FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a six-game homestand tonight with the finale of this three-game set against the New York Mets. LHP **Jarlin García** is making his third appearance of the season and the first start of his Major League career. In five previous appearances against the Mets, Garcia has tossed 4.0 scoreless innings without allowing a hit. New York is countering with RHP Zack Wheeler, recalled earlier today, who in seven previous starts against the Marlins has gone 2-1 with one complete game and a 2.28 ERA (43.1/11). Following tonight's game, Miami will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then close out the homestand with a three-game series against the Pittsburgh Pirates, Friday-Sunday. At the conclusion of the current homestand, the Marlins will hit the road for a two-game series against the Yankees (April 16-17), a four-game series in Milwaukee (April 19-22), and a three-game set at Dodger Stadium (April 23-25).

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

A late Marlins lead turned into an 8-6 loss to the New York Mets. Trailing 3-0 after the top half of the fifth inning, Miami pushed four runs across the plate to take a 4-3 advantage. In the inning, **Miguel Rojas** recorded an RBI single, **Starlin Castro** drove in a run on a sac fly, and **Justin Bour** connected for a two-run home run, his first of the season. After the Mets plated the equalizer in the top of the sixth, Bour put the Marlins back on top with his second two-run home run of the game, marking his fourth career multi-home run game. The Mets tied the game with two solo home runs in the eighth and put the game away with two runs in the ninth. **Derek Dietrich**, Castro, Bour and **Brian Anderson** each had two hits, with Dietrich extending his hitting streak to six games. **Caleb Smith** started for Miami and allowed three runs on five hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over 5.0 innings. **Brad Ziegler** (0-2) took the loss in relief.

VS. METS

The Marlins went 12-7 vs. the Mets in 2017, including a 7-3 mark at Marlins Park. The 2017 season series win was the first since going 11-8 in 2013. Miami's production against New York last season was the best against a division opponent in several years. The 12 wins were the most since 2010 (13 vs. WSH; 12 vs. NYM), their 100 runs scored were the most since 2010 (102 vs. NYM), and their 193 hits were the most since 2007 (194 vs. WSH) - *Stats LLC*. Miami has won four of the last six against the Mets, including a three-game sweep at Marlins Park from September 18-20. The series in South Florida is currently knotted at 104-104 (30-29 at Marlins Park), with Miami trailing the all-time series, 199-217.

UP NEXT

The Marlins will close out their second homestand of the season with a three-game series against the Pittsburgh Pirates beginning Friday. Miami dropped the 2017 season series, 3-4, going 1-2 at Marlins Park and 2-2 at PNC Park. The Marlins .576 winning percentage against the Pirates at home (53-39) is their second-best winning percentage at home against any National League team, behind a .646 mark against the Colorado Rockies (64-35).

LONG ROAD HOME

Starlin Castro has recorded at least one hit in each of his first eight home games this season, extending his hitting streak at Marlins Park to 16 games. His streak is currently tied for the longest hitting streak ever at Marlins Park, equaling Christian Yelich (August 11 to September 18, 2014). - *Stats LLC*

STILL STREAKING

Starlin Castro had an eight-game hitting streak to start the season snapped Sunday in Philadelphia. However, he did draw two walks in the game. With his hit last night, Castro has reached base safely in all 11 games played this season, tying for the sixth-longest such streak to begin a Marlins career. *See chart at right*

SHOWING HE BELONGS

Marlins rookie third baseman **Brian Anderson** leads all Major League rookies in hits (13), doubles (4), walks (9), RBI (9), and on-base percentage (.462), and is tied for the lead in runs scored (8). He ranks second in average (.317) and fourth in slugging percentage (.488).

THE PEN IS MIGHTIER

Through the first 11 games of the season, Miami's bullpen has worked a Major League-high 58.2 innings, ahead of the Angels (55.1). Marlins relievers rank second in the National League in strikeouts (57) and third in the Majors, behind the Yankees (67) and Brewers (59).

TOUGH TEST

Based on 2017 records, Miami will have the sixth-toughest schedule in the Majors over the course of March/April, as their opponents had a combined .519 winning percentage last season. Over the first month plus, the Marlins will have faced the Cubs, Boston, Philadelphia, the Mets, Pittsburgh, the Yankees, Milwaukee, the Dodgers, and Colorado in that stretch. However, from May through September, the Marlins have the third-easiest schedule, with opponents combining on a .485 record. - *Stats LLC*

GETTING CAUGHT RED HANDED

Marlins catchers have combined to throw out six of 13 total attempted base stealers this season (46.2%), which is the fourth-best mark in the Majors. Cubs catchers have tossed out 80.0% (4-of-5), while Tigers catchers have thrown out 63.6% (7-of-11) and Oakland's backstops have retired 50.0% (5-of-10). Miami has caught the second-most runners in all of baseball, behind only the Tigers. **Bryan Holaday** has thrown out four attempted base stealers, which ranks as the third-most, behind Jonathan Lucroy and James McCann, who both have five.

- Made first Opening Day roster of career, following rookie campaign that saw him lead Marlins bullpen in appearances (68). Made just two appearances with Marlins in Spring Training, tossing 4.0 scoreless innings.
- Is making first start of Major League career tonight. Has five career appearances against the Mets, combining to throw 4.0 scoreless innings without a hit allowed. Has walked two and struck out two.
- In first Major League season, posted a 1-2 record and 4.73 ERA (53.1/28). His 68 appearances were tied with Brian Duensing, Mike Dunn, Cory Gearrin, Hunter Strickland, and José Ramírez for 18th in NL. Ranked second among all Major League rookies in appearances, behind Cincinnati's Wandy Peralta (69).
- Stranded 34 of 42 inherited runners, marking the seventh-best inherited runner scored percentage (19.0) in the NL. Among rookies, ranked second in the NL and third in Majors, behind Danny Barnes (13.5) and Oliver Drake (16.1).
- Limited opponents to .235 (47x200) average against, sixth among NL rookie relievers and 12th among MLB relievers.
- Started season at Double-A Jacksonville, appearing in three games before being recalled on April 14. Tossed 4.0 scoreless frames with Jumbo Shrimp.
- Made MLB debut on April 14 vs. Mets, tossing scoreless sixth inning. Walked one and struck out one (Rene Rivera).
- Allowed one run over first 10 appearances (9.0 IP), and through an 18-game stretch from May 23-June 29, allowed one earned run over 12.0 innings. Over final 34 games, however, owned 6.33 ERA (27.0/19).
- Surrendered first two home runs on May 20 at Dodgers. Gave up just four home runs over remaining 53 games.
- Tossed career-high 1.2 innings on July 26 at Texas. Equaled high on August 26 vs. San Diego and Aug. 29 at Washington.
- Placed on 10-day disabled list on Aug. 15 (retro to Aug. 12) with left biceps strain. Reinstated on Aug. 22.
- Earned first MLB win on Aug. 24 at Philadelphia, becoming 19th Marlins pitcher on season to earn a win.
