**STREAKING:** The Cardinals have won eight straight games at Great American Ballpark, their longest win streak at the most current home of the Reds...the Cardinals longest win streak in Cincinnati was 10 from Aug. 1, 1930-May 23, 1931 at Crosley Field. The longest road win streak by any team in Cincinnati is held by the Brooklyn Dodgers from 6/22/1947-5/22/1949. The Cardinals longest road win streak against the same opponent is 18 against the Pittsburgh Pirates at Forbes Field from 5/7/1964-4/15/1966.

**JACKIE ROBINSON DAY:** Today marks the 71st anniversary of the Major League debut of Hall of Famer **Jackie Robinson**, who broke the color barrier on April 15, 1947 with the Brooklyn Dodgers. In his honor, every player, coach and umpire in MLB will wear No. 42 in their games today.

**BOMBIN' BIRDIES:** The Cardinals lead the National League with 23 home runs, which is the 5th highest home run total in Cardinals history through 15 games behind the first place 36 long balls by the 2000 St. Louis Cardinals.

**BENCH-MARK:** When the Cardinals recorded the third out in the bottom of the 5th inning yesterday, **Yadier Molina** passed Hall of Fame catcher from the Reds **Johnny Bench** (14,489) into 13th place all-time in innings caught. Next up on the list in 12th place is former Cardinals catcher **Ted Simmons** (15,092.1).

**SOLO SHOTS:** The Cardinals first seven home runs hit during this series were all solo home runs. **Greg Garcia** snapped the streak with a two-run home run in the 4th inning yesterday afternoon. The eight big flies since Thursday are the most by any MLB team.

**WHAT UP, G?:** **Greg Garcia** tallied a few firsts yesterday afternoon when he hit two home runs which marked his first multi-home run game. The two home runs were against LHP **Brandon Finnegan**, which also marked his first MLB home run against a left-handed pitcher. The 10 total bases were the most by a Cardinals second baseman since **Matt Carpenter** had 11 at Seattle (6/26/16).

**STARTING SUCCESS:** **Miles Mikolas** joined **Michael Wacha** and **Luke Weaver** with wins the last three games, marking three straight wins by Cardinals starting pitchers. It marked the first time Cardinals starting pitchers have earned a win in three straight games this season and the most recent since June 9-11 vs. Philadelphia (**Wacha, Martinez, Wainwright**) and since April 21-23, 2017 on the road (**Wainwright, Lynn, Leake**). The last time the Cardinals has starting pitchers record four straight wins on the same road trip was five from Aug. 23-27, 2015 at San Diego and Arizona (**Wacha, Lynn, Garcia, Lackey, Martinez**).

**SECOND HOME:** **Yadier Molina** has incredible success at Great American Ballpark with a career .318 average to go with 14 home runs and 53 RBI. Molina has racked up his highest numbers at GABP over all other road ballparks in hits (113), home runs (14), RBI (53), doubles (25) and extra base hits (39).

**RUNNING WILD:** **Tommy Pham** has scored in a team-high six straight games, tying his career best (6/25-30/2017). His run streak is currently the longest active in the National League.

**NO RED LIGHT HERE:** **Tommy Pham** tied his career-high with two stolen bases yesterday (4th time) giving him nine thefts in his career against the Reds. His nine stolen bases against the Reds over the last two years are the most in MLB.

#### CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Cardinals Manager **Mike Matheny** (1988) graduated from nearby Reynoldsburg (Ohio) High School...his daughter, Katie, played women's ice hockey at The Ohio State University.

Cardinals outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** and Reds pitcher **Austin Brice** were Marlins teammates in 2016.

Cardinals infielder **Jedd Gyorko** and Reds pitcher **Kevin Quackenbush** were Padres teammates for two seasons (2014-15).

Cardinals pitcher **Michael Wacha's** uncle, **Dusty Rogers**, was a Reds first round draft pick in 1984...played in the Reds minor league organization for five seasons (1984-88)

Reds Executive Advisor to the CEO **Walt Jocketty** served as the Cardinals General Manager for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, the Cardinals compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-06), two NL Championships ('04, '06), and one World Series Championship ('06)...the Cardinals recorded seven straight winning seasons under Jocketty, including a pair of 100+ win seasons ('04-05)...named MLB Executive of the Year (2000, '04, '10).

Reds Player Performance Special Assistant **Eric Davis** played two seasons (1999-2000) for St. Louis.

Reds bench coach **Jim Riggleman** spent 18 seasons (1976-90, 2005-07) in the Cardinals system as a minor league player (1976-81), minor league coach (AA-Arkansas, 1981), minor league manager (High-A-St. Petersburg, '82-84 & AA-Arkansas, '85-88), Director of Player Development ('88-89), St. Louis First Base Coach (1989-90) and minor league fielding coordinator (2005-07).

Reds professional scout **Bruce Manno** (2002-07) previously worked in the Cardinals front office for six seasons (2002-07)...served as Director of Player Development (2002-06) and Senior Director of Pro Scouting & Special Assistant to the General Manager (2007) before joining Atlanta.

Reds assistant pitching/bullpen coach **Ted Power** pitched in 23 games for St. Louis in 1989.

Reds catching coach **Mike Stefanski** played parts for six seasons in the Cardinals minors (1996-2001)...originally acquired by St. Louis from Milwaukee in exchange for catcher **Marc Ronan** (November 19, 1995).

Reds Special Assistant to the General Manager, Player Personnel **Cam Bonifay** worked for the Cardinals as a special assistant, evaluating the American League East from October of 2007-08.

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis (1998).

Reds Special Assistant to the GM **Marty Maier** spent 24 seasons with St. Louis as an area scout, Latin American coordinator, asst. director of scouting, scouting director and special asst. to the GM.

Reds Special Assistant to the General Manager **John Morris** played five seasons for St. Louis (1986-90).

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds during his final professional season (2010).

Reds broadcaster **George Grande** was a Cardinals play-by-play announcer for two seasons (1991-92).

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds, and a shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds President and Chief Executive Office **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were investors in the Cardinals from 1995-2006...their interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

Reds Media Relations Intern **Ben Barnette** was a 2015 Cardinals Spring Training Intern and 2016 Memphis Redbirds (AAA) Media Relations Intern.

- Has hit a batsman in a club-record four consecutive games dating to 9/26/17.

- Allowed a one-out solo HR in opening inning on 4/10 vs. MIL, then blanked the Brewers over his final 5.2 IP, taking ND in Cardinals 5-3 11-inning win that featured comebacks in the 6th, 9th, & 10th before Matt Carpenter hit a 2-run walk-off HR in the 11th.

- Is tied for the N.L. lead in hit batsmen (3). Ranks T3rd in walks (10), 10th in IP (18.2), T11th in strikeouts (19) and 6th in batters faced (82).
- Pitched 8.1 scoreless innings of four-hit ball on 4/4 at Milwaukee for his 1st win of 2018 before being removed after 114 pitches in the 9th inning.

### CAREER

- His 76 GDP induced since 2015 rank 2nd among MLB pitchers trailing Texas' Martin Perez (82).
- Has won 43 games over the past three seasons (2015-present), ranking T6th-most among National League pitchers.
- Of his 103 career starts, 69 have been 6.0 innings or more and 62 of those registered as quality starts.
- Two-time N.L. All-Star: Selected in 2017 (player vote) and 2015 (Final Fan Vote).
- Switched uniform number from 44 to 18 in 2015 to honor his late friend and teammate Oscar Taveras.
- Pitched for the Dominican Republic in the 2017 World Baseball Classic
- Registered 608 strikeouts in his first 100 career starts, most among pitchers in Cards history (Lance Lynn had 581 in first 100 starts) (*Elias*).

### 2017

- Established career-bests in starts (32), innings (205.0), strikeouts (217) and opponent BA (.232) in the first of a five-year contract extension signed before the season.
- Ranked among NL leaders in shutouts (2, 1st), batters faced (858, T1st), innings (2nd), strikeouts (4th), quality starts (20, T4th), starts (T5th), opponent batting average (8th), SO/9 IP (9.53, 9th), H/9 IP (7.86, 9th), WHIP (1.22, T10th), and ERA (3.64, 14th).
- Also ranked in the Top 10 among N.L. pitchers in opp. OBP (.302, 10th), baserunners/9 IP (11.33, 10th) and walks (71, T7th).
- His 217 strikeouts were the 9th-highest single-season total in Cardinals history and most by a Dominican-born pitcher in Cards history, besting Jose DeLeon's 208 in 1988.
- Was the 7th Cardinal to reach 200 strikeouts, joining Bob Gibson (9x), Adam Wainwright (3x) Jose DeLeon (2x), Chris Carpenter (1x), Steve Carlton (1x) and Sam Jones (1x).
