TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS
 The Reds today placed on the 10-day disabled list **OF Scott Schebler** (retroactive to 4/6; right ulnar nerve contusion) and recalled from Class AAA Louisville **INF Alex Blandino** and **RHP Zack Weiss**...the injuries to both Schebler and Suárez resulted from being hit by pitches... Schebler was hit by a **Sean Doolittle** offering in the eighth inning on 4/1 vs Washington while Suárez was plunked by **Jameson Taillon** yesterday in the fourth inning at Pittsburgh.

SHUTOUT <= 1 HIT
 In yesterday's 5-0 loss at PNC Park, **Pit's Jameson Taillon** pitched his first career shutout when he blanked the Reds on 1 hit...the opposing pitcher threw a complete game shutout in each of the last 5 games that the Reds were held scoreless on 1 hit or fewer:

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series against **Brielle Casterioto's Phillies** and **Game 5** of the Reds' first road trip of the **2018 championship season** that included a 4 game set in Pittsburgh (**1-3**)...the Reds are currently in a stretch of playing NL Central Division rivals **15** times over **18** games, with this series vs Phi as the interlude (1-0 vs Chi, 1-3 at Pit, 3g at Phi, 4g vs StL, 3g at Mil & 3g at StL)...the Reds opened the season at Great American Ball Park against Wsh (0-3) and Chi (1-0) and return there after this series for a brief 4-game homestand vs StL.

BROOKLYN, 1914: In yesterday's 5-0 loss at PNC Park, Pit's **Jameson Taillon** pitched his first career Major League shutout when he blanked the Reds on 1 hit...the Reds' only hit came from pitcher **Tyler Mahle**...yesterday's game marked the first time since **9/19/14** that the Reds have been shut out on 1 hit with the lone hit produced by their pitcher...the **Brooklyn Robins' Jeff Pfeffer** shut out the Reds and earned the 6-0 victory on 9/19/14 at Ebbets Field...the Reds' only hit of the game that day came from **Earl Yingling** who pinch hit in the sixth inning and remained in the game as Cin's pitcher...Yingling went 1-for-2, with his hit coming in his second at-bat in the eighth inning while he was Reds' pitcher. SERIES NOTES: With a **2-1 series win** from **5/26-5/28, 2017**, the Redlegs won a series at Phi's **Citizens Bank Park** for the first time since **August 2006**...in the **10 road series** prior to last May's win, the Reds went **0-9-1 at Phi** and **10-25 in 35 games** there...**Billy Hamilton** has reached base safely in each of the last **7 games** he's played in Philadelphia...for more information see **Reds vs Phillies** on media guide Page 326.

DOT, DOT, DOT...: Of the Reds' **25** runs this season, **13** were scored in innings **8-9**...**Joey Votto** needs just **3 walks** to reach **1,000 in his career**...he has agreed to donate his **batting helmet** to the **National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum** in Cooperstown...**RHP Tyler Mahle** on 4/2 vs Chi at **23 years & 185 days** became the **youngest** pitcher to record a win this season in the Major Leagues...he remains the youngest **starting** pitcher to earn a victory this season but Det's **Joe Jimenez (23 years, 78 days)** earned the win in relief Thursday night at CWS.

POSTPONED TWICE: The Reds were **rained out twice** during their season-opening homestand, first on **Opening Day vs Wsh** and then on **Tuesday vs Chi**...it marked the first time since **6/11 & 6/12, 1985** at Riverfront Stadium (vs LAD) that the Reds endured **2 weather-related postponements** in the same homestand...Tue's rainout vs the Cubs will be made up as part of a day/night doubleheader at GABP on **5/19 at 1:10**...fans holding tickets for Tue's game may present their same ticket for the rescheduled 1:10 game on 5/19 with no exchange necessary...for more information fans are encouraged to visit **reds.com/rainout**...last Thursday's **postponement** was the first for the Reds on **Opening Day** because of **inclement weather** since the first 3 games of the **1966 season vs the Mets** all were rained out...the 2018 season-opener was rescheduled and played the following day (Wsh beat Cin, 6-5)...there have been a total of **15 postponements** in the **16 seasons** at Great American Ball Park

YOUNGSTERS: The Reds' **Opening Day roster** included **5 rookies:** RHP Tyler Mahle, RHP Jackson Stephens, RHP Zack Weiss, OF Phillip Ervin and OF Jesse Winker...it also included **21 players age 30 and under, 17 players age 27 and under and 11 players age 25 & under**...Weiss, who was optioned to Class AAA Louisville the day after **Opening Day** to make room on the roster for RHP Yovani Gallardo, was the only player on the **Opening Day roster** without a **Major League appearance**...according to *Elias Sports Bureau*, the average age for the Reds' 25-man **Opening Day roster (27 years, 196 days)** was the second-youngest in the Major Leagues behind the **Phillies (26.334)** and ahead of the **Marlins (27.351)**...in **2017**, the Reds began a season with **7 rookies** on their **Opening Day roster** for the first time in researchable history, per *Elias*...last year's **Opening Day Reds roster** was the youngest in the Major Leagues (**26.355**).

ROOKIE ARMS: The Reds' **Opening Day** pitching staff included rookie starter RHP Tyler Mahle along with rookie relievers RHP Jackson Stephens and RHP Zack Weiss...Weiss, who was recalled today, was optioned on 3/31 to Class AAA Louisville to make room on the roster for RHP Yovani Gallardo, who was signed to a 1-year contract...Stephens was optioned to Louisville on 4/1 when RHP Raisel Iglesias came off the 3-day disabled list...over the last 4 seasons, including 2018, **rookie pitchers** started **253** of the Reds' **494 games (51%)**, including a club record **110 games** in 2015, **56 games** in 2016, **84 games** last season and **2 games** so far this year...during **Bryan Price's** 5-year tenure as manager, including 2018, **rookie pitchers** have started **261** of Cin's **656 games (40%)**.

IRON MAN: Since **Ivan De Jesus Jr.** started at first base on **9/2/2016 vs StL**, **Joey Votto** has started each of the Reds' **last 199 games**...in 2017 **Votto** became only the **fourth player** in franchise history to **start at least 162 games** in a season, joining **Pete Rose (1965, 163gs in 1974, 1975)**, **Leo Cardenas (163gs in 1964)** and **Vada Pinson (1963)**...**Votto's** is the Major Leagues' **second-longest active streak** of starts in his team's games behind Royals **SS Alcides Escobar (339g)**, who was the only other player in 2017 to start all of his team's games (162g).

LOU GEHRIG AWARD: Last week, **Joey Votto** was announced as winner of this year's **Lou Gehrig Memorial Award**, presented annually to a Major League Baseball player who best exemplifies the giving character of Hall of Famer **Lou Gehrig**...the award, sponsored by **Phi Delta Theta** international fraternity, headquartered in Oxford, Ohio, first was presented in 1955 and is permanently maintained at the **National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum** in Cooperstown...**Gehrig** was a member of that fraternity's **Columbia University** chapter...other Reds players to win the award were **Pete Rose (1969)**, **Johnny Bench (1975)**, **Barry Larkin (1994)** and **Danny Graves (2002)**...other past recipients include **Stan Musial, Ernie Banks, Hank Aaron, Harmon Killebrew, Willie Stargell, Lou Brock, George Brett, Ozzie Smith, Cal Ripken Jr., Tony Gwynn, Albert Pujols and Derek Jeter**.

OLD RELIABLE: RHP Raisel Iglesias last season led the Major Leagues with **8 saves** of at least **2.0 innings** and with **11 saves** of at least **1.2 innings**...with **12 saves** of more than **1.0 inning** tied LAD's **Kenley Jansen** for the lead among all pitchers...**Mike Montgomery** of the Cubs ranked second with **3 saves** of at least **2.0 innings**...**Iglesias'** eight **2.0-inning saves** were the most by any pitcher in the Major Leagues since **1999**, when Cin's **Danny Graves** had **10 saves** of at least **2.0 innings**...the club record for saves in a season of at least **2.0 innings** still belongs to **Rawly Eastwick (14sv, 1976)**.

Tonight's Pitcher - #25 Cody Reed, LHP

RED HOTS

Cody Reed on **Sunday** will turn **25 years old**...tonight is making his season debut...was scheduled to start the Reds' fifth game of the season, on **4/3 vs Cubs**, but it was rained out...instead, he threw a simulated game the next day in Louisville (17bf, 4.2ip, 2h, 3bb, 6k, 89 pitches)...will be making his second career appearance and first career start vs the Phillies...was added to the roster after the Opening Day rainout forced the Reds to add a fifth starter...in spring training made 1 start and 5 relief apps before he was optioned to Louisville on 3/25, the day the Reds left Goodyear...spent most of the 2017 season at Louisville...made 1 start and 11 relief apps during 2 stints for the Reds...as 1 of 7 rookies on the 2017 Opening Day roster began the season in the Reds' bullpen and made his first 4 apps in relief before his only start, a 12-8 loss on 4/22 vs Cubs...retired all 18 batters (7k) in his last 3 relief apps prior to his 4/22 start...following that 4/22 start made a pair of relief apps before he was optioned to Louisville on 5/4 to make room on the roster for RHP Austin Brice...spent the rest of the season with the Bats...returned to the Reds in September, after Louisville's season ended.

Tomorrow's Pitcher - #34 Homer Bailey, RHP

RED HOTS

Homer Bailey tomorrow will make his third start of the season...will be his **11th career start** vs the **Phillies**, his first since **2014**, and his eighth career appearance at **Citizens Bank Park**...in the 2-0 loss on **3/30 vs Wsh** made the first **Opening Day start** of his Major League career...has the **third-longest tenure** of any Major League pitcher with his current team (June 2007), trailing only Sea's **Felix Hernandez** (August 2005) and StL's **Adam Wainwright** (September 2005)...was on the Reds' **Opening Day roster** for the first time since **2014**...is approaching **200 apps** (194), **1,200 innings** (1,134.2) and **1,000 strikeouts** (931)...over the previous 3 seasons made just 26 starts for the Reds while recovering from 3 surgeries, on 9/5/14 to repair the **torn flexor tendon in his right forearm**, on 5/8/15 to repair the **torn ulnar collateral ligament in his right elbow** ("Tommy John") and on 2/18/17 to remove **small bone spurs in his right elbow**...in 2017, his 7 quality starts tied **Tim Adleman** for third on the staff behind **Scott Feldman** (9qs) and **Luis Castillo** (8qs)...in his last 7 starts of last season, beginning 8/22, went **2-3, 3.58**...in **2018 spring training** made all 6 scheduled starts without issue, including a minor league outing (0-2, 7.50, 18ip, 26h, 3bb, 9k, 7hr).

REDS BATTERS

REDS BATTERS in 2017

- Among National League team leaders ranked eighth in hitting, eighth in runs, sixth in HR, fifth in walks, seventh in strikeouts.
- The Reds' 219 home runs last season were third-most in franchise history (222 in 2005, 221 in 1956)...established a single-season club record for players with at least 20 HR (6) and tied franchise records for players with 25 HR (5) and 30 HR (3).

2 ALEX BLANDINO, c 2018 AAA-Louisville: 3gs at 3b, 0-8, 3r, 2bb, 1sb

- Earlier today was recalled from AAA-Louisville along with RHP Zack Weiss when OF Scott Schebler and 3b Eugenio Suárez were placed on the DL.
- When he plays will make his Major League debut.
- In Spring Training hit .325 in 26 apps and 5 starts (2 3b, 6rbi)...in his last 15 spring apps he hit .375 (9-24)...he played 2B (9g, 4gs), SS (6g) and 3B (11g, 1gs).
- His .834 OPS in 237 plate appearances with Louisville in 2017 was the highest OPS (min. 100 PA) for a Bats player in his first Triple-A season since Denis Phipps' 1.004 OPS in 173 plate appearances with Lou in 2011.

16 TUCKER BARNHART, c On the road trip: 3gs, 2-8, 2r, 1 2b, 4bb

- Reached base safely 10 times over his last 18 plate apps (4 singles, 4bb, 2 2b).
- Spring Training: 16g, .300, 4hr, 9rbi...tied for the team lead in HR, hit safely in 10 of his 16 apps and caught a team-high 90.0 innings.
- In 2017 became only the third catcher in Reds history to win a Rawlings Gold Glove Award for defensive excellence, joining Johnny Edwards (1963, 1964) and 10-time winner Johnny Bench (1968-1977).
- Established a new single-season franchise record for highest fielding percentage by a catcher (.999) and tied Brayan Pena's 2015 club mark for fewest errors in a season by a catcher (1e, 953tc).
- Led Major League catchers in fielding percentage (.999, 1e, 953tc), caught stealings (28) and assists (89)...led NL catchers in blocked pitches (661).
- With a 2.8 Defensive WAR as calculated by Baseball Reference, led all NL position players and ranked second among all Major League players (SS Andrelton Simmons 4.2)...as calculated by Fangraphs, led all Major League catchers in defensive value and in defensive runs saved.
- Is approaching 100 career runs (88) and 300 hits (274).

23 ADAM DUVALL, lf On the road trip: 4gs, 1-15, 1hr, 1bb

- Is hitless over his last 11 at-bats.
- Started Fri night at Pit in LF but replaced Votto at 1B in the seventh inning...was his first app at 1B since 8/20/17 at Atl...has made 34 total apps at 1B including 22 starts.

- Spring Training: 19g, .271, 4hr, 12rbi, 1sb...in his last 12 apps hit .323 (2hr, 8rbi)...his 6-game hit streak from 3/7-3/16 tied Gennett's for the longest by a Reds batter.
- In 2016 was a National League All-Star and in each of the last 2 seasons was a finalist for the Rawlings Gold Glove Award.
- In 2017, led all Major League outfielders with 15 assists, the most by a Reds outfielder since Pete Rose had 15 assists in 1973.
- Is trying to join Hall of Famer Frank Robinson as the only players in Reds history to produce at least 70 extra-base hits in 3 straight seasons (courtesy TheAthletic.com).
- Is approaching 400 career apps (370), 200 runs (179) and 100 walks (90).

27 PHILLIP ERVIN, of On the road trip: 3g, 1gs, 1-7, 1rbi

- On Fri vs Pit collected his first RBI of the season (single off Smoker).
- Made his first start of the season on Sat at Pit (CF, batted 6th; 0-for-4).
- Spring Training: 24g, .229, 5rbi, 1sb...made 11 starts (3gs in LF, 4gs in CF, 4gs in RF).
- Made his first Opening Day roster...was 1 of 5 rookies on the Opening Day roster..
- In 2017 made his Major League debut with 28 apps and 11 starts during 4 stints for the Reds.

4 SCOOTER GENNETT, 2b On the road trip: 4gs, 1-16, 1r, 1bb

- Is hitless over his last 15ab after opening the season with a 5-game hitting streak.
- Has hit safely in 12 straight home games dating back to 9/16/17 vs Pit.
- On 4/1 vs Wsh made his 600th career appearance and reached 2,000 at bats.
- On 3/30 vs Wsh became the first Reds batter with 4 hits on Opening Day since Ramon Hernandez went 4-for-5 (3rbi) on 3/31/11 vs Mil.
- Spring Training: 17g, .386, 2hr, 7rbi, 1sb...finished the spring with a 6-game hitting streak (10-18, .556, 3 2b, 1 3b, 1hr, 5rbi), tying Adam Duvall's for the longest by a Reds batter this spring...hit safely in 11 of his last 15 apps (.415, 2hr, 7rbi)...from 3/15-3/18 missed 4g with a sore right shoulder.
- By 7/23 of last season already had established new career highs in HR and RBI...also established career highs in games, runs, hits, total bases, slugging and OPS.
- In his 108 starts in 2017 hit .301 (22 2b, 2 3b, 25hr, 90rbi).
- Beginning 7/19 started at second base in 57 of the Reds' last 69 games of the season.
- His 97 RBI ranked T13th in the National League and were the most by any player in the Major Leagues with as few as 461 at bats...his AB-per-RBI ratio was 4.8, the best on the team, but needed 5 more plate apps to qualify among the leaders.
- Was born in Cincinnati and lived in nearby Lebanon until he was 9 years old, when his family moved to Sarasota.
- Is approaching 600 career hits (571).

46 PHIL GOSSELIN, inf On the road trip: 4g, 1-4, 1bb

- Yesterday at Pit entered the game at 3B in the fifth inning and went 0-for-2.
- In the ninth inning on 4/1 vs Wsh hit a 2-run HR off Sean Doolittle.
- Spring Training: 23g, .239, 4rbi, 1sb...played 1B (1gs), 2B (7g, 2gs), SS (4g, 1gs), 3B (5g, 4gs) and LF (3g, 1gs).
- Was 1 of 3 non-roster invitees to make the Opening Day roster (IF Cliff Pennington, RHP Kevin Quackenbush)...on 12/21 was signed to a minor league contract.
- One of baseball's most versatile players, in his Major League career has played 1B (7g, 4gs), 2B (97g, 61gs), 3B (31g, 19gs), SS (11g, 5gs), LF (6g, 3gs) and RF (1g).

6 BILLY HAMILTON, cf On the road trip: 4g, 3gs, 2-10, 3r, 2bb, 1sb

- In the eighth inning Sat at Pit collected his first stolen base since 9/28 at Mil.
- Spring Training: 19g, .170, 2rbi, 0sb...hit safely in 7 of his last 10 Cactus League apps.
- In each of the last 4 seasons was a finalist for but did not win the Rawlings Gold Glove Award for center fielders.
- Since his debut on 9/3/13 leads all Major League players in stolen bases with 244, sixth on the Reds' all-time list since 1898...Reds Hall of Famer Eric Davis is fifth at 270.
- Last season established new career highs in runs, hits, triples, walks and steals.
- Also in 2017, ranked among the National League leaders in triples (2nd), stolen bases (2nd) and hardest to GIDP (116.4ab, 4th)...his 13 outfield assists were second in the Major Leagues to teammate Adam Duvall's 15 assists.
- If he reaches 60 stolen bases in 2018 will become the first player in Major League history to steal at least 10 bases in each of his first 6 seasons while establishing a career high in each of those 6 years...is tied with Jose Reyes, Cesar Cedeno and Bert Campaneris as the only players to do it in 5 straight years (courtesy TheAthletic.com)..

39 DEVIN MESORACO, c On the road trip: 2g, 1gs, 0-5

- Made 2 starts behind the plate (4/1 vs Wsh & 4/6 at Pit) and 2 app as a PH (3/30 vs Wsh & 4/8 at Pit).
- Spring Training: 18g, .308, 1hr, 7rbi...in his last 14 Cactus League apps hit .344 (11-32, 3 2b, 1hr, 6rbi)...made 17 starts (14gs at C, 3gs at DH).

- In 2017 for LAA played 2B (47g, 35gs), 3B (18g, 11gs) and SS (18g, 18g, 4gs).
- Following the season became a free agent and on 2/15/18 was signed by the Reds to a minor league contract with an invitation to Major League spring training camp.

9 JOSÉ PERAZA, ss On the road trip: 5gs, 5-13, 2r

- Has 5 hits over his last 14 PAs (5-for-11, 2r, 1sac) since beginning the season 0-for-12.
- Spring Training: 19g, .291, 6rbi...in his last 14 apps hit .318 (14-44, 2 2b, 5rbi)...hit safely in 5 of his last 8 apps (9-26, .346, 1 2b, 4rbi).
- In 2017 established career highs in games, runs, hits, doubles, triples, HR, RBI, walks and stolen bases...ranked T6th in the National League in stolen bases.
- In 2017 played 2B (77g, 69gs), SS (55g, 48gs) and CF (2g, 2gs)...made his starts in CF on 9/10 at NYM and 9/20 vs STL.
- In his last 48 apps of last season beginning 7/27 hit .293 (3 2b, 12hr, 11rbi, 8sb, .361obp), raising his overall batting average from .246 to season-ending .259.

19 JOEY VOTTO, 1b On the road trip: 3gs, 4-12, 2rbi

- His last base on balls came on 3/31 vs Wsh (sixth inning), a span of 27 plate apps.
- Spring Training: 19g, .167, 0hr, 4rbi.
- Is approaching 1,500 career apps (1,438), 1,600 hits (1,593) and 1,000 walks (997).
- In the 2017 NL MVP Award voting finished second by 2 points to Mia's Giancarlo Stanton in the fourth-closest vote ever.
- Joined Babe Ruth (1921, 1924, 1926, 1930) and Ted Williams (1941, 1942, 1949) as the only players in Major League history to produce in a season at least 179 hits, 36 HR and 134 walks with 83 strikeouts or fewer.
- Joined Babe Ruth (35 in 1930) and Lou Gehrig (33 in 1936) as the only players in their age-33 seasons or older to produce at least 175 hits, 130 walks and a .450 on-base percentage...Votto turned 34 in September.
- Was the only player in the Major Leagues to produce at least 26 HR and 100 RBI while hitting .300 with an on-base percentage of .400 and a slugging percentage of .500.

33 JESSE WINKER, of On the road trip: 4gs, 4-14, 3bb, 1hp, 2rbi

- Started in LF and batted leadoff in each of the previous 3 games.
- On Fri night at PNC Park collected 3 hits while Pit's Colin Moran went 4-for-5...they are 2 of just 7 Major League rookies in 2018 to collect 3 or more hits in a game.
- Ranks among National League rookie leaders in most offensive categories, including on-base pct (.467, 1st) and walks (7, T1st).
- Spring Training: 20g, .347, 1hr, 10rbi, 2sb... tied for the team lead in doubles (5) and ranked among the team leaders in hits (17)...hit safely in 13 of his 20 apps, including 10 of his last 14 apps (14-36, .389, 3 2b, 1hr, 8rbi) and each of his last 3 apps (3-9, .333, 1rbi)...made 9 starts in LF, 5 starts in RF and 4 starts at DH.
- Made his first Opening Day roster...was 1 of 5 rookies on the Opening Day roster.
- Started in LF on Opening Day.
- In 2017 at Louisville was an International League mid-season All-Star.
- Last season, in his Major League debut made 47 apps and 28 starts during 4 stints the Reds.
