THE GIANTS: Play game two of this three-game series against the Arizona Diamondbacks...San Francisco is 2-3 thus far on this eight-game homestand (one game was rained out) and have posted a 4-5 record overall this season...SF will try and snap a brief two-game losing streak with a win tonight.

ROSTER MOVES: Following last night's game the Giants optioned **RHP Roberto Gomez** to triple-A Sacramento...**RHP Tyler Beede** (#38) has been recalled and will make his Major League debut tonight.

AGAINST THE D-BACKS: The Giants are seeking their 200th all-time win versus the Arizona Diamondbacks tonight...since the D-Backs began play in 1998, the Giants have posted a 199-155 record...San Francisco's 199 wins versus Arizona are the fourth-most against a single opponent among NL teams from 1998-2018 (STATS, LLC).

LOOKING FOR WIN #1: 2014 first-round draft pick **Tyler Beede** will try to become the 16th San Francisco Giant to start and win his Major League debut and the first since **Ryan Sadowski** did it on June 28, 2009 at Milwaukee.

KEEPING IT IN THE YARD: Giants pitchers have held their opponents to just two home runs in nine games and 85.0 innings this season...the Giants have allowed the fewest homers of any big league team in 2018...last year, Giants pitchers allowed 182 home runs, tied with the Pirates for the third-most in MLB.

CLOSE CALLS: Six of the Giants' first nine games this season have been decided by just two runs or fewer.

POSEY AT THE PLATE: **C Buster Posey** enters tonight having hit safely in each of his last seven games at .435 (10-for-23) with three extra base hits (two doubles, homer) and three RBI...Posey's a career .293 hitter (12-for-41) against LHP Patrick Corbin.

RISPY BUSINESS: San Francisco batters have combined for a .119 batting average (8-for-67) with runners in scoring position...that's the lowest clip in the Majors (Cleveland is the second-lowest at .154).

BEGINS WITH THE STARTERS: San Francisco starters have allowed three earned runs or fewer in eight of their first nine starts...their combined 3.26 ERA ranks as the fifth-best figure among National League starting staffs.

CORBIN VS. SF: Arizona LHP Patrick Corbin is 5-7 with a 3.44 ERA (39er, 102.0ip) and .267 opponents batting average against in 17 career starts against San Francisco...he's just 1-3 with a 3.51 ERA (13er, 33.1ip) in his last six starts against the Giants...**OF Hunter Pence** is 15-for-33 (.455) against Corbin with four homers and 11 RBI.

GETTING AHEAD: The Giants are 4-0 this season when scoring first and 0-5 in games their opponent scores first.

FEW RUNS: San Francisco has been held to one run or fewer in six of the first nine games.

IN THE 'PEN: Giants relievers have combined for a 2.29 ERA and .244 opponents average against so far this season.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#38 RHP Tyler Beede
6-3, 210, 24 years old (May 23, 1993)
0-0 Record, -- ERA

- The 24-year-old right-hander is slated to make his first Major League start today in what will be his Major League debut.
- Appeared in four games this spring with the Giants, going 1-1 with a 10.80 ERA (10er, 8.1ip)...was optioned to triple-A Sacramento on March 19.
- Made the opening night start for Class A Advanced San Jose on April 5 and fired 5.0 innings, allowing one run on one hit and three walks with four strikeouts... he was added to San Jose's roster from triple-A Sacramento before the game due to weather concerns of the River Cats season-opening series in Tacoma.
- Spent all of 2017 with the Sacramento RiverCats... posted a 4.79 ERA (58er in 109.0ip) in 19 starts before suffering a groin injury.
- Made four starts in the Arizona Fall League, going 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (8er in 16.0ip).
- Won the Eastern League ERA crown with the Richmond Flying Squirrels in 2016...logged an 8-7 record with a 2.81 ERA in 24 starts that season.
- In 2015, Beede represented the Giants in the Futures Game while playing for the Richmond Flying Squirrels.
- Was drafted by San Francisco in the first round (14th overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft...entered the season ranked as the third-best prospect in the Giants' organization according to *Baseball America*.
- Attended Vanderbilt University and during his sophomore season he led the NCAA with a school-record 14 victories...in his junior season, Vanderbilt won their first College World Series title in school history.
- Was originally a first round selection by the Toronto Blue Jays (21st overall pick) in 2011 out of high school, but did not sign.

NOTES: The two-time All-Star (2014 & 2016) is slated to make his third start of the season...is 1-0 with a 0.69 ERA in his first two outings, allowing just one run in 13.0 innings of work...the Giants are 2-0 in his starts this year and 39-20 (.661) overall since Cueto joined the team in 2016...earned his first 2018 win in his last start on Wednesday vs. Seattle in the Giants' 10-1 victory...logged 6.0 innings and allowed just one run on eight hits...matched up with Felix Hernandez for the first time...is 11-3 with a 3.38 ERA (35er, 93.1ip) in 15 career starts against Arizona...the only team he's defeated more is the Pirates (20 wins).
