AND THE RUNS JUST KEEP COMING: The Padres defeated the Milwaukee Brewers 11-5 last night in the first of the three-game set, notching their first win against the Brew Crew in 2018 (1-3)...SD scored in seven-straight innings for the first time since June 24, 2016 @ CIN (scored in eight-straight), and with their 11 runs scored last night and their 10 runs scored in their series finale @ CHC, it marked the first time the Padres had scored double-digit runs in back-to-back games since June 1-2, 2016...**Manuel Margot** logged a career-high five RBI last night, and **Franmil Reyes** homered in his second consecutive game since being recalled from El Paso (AAA).

ASK NOT WHAT THE PADRES CAN DO FOR YOU, ASK WHAT YOU CAN DO FOR THE PADRES: Tonight, RHP **Brett Kennedy**, who just celebrated his 24th birthday on August 4, will make his Major League debut...Kennedy made 16 starts for El Paso (AAA) this season, going 10-0 with a 2.72 ERA (27 ER, 89.1 IP), striking out 80 and walking 23 while limiting opposing hitters to a .233 average.

A LOVELY NIGHT FOR A DEBUT: With RHP **Brett Kennedy's** debut, the Padres will have seen 12 debuts in the 2018 season...entering the game, the Padres 11 debuts tied with the LA Angels for the most of any team this year...since the beginning of last season, 21 Padres have debuted (not counting Kennedy), which rank fourth-most of any club...listed are, in order, the Padres who have debuted this season: **Adam Cimber, Joey Lucchesi, Kazuhisa Makita, Colten Brewer, Eric Lauer, Javy Guerra, Franmil Reyes, Walker Lockett, Jose Casillo, Robert Stock and Trey Wingenter.**

ROOKIE RULERS: The Padres have seen 37 starts this season by rookies (18 by **Eric Lauer**, 17 by **Joey Lucchesi** and two by **Walker Lockett**), which, entering the game, ranked third-most in baseball this year behind TB's 43 and MIA's 50...the Padre record for starts by rookies in a season was when they had 82 in 1969.

CAN'T BE 'PENED: The Padres relief crew since the All-Star break has fostered the best ERA in the National League (2.59) and the second-best in the majors behind OAK's 1.97 mark...they've allowed just four home runs in that time, which is the tied with PIT for the fewest of any bullpen.

STARTING-WISE: While the SD bullpen's 19 runs allowed since the break are tied with OAK for second-fewest in the majors (behind CLE's 16), Padres starters have allowed 63 runs in that time, tied with CWS and LAA for the most in baseball.

HOMER MUCH?: The Padres have combined for three home runs in consecutive games for the first time since June 16-17, 2017 (did so just twice last year)...since the start of their roadtrip on August 2, the Friars have hit nine home runs, good for second-most in the National League behind just the MIL's 11.

BASES-HOARDING HOZ: **Eric Hosmer** has reached base via hit or walk in 13-straight games (.404 OBP), and his on-base streak is just one game short of tying his season-high (14-game streak from May 11-26).

VAMOS VILLA: In his five games in August, **Christian Villanueva** has a .471 average (8-for-17), which is the second-highest clip among NL players in the month behind ARI's David Peralta (.533) and the fourth-highest in the majors in that time.

PADRES ON DECK: Tuesday night for Lake Elsinore (A), RHP **Reggie Lawson** allowed one run on six hits and a walk with two strikeouts...for San Antonio (AA), LF **Josh Naylor** went 3-for-4 with two doubles and a walk...SS **Owen Miller** was 1-for-4 with a sacrifice fly and two RBI in the Northwest-Pioneer Leagues All-Star Game in Grand Junction, CO...2B **Olivier Basabe** was 0-for-3 with a RBI.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#60 RHP BRETT KENNEDY (0-0, 0.00) @ALLDAY_BK

GREAT DAY FOR A DEBUT: 24-year-old RHP **Brett Kennedy** is slated to make his ML Debut tonight against the Milwaukee Brewers...had his contract selected from triple-A El Paso yesterday, and will become the 12th Padre to make their ML Debut this season and the fourth to do so as a starting pitcher.

- The full list of Padre debuts in '18 are: RHPs **Adam Cimber, Kazuhisa Makita, Colten Brewer, Robert Stock, Walker Lockett** and **Trey Wingenter**, LHPs **José Castillo, Eric Lauer** and **Joey Lucchesi**, INF **Javy Guerra** and OF **Franmil Reyes**.
- Heading into tonight, the Padres 11 ML Debuts are tied for the most in the majors with LAA...since 2017, the Padres 21 ML Debuts are fourth-most in the majors, behind only CIN (23), PHI (23) and NYM (22).

UN-BRETT-FEATED: Has made 16 starts for triple-A El Paso this season, going 10-0 with a 2.72 ERA (27 ER, 89.1 IP), striking out 80 and walking 23 while limiting opposing hitters to a .233 average.

- Is one of just three pitchers in all of minor league baseball to have made at least 15 starts this season and have a 1.000 winning percentage...is the only player at the triple-A level to have done so.

DIGGING DEEPER: Kennedy ranks first among the Pacific Coast League Southern Division-leading El Paso staff in ERA (2.72), wins (10) and ranks second behind only RHP **Walker Lockett** in innings pitched (89.1), games started (16) and strikeouts (80).

- Has allowed just six home runs this season, one of just seven pitchers to have tossed at least 89.0 IP and allowed six home runs or fewer in the homer-friendly Pacific Coast League...he's also one of just 14 pitchers in all of triple-A to toss at least 89.0 IP and allow six HR or fewer.

ROOKIE RULERS: The Padres have seen 37 starts this season by rookies (18 by **Eric Lauer**, 17 by **Joey Lucchesi** and two by **Walker Lockett**), which, entering the game, ranked third-most in baseball this year behind TB's 43 and MIA's 50...the Padre record for starts by rookies in a season was when they had 82 in 1969.

PUMPING OUT WINS: The Chihuahuas have won each of Kennedy's last eight starts since 6/19, with Brett getting the winning decision in seven of those outings...since 6/19, he is 7-0 with a 2.47 ERA (13 ER, 47.1 IP) with .226 opponent average.

- Has allowed three earned runs or less in 13 of his 16 outings this season.
- Earned Mid-Season Pacific Coast League honors.

A LOOK BACK: Kennedy spent the entire 2017 campaign with double-A San Antonio, earning a career-high 13 wins over 26 starts with a 3.70 ERA (58 ER, 141.0 IP).

- Was named a Texas League Post-Season All-Star in 2017 and earned TL Pitcher of the Week honors (5/7) after tossing 13.0 shutout-innings in back-to-back starts.
- Has pitched to a 31-20 record and a 3.36 ERA (150 ER, 402.1 IP) in 82 career appearances (72 starts) with 399 strikeouts against 123 walks across parts of five minor league seasons.

READY FOR ROBBIE: LHP **Robbie Erlin** is set to make his fourth start of the season and 29th of his career in Game 3 of this three-game set at Miller Park.

- Earned his ninth career win as a starter last Thursday at Wrigley Field, tossing 5.0 IP of one-run, two-hit ball in SD's 6-1 victory.
- Has made 27 relief appearances this season, going 1-1 with a 2.05 ERA.
