since 1913) and second-most among active pitchers ( **Clayton Kershaw**  - 23)... **Tom Seaver**  (H.O.F., 1992) is next on the list with 21 games.
- Scherzer's five career games with 15 or more strikeouts are the most among active players and tied for seventh-most all-time .
- Leads all active starters and ranks second in MLB history with a career 10.36 strikeouts per 9.0 IP ( **Randy Johnson**  - 10.61).
- His career .197 opp. AVG vs. right-handed batters is fourth-best all-time and second among starting pitchers ( **J.R. Richard**  - .186).
- Is the only pitcher in MLB with an active streak of six-plus seasons with at least 200 strikeouts.
- Since joining the Nationals in 2015, has taken a no-hitter into the sixth inning in 11 of 118 starts (9.3%), per MASN in-game reporter, Dan Kolko.
- Since 2015, has posted a 0.92 WHIP, behind only  **Clayton Kershaw**  (0.88) for the best over this stretch.
