MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (273-278) and third full season.....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #57 - RHP CHASE ANDERSON (17gs, 6-6, 3.99)

ANDERSON AT A GLANCE: Chase Anderson, 30, is making his 18th start of the season and second against the Marlins....he last started last Wednesday vs. Minnesota and received no decision in a 3-2 win (6.1ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 5k)....he left the game with a 1-0 lead....Anderson is 1-0 with a 1.56 ERA over his last 3 starts (17.1ip, 3er)....opponents are batting just .123 during this stretch (7-for-57, 2hr)....the team is 10-7 in his starts....he has 8 quality starts....opponents are batting .204 (68-for-334, 17hr)....he was on the 10-day disabled list from 5/13-5/20 due to illness, retroactive to 5/10....Anderson, who made the first Opening Day start of his career, was acquired from Arizona, along with INF Aaron Hill, SS Isan Diaz and cash, in exchange for SS Jean Segura and RHP Tyler Wagner on 1/30/16....he is signed through the 2019 season with club options for 2020 and 2021....bio is on p. 60 of the media guide.

LAST SEASON: Anderson went 12-4 with a 2.74 ERA in 25 starts....he set career highs for wins (12) and strikeouts (133)....the team went 14-11 in his starts....he made 13 quality starts....opponents batted .220 (113-for-514, 14hr)....he was named Brewers Pitcher of the Month for April (5gs, 2-0, 2.10era) and September/October (6gs, 4-1, 2.06era)....Anderson was on the 10-day disabled list from 6/29-8/19 with a left oblique strain....he ranked sixth in the NL in ERA (2.89) and eighth in WHIP (1.11) at the time of his placement on the DL.

CAREER: Is 42-34 with a 3.89 ERA in 121 games / 120 starts (654.2ip, 283er)....is in his fifth MLB season....has pitched for Arizona (2014-15) and Milwaukee (2016-current)....Anderson has gone 27-21 with a 3.69 ERA in 73 games / 72 starts as a Brewer (387.2ip, 159er).

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 15-9 with a 3.83 ERA in 36 starts (200ip, 85er)....is 3-3 with a 4.83 ERA in 10 starts this season (54ip, 29er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 18-18 with a 3.99 ERA in 61 games / 60 starts (320.1ip, 142er)....is 3-3 with a 2.88 ERA in 7 starts this season (40.2ip, 13er).

CAREER vs. MARLINS: Is 3-2 with a 4.04 ERA in 6 starts (35.2ip, 16er), including a 12-3 victory this season on 4/19 at Miller Park (5.1ip, 5h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 3k, 2hr, 1hbp)....has gone 1-1 with a 3.15 ERA in 3 career starts at Marlins Park (20ip, 7er).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is a .099 (20-for-202) hitter....has not homered....has 2 walks and 106 strikeouts.
