NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees improved to 3-3 on their seven-game homestand...are 11-4 in their last 15G...at 86-50, are a season-high-tying 36G over .500 for the third time this season (last at 84-48 at the end of play on Tuesday).
 - Improved to 22-8 (.733) vs. the AL Central this season.
 - Own the Majors' best record when their starter tosses at least 6.0IP (53-9, .855).
 - Was just their fifth one-run game since 7/29...have won four straight one-run games.
- **Yankees batters** were held to 2R and 2H...was just their third game with 2H-or-fewer this season...was their first win with 2H-or-fewer since 5/27/17 vs. Oakland (2H in a 3-2 win)...since the start of 2016, have won three of their 7G in which they were held to 2H-or-fewer...improved to 5-22 when scoring 2R-or-fewer.
 - Went 12-up, 12-down to begin the game before Andújar walked in the fifth.
 - Have scored prior to the fifth inning in just two of six games on this homestand.
- **SS/2B Gleyber Torres** (1-for-3) hit a two-run HR in the fifth inning...was his 22nd HR of the season...has 2RBI in three consecutive games, the longest multi-RBI streak of his career...has homered in 2-of-3, 3-of-6 and 4-of-9.
 - Is batting .420/.500/.660 (21-for-50) with 9R, 4HR, 11RBI, 8BB and 2SB in his last 14G (since 8/18).
- **RHP Masahiro Tanaka** (7.0IP, 7H, 1ER, 1BB, 6K) started and earned his 10th win...snapped streaks of three consecutive losses and five winless starts...is just his third start of at least 7.0IP this season (also had 7.0IP in his last start on Mon. vs. Chicago-AL and a CG SHO on 7/24 at Tampa Bay)...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in seven of his last nine starts, posting a 2.68 ERA (57.0IP, 17ER) over that span...was his first win vs. Detroit at Yankee Stadium (was 0-3 in his first three home starts).
 - Is the second pitcher in Yankees history to reach double-digit wins in each of his first five Major League seasons, joining Andy Pettitte, who did it in each of his first nine campaigns (1995-2003).
 - Is 6-2 with a 2.26 ERA (63.2IP, 16ER) in his last 10 day starts (since 8/2/17).
 - Escaped a two-on, no-out jam in the seventh with a groundout and two strikeouts.
- **RHP Dellin Betances** (1.0IP, 1H, 1K) converted his second save of the season.
 - Struck out Jeimer Candelario to begin the ninth inning to become **the first reliever in Major League history to record at least 100K in five consecutive seasons.**
 - Has at least 1K in 36 consecutive relief appearances, the fourth-longest streak in Major League history, behind Aroldis Chapman (49, 8/21/13-8/13/14), Corey Knebel (46, 10/2/16-7/15/17) and Bruce Sutter (39, 6/1-10/2/77).
 - Has a 1.26 ERA (35.2IP, 5ER) in his last 37 appearances since 5/27.
- **RF Andrew McCutchen** (0-for-3, 1HP) made his Yankees debut, batting leadoff.
- **SS Adeiny Hechavarria** made his Yankees debut as a defensive replacement in the ninth inning.
- **PR/2B/3B Tyler Wade** recorded his second career stolen base in the seventh.

DETROIT TIGERS NOTES

- The Tigers fell to 1-4 on their current three-city, nine-game road trip...fell to 35-34 when scoring first this season...are now 36-24 when outhitting the opponent this season...also fell to 19-23 in one-run games this season.
 - Are now 2-4 vs. the Yankees this season...with today's loss, have lost the season series and are 0-4-3 in season series since 2012, going 20-28 over the span...are 11-21 all-time at the current Yankee Stadium.
- **Detroit batters** did not hit a home run today, snapping their six-game streak with at least 1HR (10HR total during streak)...fell to 15-45 this season when hitting 0HR.
- **LHP Daniel Norris** (4.1IP, 1H, 2ER, 1BB, 7K, 1HR) was reinstated from the 60-day D.L. prior to today's start and made his first start since 4/29...retired his first 12BF before walking Miguel Andújar to lead off the fifth inning...did not allow a hit until a fifth-inning, one-out HR by Gleyber Torres...recorded his most strikeouts in a game since 6/16/17 vs. Tampa Bay (8K).
 - Was the second consecutive Detroit starter to take a no-hitter into the fifth inning (Jordan Zimmermann did not allow a hit until Brett Gardner's one-out home run in the sixth inning on Friday).
 - Was removed with one out in the fifth and a 2-2 count to 1B Luke Voit due to left calf cramping.
- **DH Victor Martinez** (0-for-3, 1RBI) drove in Detroit's sole run with in the first inning with his sacrifice fly...has 7RBI in six games vs. the Yankees this season.
- **1B Jim Adduci** (2-for-4, 2K) has registered multi-hit efforts in three of his last five games and six of his last 12 games, hitting .359 (14-for-39) with 2R, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 7RBI and 2BB over the loner span.
- **CF JaCoby Jones** (2-for-4, 1K, 1SB) has hit safely in all three games this series, going 4-for-12 with 1R, 1 double and 1SB...had his first multi-hit game since 8/1 vs. Cincinnati...added his 10th stolen base of the season and first since 7/28 vs. Cleveland.
- **RF Nicholas Castellanos** (2-for-3, 1BB) logged his team-leading 45th multi-hit game of the season.
- **LHP Daniel Stumpf** (0.2IP, 1K) has not allowed a run since being recalled from Triple-A on 8/19, throwing 6.1 scoreless innings in six appearances...opponents are hitting just .050 (1-for-20) with 1BB and 8K over the span.
