NATIONALS NEWS

BREAK OUT THE BROOMS

On Wednesday afternoon, the Washington Nationals completed their eighth sweep of the season, topping the New York Mets, 5-3...Behind 7.0 strong innings of one run ball from left-handed pitcher **Tommy Milone**, a multi-hit performance from **Bryce Harper**, a pair of stolen bases from **Trea Turner** and **Anthony Rendon's** 16th home run of the season, the Nationals went on to top the New York Mets 5-3.

- The Nationals have won five of their last seven games...Over the seven-game stretch dating back to July 25, the Nationals have outscored their opponents 57-21 and rank first in the National League in average (.293), OBP (.392) and SLG (.530)...Their 73 hits trail only the Milwaukee Brewers (77) during that time.

ROOKIE OF THE MONTH...AGAIN

For the second consecutive month, **Juan Soto** was named National League Rookie of the Month...He led National League rookies in batting average (.299), on-base percentage (.398), slugging percentage (.526), OPS (.924), hits (29), RBI (15) and walks (16)...His five home runs for the month rank tied for first with ATL **Ronald Acuña Jr.**...He hit safely in 17 of the 25 games and reached base safely in 21 of the 25 games during the month of July.

- Soto leads all MLB rookies (min. 260 PA), in batting average (.309), on-base percentage (.415), slugging percentage (.559), and OPS (.974).
- Even though he was called up on May 20, he ranks among National League rookies this season in home runs (2nd, 13), walks (3rd, 40), runs (3rd, 43), RBI (5th, 36), hits (5th, 68) and doubles (T5th, 14).
- Since May 15 (the first game in his game log, due to the suspended game vs. NYY), Soto ranks among all National League hitters in on-base percentage (3rd, .415), runs scored (T6th, 43), slugging percentage (8th, .559), walks (8th, 40), home runs (T8th, 13) and batting average (13th, .309).
- Among all National League hitters (min. 260 PA) in 2018, he ranks in OPS (2nd, .974), on-base percentage (2nd, .415), batting average (7th, .309) and slugging percentage (7th, .559).
- With 13 home runs as a teenager, **Juan Soto** is tied with H.O.F. **Mickey Mantle** (1951) for the sixth-most home runs by a teenager in Major League history...Next on the list is H.O.F. **Ken Griffey Jr.** who hit 16 during the 1989 season.

SECOND HALF HARPER

Bryce Harper is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with four doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, seven walks, three stolen bases and 10 runs scored in 11 games since returning from the All-Star break...He has a .444 on-base percentage, a .611 slugging percentage and 1.056 OPS over this stretch.

- On the season, Harper's 85 walks lead all National League hitters and rank second in Major League Baseball behind LAA **Mike Trout** (99)...His 25 home runs rank tied for third in the National League.

TREA TAKES BASES

With two stolen bases on Tuesday night and two stolen bases in Wednesday's game **Trea Turner** bumped up his season total to 28...It marked the first time in his career that he has stolen multiple bases in consecutive games...Turner has six stolen bases over his last four games...On the season his 28 stolen bases lead all of Major League Baseball.

- Over his last six games, Turner is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with two doubles, one triple, three RBI, one HBP, six stolen bases and 10 runs scored.

TONY IS ON A TEAR

Anthony Rendon has hit safely in 31 of his last 36 games dating back to June 15...Over the stretch he is hitting .329 with a .375 on-base percentage and a .630 slugging percentage...He is tied for fifth in the National League with 23 extra-base hits (12 2B, 3B, 10 HR) and his .630 slugging percentage is good for sixth over this stretch.

- Rendon's recent surge has him in ranked in the National League in doubles (8th, 26), slugging percentage (9th, .523) and OPS (13th, .873) on the season.

MURPH IS MASHING

Daniel Murphy recorded his first multi-home run game of the season on Tuesday night...He clubbed a two-run shot in the second inning and a three-run blast in the third...He recorded a career-high six RBI, as well.

- In 18 games dating to July 8, **Daniel Murphy** is 23-for-56 (.411) with a .469 on-base percentage (23 H, 7 BB) and a .643 slugging percentage (4 2B, 3 HR)...He has struck out just six times over this stretch.
- Murphy has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games, going 15-for-39 (.385) with two doubles, three homers, 13 RBI, three walks and five runs scored.

NATIONALS HISTORY

August 2 (9-4 on this date)

2012 - **Ross Detwiler** tossed 7.0 scoreless innings, using predominantly his fastball, and the Nationals blanked PHI, 3-0, in DC. Reportedly, 78 of Detwiler's 88 pitches were fastballs. **Adam LaRoche** homered in the second inning to reach the 20-homer plateau for the seventh time in eight years. **Jayson Werth** (single, RBI, walk) returned to Washington's lineup after missing 75 games with a fractured left wrist.

IN THE COMMUNITY

August 4: Harris Teeter Food Drive

The Nationals will collect non-perishable food items for the annual Harris Teeter Food Drive outside Center Field Gate on August 4 and 5. Fans who donate at least four items will receive two tickets to a Nationals home game (while supplies last). All items collected benefit the Capital Area Food Bank. Donation collections will begin three hours before first pitch.

OPPONENT

CINCINNATI REDS

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** spent the 1992 season with the Cincinnati Reds, hitting .254 with 20 doubles, five triples, three homers, 31 RBI and 47 runs scored in 135 games...Reds interim manager **Jim Riggleman** managed the Nationals from 2009-11.

THE SERIES

The Nationals and Reds will face off seven times in 2018 (3 in CIN, 4 in D.C.)...Since June 5, 2016, Washington has won 13 of the last 15 games against the Reds, outscoring them 124-63 over this stretch.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#31 - MAX SCHERZER - RHP

Polished veteran right-hander, three-time Cy Young Award Winner and five-time consecutive All-Star signed a historic seven-year contract with Washington on Jan. 21, 2015...Joined the Nationals after seven Major League seasons with the Detroit Tigers (2010-14) and Arizona Diamondbacks (2008-09)...Is one of just 10 pitchers in Major League history to take home the Cy Young Award three or more times.

AGAINST THE REDS: Faces Cincinnati for the second time this season...Is 3-1 with a 2.05 ERA in five career starts against the Reds...His 2.05 ERA is his lowest against any NL Central team.

LAST START: Won his fourth straight start, tossing 8.0 innings, allowing one unearned run on just three hits as Washington topped Miami, 9-1...Struck out 11 batters while issuing just one walk and one hit batter...It was his fourth straight start with two walks or fewer.

- Ranks among NL pitchers in strikeouts (1st, 200), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (1st, 12.11), WHIP (1st, 0.90), opp. AVG (1st, .183), opp. OBP (1st, .245), hits per 9.0 IP (1st, 5.93), wins (1st, 14), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 5.56), ERA (2nd, 2.30), opp. OPS (3rd, .577) and opp. SLG (4th, .332).
- Has tossed at least 7.0 innings in 12 starts, tied for the second-most in MLB and second-most in the National League.
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout as a member of the Nationals on July 2 vs. BOS, becoming the 11th pitcher in MLB history to collect at least 1,000 strikeouts with two different clubs...The list, according to *Elías*: **Jim Bunning** (DET/PHI), **Roger Clemens** (BOS/NYY), **Randy Johnson** (ARI/SEA), **Mark Langston** (ANA/SEA), **Greg Maddux** (CHI/ATL), **Mike Mussina** (BAL/NYY), **Nolan Ryan** (CAL/HOU), **CC Sabathia** (CLE/NYY), **Luis Tiant** (BOS/CLE) and **Cy Young** (BOS/CLE)
- Recorded a nine-game winning streak from (4/9-6/5) which tied the second-longest streak of his career (13 G; 4/6-7/3/13 and 9 G; 8/20/16-4/7/17)...It is the longest winning streak in Major League Baseball in 2018.
- Struck out at least 10 batters in three consecutive starts from May 6-19, tied for the the third-longest streak of his career (6 G; 5/26-6/21/17).
- Did not earn the win, but struck out a season-high 15 batters on May 6 vs. PHI...It was his fifth career 15+ strikeout game...He became the first pitcher in Major League history (since 1913) to strike out at least 15 batters in no more than 6.1 IP according to Baseball-Reference.com.
- Was named National League Pitcher of the Month for April (5-0, 1.62 ERA, 57 SO, 9 BB, .165 opp. AVG) and May (4-0, 2.21 ERA, 63 SO, 10 BB).
- Was named National League Player of the Week for the week of April 9 through 15 (2-0, 1.13 ERA, 21 SO, BB, 3 H).

CAREER NOTES

- His 75 games of 10+ strikeouts are rank eighth-most in MLB history (since 1913) and most among active pitchers...**Steve Carlton** (H.O.F., 1994) is next on the list with 84 10+ strikeout games.
- His 40 games of 10+ strikeouts and one earned run or fewer allowed are tied **Walter Johnson** (H.O.F., 1936) for seventh-most in MLB history (since 1913) and most among active pitchers.
- His 21 games of 10+ strikeouts and zero earned runs allowed are tied with **Tom Seaver** (H.O.F., 1992) for seventh-most in MLB history (since 1913) and second-most among active pitchers (**Clayton Kershaw** - 23)...Scherzer's five career games with 15 or more strikeouts are the most among active players and tied for seventh-most all-time .
- Leads all active starters and ranks second in MLB history with a career 10.33 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (**Randy Johnson** - 10.61).
- His career .198 opp. AVG vs. right-handed batters is fourth-best all-time and second among starting pitchers (**J.R. Richard** - .186).
- Is the only pitcher in MLB with an active streak of seven-plus seasons with at least 200 strikeouts.
- Since joining the Nationals in 2015, has taken a no-hitter into the sixth inning in 11 of 118 starts (9.3%), per MASN in-game reporter, Dan Kolko.
- Since 2015, has posted a 0.93 WHIP, behind only **Clayton Kershaw** (0.89) for the best over this stretch.
