NATIONALS NEWS

SOMETIMES YOU WIN, SOMETIMES YOU LOSE, SOMETIMES IT RAINS

The Washington Nationals endured 3 hours and 33 minutes of rain across two separate delays (1 hour, 55 minutes prior to the start and 1 hour, 38 minutes between the sixth and seventh innings) en route to topping the Atlanta Braves, 6-2 on Sunday afternoon/evening...**Max Scherzer** (6.0 IP, 8 H, 2 ER, BB, 7 SO) earned his 13th win, while **Adam Eaton** (3-for-4, 2 R), **Bryce Harper** (2-for-4, HR, 2 RBI, BB, 2 R), **Anthony Rendon** (2-for-5, 3B, 2 RBI, R) and **Juan Soto** (3-for-4, 2B, RBI, BB, R) each recorded multi-hit efforts.

- The Nationals embark on a two-city, seven-game road trip on Monday that will take them from Milwaukee (3 G) to Miami (4 G).

STREAKING ANT

Anthony Rendon has hit safely in 10 straight games - his longest hitting streak of the season and his longest since Sept. 27, 2013-April 10, 2014...It is his second-longest streak spanning one season...During the streak, he is 13-for-40 with one double, one triple, three home runs, 10 RBI, three walks and 10 runs scored.

- Since June 15, Rendon is hitting .333 with a .382 on-base percentage and a .659 slugging percentage... He is tied for second in the National League with 21 extra-base hits (11 2B, 3B, 9 HR) and his .659 slugging percentage is good for fifth over this stretch.
- Rendon's recent surge has him in the top ten in the NL in slugging percentage (9th, .527) on the season.

STATS ABOUT SOTO

Outfielder **Juan Soto** leads all MLB rookies (min. 215 PA), in batting average (.311), on-base percentage (.422) and OPS (.968)...His .546 slugging percentage ranks second behind NYY **Gleyber Torres** (.555)

- Even though he was called up on May 20, he ranks among NL rookies in home runs (T2nd, 10), walks (3rd, 35), doubles (T4th, 13), RBI (5th, 31), runs (6th, 34) and hits (7th, 57).
- The left-handed Soto is 19-for-50 (.380) with two doubles, five homers and 12 RBI against left-handed pitching...His .720 slugging percentage against lefties is the best in Major League Baseball among left-handed batters (8th among all MLB hitters) with at least 50 plate appearances.
- Soto clubbed his 10th home run of the season on Friday night, a two-run shot off left-handed pitcher **Jessie Biddle**...Atlanta Braves left fielder **Ronald Acuña Jr.** also homered on Friday...According to *Elias Sports Bureau*, the two became the first opposing players to homer in the same game prior to turning 21 years old since May 19, 1887 (**Egyptian Healy**, Indianapolis Hoosiers and **Mike Tiernan**, New York Giants).
- With 10 home runs in hand, Soto is the ninth player in Major League history to record at least 10 home runs as a teenager.

HARPER'S HOMERS

Bryce Harper is tied for fourth in the National League with 24 home runs, while his 79 walks pace the National League and rank second in Major League Baseball...Harper's 24 homers pace all National League outfielders, while his 38 extra-base hits are tied for fifth.

- Harper has hit safely in five straight games, reached base safely in six straight, 11 of his last 12 and 24 of his last 27 games.

MATT'S BAT

Including his 16th home run of the season on Friday night, **Matt Adams** has homered in three of his last five games...Of his 16 home runs, 15 have come off right-handed pitchers...His 15 homers against righties are seventh-most in the National League, while his .599 slugging percentage (6 2B, 15 HR) against right-handers is second-best in the NL (min. 180 PA vs. RHP).

- Adams is 15-for-46 (.326) with one double, three homers, five RBI, five walks and nine runs scored in 13 games since returning from the disabled list...He has hit safely in 11 of the 13 games.

EATON'S HEATIN'

Adam Eaton has hit safely in six of his last eight games, going 14-for-31 (.452) with two doubles, three RBI, two walks, two stolen bases and five runs scored...Over his last 16 games, he is hitting .377 (23-for-61) with a .457 on-base percentage (23 H, 7 BB)...He has reached base safely in 15 of the 16 games.

ALL-STAR RECAP

Outfielder **Bryce Harper** - with the help of father **Ron Harper** and motivation from teammates **Max Scherzer**, **Sean Doolittle** as well as former teammates **Wilson Ramos** and **Felipe Vasquez** - claimed victory in the T-Mobile Home Run Derby on Monday at Nationals Park.

- Harper beat ATL **Freddie Freeman** (1st rd.), LAD **Max Muncy** (2nd rd.) and CHI **Kyle Schwarber** (final) en route to becoming the third player ever to win the Derby in his home ballpark, joining Hall of Famer **Ryne Sandberg** (1990, Wrigley Field) and **Todd Frazier** (2015, Great American Ball Park).
- In the final round, Harper clubbed nine home runs in the final minute and a half before receiving an additional 30 seconds of time...He hit his 19th home run of the round on his second swing, giving him the title.
- On Tuesday, the American League topped the National League, 8-6, in the 89th All-Star Game presented by Mastercard...13 of the 14 runs came via an All-Star Game record 10 home runs...HOU **Alex Bregman** was awarded the Ted Williams Most Valuable Player Award presented by Chevrolet after leading off the 10th inning with a solo home run to give the American League the 6-5 lead.

NATIONALS HISTORY

July 23 (5-7 on this date)

2012 - **Bryce Harper** hit a two-run homer in the first inning and his bases loaded RBI-single prompted a six-run 10th inning as Washington beat the New York Mets, 8-2, at Citi Field. The six-run outburst in the 10th was the Nationals' largest single inning of the 2012 season (it would later be bested). Earlier in the game, Harper homered in the first at-bat in his first game in New York. Washington won despite going hitless from the second through eighth innings.

OPPONENT

MILWAUKEE BREWERS

Brandon Kintzler spent six seasons (2010-15) with the Brewers, going 10-9 with a 3.38 ERA in 172 games out of their bullpen...**Mark Reynolds** clubbed 22 home runs in 130 games with Milwaukee in 2014...Bullpen coach **Henry Blanco** appeared in 197 games for Milwaukee across two seasons (2000-01)...Assistant hitting coach **Joe Dillon** spent the 2007-08 seasons with the Brewers.

THE SERIES

The Nationals and Brewers will play six times in 2018 (3 in D.C., 3 in MIL)...From 2005-11, Washington went 6-18 at Miller Park, but since 2012, the Nationals are 11-10 in Milwaukee.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#47 - GIO GONZALEZ - LHP

Electric left-hander is in his seventh season with Washington...In seven years with the Nationals, is 85-60 with a 3.51 ERA in 205 starts...Ranks second on Washington's all-time (2005-pres.) wins list with 85...Is Washington's most prolific left-handed pitcher, leading Nationals southpaws in nearly every pitching category...Leads Nationals (2005-pres.) lefties in wins (85), innings pitched (1,209.1), and strikeouts (1,183), among other categories...Has made 30-or-more starts seven of the last eight seasons.

AGAINST THE BREWERS: Faces the Milwaukee Brewers for the first time this season...In his last nine starts against the Brewers he is 2-4 with a 4.93 ERA with 48 strikeouts and 23 walks.

LAST START: Was strong in 6.0 innings of work on July 11 at Pittsburgh...Allowed two earned runs on six hits with four strikeouts and one walk...Both runs came via third inning home run by **Starling Marte**...Was saddled with the loss as the Nationals were blanked by the Pirates, 2-0.

2018 NOTES

- Ranks sixth among National League left-handed pitchers with a 3.72 ERA...Is tenth in the NL, third among lefties, having allowed 0.89 home runs per 9.0 IP (10 home runs in 101.2 IP).
- Also ranks among NL lefties in strikeouts per 9.0 IP (4th, 8.32), opp. SLG (6th, .401), opp. OPS (7th, .737), opp. AVG (11th, .257) and opp. OBP (12th, .336).
- Has held opposing batters to a .171 average with RISP (14-for-82), sixth-best in MLB and fourth-best in the National League.
- Has allowed two earned runs or fewer in 13 of his 19 starts...His 13 such starts are tied for fifth among National League starting pitchers.
- He pitched to a 1.81 ERA (9 ER/44.2 IP) in seven starts from April 29 through June 2, going 4-0 along the way...He recorded 43 strikeouts and a .200 opp. AVG.
- Struck out a season-high nine batters in 7.0 innings pitched in Washington's 5-3 win over Atlanta on June 2.
- Tossed a season-high 7.2 innings on May 28 at Baltimore...Did not allow a run while allowing six hits and striking out three.
- Allowed two earned runs on six hits in 5.0 innings of work on May 15 vs. New York...Struck out five batters...Allowed his first home run since April 12 vs. Colorado...The game was eventually suspended due to rain.
- In his sixth start, tossed a season-high on 7.0 innings and struck out a season-high eight batters en route to his third win of the season on April 29 vs. Arizona.
- Earned his 11th career win at Citi Field vs. NYM on April 17...Allowed two earned runs on eight hits with two walks and five strikeouts in 5.1 IP.
- Allowed two earned runs on five hits with three walks and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings on April 12 vs. COL.
- Opened the season with 6.0 strong innings as Washington completed the sweep of the Cincinnati Reds, 6-5...Allowed one earned run on five hits with one walk and seven strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- His 85 wins are sixth among left-handed pitchers since 2012...Ranks fifth among MLB LHP in that span with a .237 opp. AVG.
- His 21 wins in 2012 are tied with **Clayton Kershaw** (21 in 2014) for the most in a single season by a lefty since 2012.
- Since 2012, is 75-6 with a 2.96 ERA in 103 starts when receiving more than two runs of offensive support...Is 86-1 with a 2.81 ERA in 109 starts when getting four or more runs of offensive support in his career.
- Since 2014, has allowed just six home runs in 685 AB vs. LHB, the fewest among left-handed starting pitchers (min. 600 AB vs. LHB).
- Since the start of the 2017 season, ranks 16th in Major League Baseball (5th among lefties) with a 3.21 ERA...Is 21-15 with a 3.21 ERA in 51 starts over this stretch.
