PITTSBURGH PIRATES (32-34) vs. ARIZONA DIAMONDBACKS (36-29)

June 12, 2018 at Chase Field, Phoenix, AZ --- GAME #67/ROAD #34

RHP TREVOR WILLIAMS (5-3, 4.18 ERA) vs. RHP CLAY BUCHHOLZ (1-1, 1.88 ERA)

THE PIRATES... snapped their three-game losing streak with a 7-1 win at Wrigley Field Sunday afternoon...Have dropped seven of their last nine games and 12 of their last 16...Have gone 6-17 in their last 23 games after their record was a season-high nine games over .500 on 5/17 (26-17)...Won a season-high five straight games on two occasions (4/25-29 & 5/6-12)...Were 30-36 after 66 games in 2017 (30-37 after 67).

PROJECT 34: Created by Bucco RHP Trevor Williams, Project 34 was inspired by the journey of Cory Hahn, a former roommate and teammate of Trevor's at Arizona State University, who suffered a spinal cord injury...Project 34 has a mission to positively impact the lives of those living with a spinal cord injury by providing necessary medical equipment, assistive devices, and aiding in the cost for physical therapy...In Hahn's honor, Williams is wearing uniform #34 this season...For the complete story on Cory, check out the following link: <https://www.theplayertribune.com/en-us/articles/cory-hahn-arizona-diamondbacks>.

3-BAGGERS: The Pirates (22) trail only the Diamondbacks (23) for the Major League lead in triples...The Bucs have tallied a triple in two of their last three games while the D-Backs have tripled three times in their last four games...Dating back to the start of last season, Arizona ranks first among all big league teams with 62 three-baggers and Pittsburgh is second with 58.

BEHIND THE DISH: Elias Díaz has produced back-to-back multi-hit games while starting each of the last two contests...He is hitting .301 overall this season and has gone 5-for-12 with a homer and five RBI in his last three starts...In his 19 starts this season, Díaz is hitting .329 (23-for-70) with two doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI.

START ME UP: Rookie third baseman Colin Moran has reached base safely in each of his last 11 starts, going 12-for-38 (.316) with four walks...Overall he has reached base safely in 42 of his 49 starts at third base...Among National League rookies, Moran ranks second in batting average (.270), third in on-base percentage (.353) and third in RBI (25).

CATCH THIS: Francisco Cervelli and Elias Díaz have combined to produce the best batting average (.282) and the best OBP (.379) among all catching tandems in the Major Leagues this season...Their 47 combined RBI from the catching position are tops among N.L. teams and are second behind the Yankees (50) in MLB...Their 12 home runs while catching are tied with the Dodgers for the most among National League teams and are the most hit by Pittsburgh catchers since 2014 (13)...The Bucco backstops combined to hit six home runs in 2017, three in 2016 and seven in 2015.

HOT IN ARIZONA: In 10 career games at Chase Field, Starling Marte has gone 17-for-45 (.378) with eight RBI...He has hit safely in nine of the 10 games, including a four-hit performance on 4/24/17...Gregory Polanco is hitting .345 (20-for-58) with two home runs and seven RBI in 14 career games at Chase Field while Josh Harrison has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 games played here, going 21-for-63 (.333) with nine doubles, a triple and a home run.

LEADING THE WAY: Josh Harrison connected off Kyle Hendricks for his seventh career home run leading off the first inning Sunday afternoon in Chicago...Harrison now ranks fifth in club history in leadoff homers behind Barry Bonds (20), Al Martin (10), Bob Bailey (8) and Andrew McCutchen (8)...The Pirates have now hit five leadoff home runs this season, the most by the club since smacking five such homers in 2009.

SNAKE CHARMERS: The Pirates have gone 7-4 at Chase Field over the last four seasons and are 13-7 in their last 20 games played here, dating back to 4/17/12.

ROLLING MEADOWS: Beginning with the date of his first Major League game on 5/18, Austin Meadows ranks eighth among all National League players with a 1.027 OPS...He has hit safely in each of his last eight starts and in 16 of his first 19 big league starts overall, going 27-for-75 (.360) with five doubles, two triples, five homers and 10 RBI...Meadows was named the N.L. Rookie-of-the Month in May after hitting .409 with four HR in 13 games.

ROAD TRIP: Pittsburgh has gone 1-3 thus far on this six-game road trip after losing two-of-three at Wrigley Field over the weekend and dropping Monday's tilt in Arizona...The Bucs have lost eight of their last 11 games played on the road after winning three straight between May 6-9...Overall the Pirates have produced a 14-19 record on the road this season.

GUNNING THEM DOWN: Francisco Cervelli has caught 10 runners attempting to steal this season; he had a total of nine last year...Among N.L. catchers, only Philadelphia's Jorge Alfaro has gunned down more runners this season (11).

DICKERSON DELIVERING: Corey Dickerson currently ranks ninth among the National League leaders with a .313 batting average and is seventh with 73 hits...Dickerson has hit safely in nine of his last 10 games (14-for-42, .333) and has produced a .344 (22-for-64) average in his last 17 games, dating back to 5/23.

ALL-STAR WORTHY: Francisco Cervelli enters today ranked first among all Major League catchers with a .386 on-base percentage...He also ranks second among all backstops in slugging percentage (.503) and OPS...Cervelli has already established a single-season career high in home runs (nine).

OFFENSIVE OUTFIELD: Pittsburgh outfielders have combined to produce the best OPS among National League teams (.814) and the third-best among all Major League teams behind Boston (.887) and the New York Yankees (.824)...The Pirates outfielders also lead the N.L. in total bases (375) and RBI (112).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

June 12, 1970: Dock Ellis pitched the fourth no-hitter in club history. The 25-year-old righthander hit a batter, walked eight and struck out six in the 2-0 victory in game one of a doubleheader in San Diego. Willie Stargell gave the Pirates a 1-0 lead with a solo home run off Dave Roberts in the second inning and made it a 2-0 game with another solo blast off Roberts with one out in the seventh.
