**Winning**

Including the postseason, the Brewers have 101 wins, which ties a franchise record for a single year....the team also produced 101 wins in 1982 and 2011.

**Pitching In**

The Brewers have recorded a 2.14 ERA this postseason (75.2ip, 18er)....opponents have batted just .193 (52-for-269, 2hr).

**For Starters**

Brewers starting pitchers have a 0.68 ERA this postseason (26.2ip, 2er)....opponents have batted just .151 (14-for-93, 1hr)....the only runs were scored off **Gio Gonzalez** (3ip, 2er).

**Going the Extra Miley**

**Wade Miley** will become the fifth different pitcher (7x) to start consecutive games in a postseason series....the last to accomplish the feat was **George Earnshaw** for the Philadelphia A's in games 5 and 6 of the 1930 World Series against the Cardinals.

**Even Steven**

Coming into Game 6, the Brewers and Dodgers have each scored 16 runs....the Brewers have 39 hits and the Dodgers have 38.

**Win or Go Home**

The Brewers have not lost 3 consecutive games since 8/15-8/18 at Chicago-NL (1g) and at St. Louis (2g).

**TONIGHT:** Is Game 6 of the National League Championship Series against Los Angeles....the Dodgers lead the series, 3-2....these teams are meeting in the postseason for the first time ever....the Brewers swept Colorado in the National League Division Series, 3-0.

**IN THE STANDINGS (187 days):** The Brewers spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central standings this season: **FIRST:** 66, **SECOND:** 95, **THIRD:** 22, **FOURTH:** 4, **FIFTH:** 0....the team clinched a postseason berth on 9/26 and the NL Central championship on 10/1....prior to clinching the championship with a win at Chicago in game #163, the Brewers had not been in first place since 7/12.

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The Brewers went 31-15-7 in series play this season....the team won 12 of its last 13 series with the only loss coming from 9/14-9/16 vs. Pittsburgh (1-2).

**AT HOME:** The Brewers went 51-30 at home, going 16-7-3 in series play....their .630 home winning percentage was best in the National League and tied Tampa Bay for third in the majors....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 4/17-4/22 and a season-high 3-game home losing streak from 4/7-4/16....the team went 46-38 at home last season, going 14-9-4 in series play.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers went 45-37 on the road, going 15-8-4 in series play....their .549 road winning percentage ranked fourth in the National League....their 45 road wins marked the third most in franchise history (47-33-1 in 1982 and 46-34 in 1980)....the team won its last 6 road series and last 5 road games....had season-high 5-game road winning streaks from 4/30-5/11 and 9/23-10/1....had a season-high 6-game road losing streak from 7/11-7/15....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

**MANAGER:** **Craig Counsell** completed his fourth season as Brewers manager (316-308) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

**COACHES:** Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers made 34 replay challenges during the regular season, going 7-27....the team has made 10 replay challenges in the postseason, going 5-5....their last challenge (lost) came in Game 5 of the NLCS at Los Angeles as a safe call at second base involving Cody Bellinger on a stolen base was confirmed.

## GAME 6 STARTER: #20 - LHP WADE MILEY (16gs, 5-2, 2.57 in regular season)

**MILEY AT A GLANCE:** Wade Miley, 31, will be making his fourth start of the postseason and third of this series....Miley last started on Wednesday in Game 5 of the NLCS and faced one batter (walked Cody Bellinger)....he also started Game 2 of the NLCS vs. Los Angeles and received no decision in the Brewers' 4-3 loss (5.2ip, 2h, 0r, 0bb, 3k, 74 pitches)....his other postseason start came in Game 3 of the NLDS on 10/7 at Colorado as he received no decision in the Brewers' 6-0 series-clinching victory (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 2k, 64 pitches)....Miley had never pitched in the postseason prior to 2018....the team went 12-4 in his starts during the regular season, including 7 straight wins to finish the year....he made 6 quality starts....opponents batted just .237 (71-for-300, 3hr)....Miley was placed on the 10-day disabled list on 5/9 with a right oblique strain and transferred to the 60-day DL on 5/12....he was reinstated on 7/12....he was signed to a minor-league contract on 2/16 and invited to Major League camp....he suffered a groin strain while fielding a bunt on 3/21 vs. Oakland and was reassigned to minor-league camp on 3/28....Miley began a rehab assignment on 4/17 at Double-A Biloxi and joined the Brewers on 5/2....he returned to Biloxi for a second rehab stint on 6/22....bio is available in the press box.

**LAST SEASON:** Miley went 8-15 with a 5.61 ERA in 32 starts with Baltimore....he made 30+ starts for the fifth consecutive season....the team went 15-17 in his starts....he made 8 quality starts....opponents batted .287 (179-for-624, 25hr).

**CAREER:** Is 71-76 with a 4.26 ERA in 216 games / 212 starts (1236.1ip, 585er)....he has pitched for Arizona (2011-14), Boston (2015), Seattle (2016), Baltimore (2016-17) and Milwaukee (2018)....Miley was a 2012 National League All-Star while pitching for the D-backs.

**CAREER AT MILLER PARK:** Is 3-2 with a 5.40 ERA in 10 starts (41.2ip, 25er)....went 2-0 with a 2.67 ERA in 7 starts this season (30.1ip, 9er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 36-41 with a 4.12 ERA in 116 games / 115 starts (662.1ip, 303er)....went 3-2 with a 2.50 ERA in 9 starts this season (50.1ip, 14er).

**CAREER vs. DODGERS (POSTSEASON INCLUDED):** Is 4-5 with a 3.34 ERA in 17 games / 16 starts (94.1ip, 35er), including 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA in 4 starts this season (18.2ip, 0er)....during the regular season he received a no-decision in a 6-4 Brewers loss on 7/20 at Miller Park (6ip, 4h, 1r, 0er, 2bb, 2k, 1hbp) and earned a 1-0 victory on 7/31 at Dodger Stadium (7ip, 2h, 2bb, 5k).

**CAREER AT THE PLATE:** Is batting .155 (37-for-239) with 1 HR....has 9 walks and 66 strikeouts....his home run came on 4/22/13 at San Francisco (solo off Ryan Vogelsong).

**THIS SEASON:** Batted .185 (5-for-27)....had 1 walk and 11 strikeouts....did not have a sacrifice bunt.
