THE GIANTS: Look to win their third-straight game as they face the Reds in the middle game of this three-game series tonight.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves today: **OF Austin Slater** (#53) was optioned to triple-A Sacramento following last night's game...**IF Miguel Gómez** (#52) has been recalled from double-A Richmond and will be available for tonight's game.

HOT AT HOME: The Giants have been one of MLB's hottest teams since late April, winning eight of their last 11 games here at AT&T Park...only the Yankees (11-2, .846) and Pirates (7-2, .778) have a better home winning pct. than the Giants (.727) since April 23.

ON THE MOUND: LHP Ty Blach was on the losing end of a 6-3 score in his last start, Thursday at Philadelphia...Blach has started two previous games against Cincinnati, going 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA...the Reds will counter with RHP Tyler Mahle, who got the sweep of the Dodgers rolling in a 4-1 win Thursday...he allowed just one unearned run in 5.0 innings...Mahle has never pitched against the Giants.

HITTING STREAK: OF Andrew McCutchen enters tonight having hit safely in a season-high 13 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the NL and the second-longest in the big leagues behind Cleveland's Francisco Lindor (15 games).

ON-BASE STREAK: McCutchen has also reached base safely via hit, walk or hit by pitch in his last 24 games, the second-longest active streak in MLB behind Philadelphia's Odubel Herrera (41 games).

RUNS AT HOME: San Francisco is averaging 5.11 runs per game at AT&T Park this season (92 runs in 18 games)...only the Braves (5.73 r/g), Pirates (5.61), Cubs (5.57) and Phillies (5.41) are averaging more runs at home than the Giants.

GIANT RUNS: The Giants have scored 171 runs this season (4.07 per game), tied with the Rockies and Dodgers for the most in the NL West...the first-place Diamondbacks have scored 166 runs while the Padres have scored 160.

BELTING: IF Brandon Belt recorded three hits last night and now has six hits in his last nine at-bats...Belt's .931 OPS ranks as the 10th-best in the NL.

AGAINST RIGHTIES: The Giants are just 10-14 against right-handed starters this season (11-7 against left-handed starters)...tonight will be the 12th-straight game the Giants will have faced a RH starting pitcher.

GIANTS STARTERS: Have combined for a 7.38 ERA (32er, 39.0ip) in the last eight games, making it past the 5th inning just twice in that span.

WITH RISP: The Giants are hitting .232 with runners in scoring position (5-for-18 last night) and .193 with runners in scoring position and two outs.

The Alou brothers and **Orlando Cepeda** led an 18-hit attack as San Francisco overpowered the Cubs, 14 - 1...Cepeda hit two homers and a double and drove in five runs, while **Felipe Alou** hit his first grand slam and brother **Matty Alou** his first Major League homer.

6-1, 213, 27 years old (October 20, 1990)
3-3 Record, 3.60 ERA

- The 27-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 10th start of the season in the second game of this three-game series against the Reds.
- The Giants are 4-5 in his starts this year.
- Was touched for five runs on seven hits in 4.1 innings in his last start Thursday at Philadelphia in SF's 6-3 loss...surrendered a three-run homer to Carlos Santana in the 4th.
- Has 35 starts in his big league career and has allowed three walks or fewer in all of them.
- Has struck out 25 batters in 49.1 innings...his 4.56 strikeouts per 9.0 innings are the lowest in the Majors.
- His groundball percentage of 57.6% is the fifth-best in the Majors behind Lance McCullers Jr. (61.5), Charlie Morton (58.7), Jake Arrieta (57.9) and Dallas Keuchel (57.7).
- Will face the Reds for the third time in his career...faced them twice last year and went 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (10er, 10.0ip)...logged 7.0 innings while allowing two runs on five hits in his last start against them Aug. 19.
