ROAD TRIPPIN' REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their nine-game/10-day road trip through Pittsburgh (2-1), Miami (1-1) and Kansas City with tonight's finale of a three-game series at Marlins Park. This nine-game stretch ties the Cardinals' longest road trip of the season (July 2-11: ARI, SF, CWS). St. Louis is 11-9 post All-Star Break and 12-9 under interim manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 7.5 games out of first place and 4.0 games out of the second Wild Card position.

KEEP IT ROLLING: The Cardinals have sported a winning August record in each of the last seven seasons (2011-17), and are one of six Major League teams with five wins this month (BOS, CHI, HOU, PHI, WSH)...Sunday marked the Cardinals season-best third consecutive winning series (vs. Cubs 2-1; vs. Rockies 3-1; at Pirates 2-1), and a win tonight would give the club four straight, something the Cardinals have not achieved since May 30-June 12, 2016 (at Milwaukee, 2-1; vs San Francisco, 2-1; at Cincinnati, 2-1; at Pittsburgh, 3-0).

IT'S GOTTA BE THE SALSA: Reigning NL Player of the Month and Week **Matt Carpenter**, who has gone yard in five of his last eight games, leads the National League with a career-high 30 home runs...Carpenter leads Major League Baseball with 20 road home runs (**Khris Davis**, 17), 8 leadoff home runs (**George Springer**, 6) and 26 solo blasts (**Mike Trout**, 22), which are T5th-most in Cardinals single-season history (**Mark McGwire** leads with 35 in 1999).

SELECT COMPANY: **Matt Carpenter** is the sixth left-handed batter to hit 30 or more home runs in a season in franchise history (15th occurrence). **Johnny Mize** (1940) holds with team record with 43. Other Cardinals left-handed hitters include **Jim Edmonds** (4 times), **Stan Musial** (6 times), **Ray Lankford** (2 times) and **Jim Bottomley**.

30/30: Carpenter is the first Major Leaguer this season to hit 30 or more home runs and 30 or more doubles, and the 13th different Cardinal reach the feat in franchise history (31st occurrence)...the last Cardinal with 30 homers and 30 doubles was **Albert Pujols** in 2010 (42 HRs, 39 2Bs), who reached the milestone 10 consecutive seasons from 2001-10.

ALL THE TOOLS: With a go-ahead homer last night, Carpenter extended his on-base streak to 26 games (July 8-present), longest active in the Majors, T9th-longest in the Majors this season, and ties his career high (Sept. 18, 2014-April 28, 2015). Over that red-hot stretch, he is slashing .366/.483/.892 with 34 hits, seven doubles, 14 home runs, 21 walks and 24 RBI.

DEJONG'S DOUBLE DIGITS: **Paul DeJong's** game-tying two-run homer last night gave him 10 home runs this season, making him the 9th Cardinal to hit 10 or more home runs in their first two Major League seasons. His combined 35 home runs over his first two seasons are 5th-most in franchise history (**Albert Pujols** leads with 71).

YOUNG BIRDS: Tonight, **Adolis Garcia** becomes the 7th Cardinal to make his MLB debut this season, joining **Jordan Hicks**, **Yario Muñoz**, **Tyler O'Neill**, **Austin Gomber**, **Daniel Poncedeleon**, and **Dakota Hudson**. St. Louis' seven MLB debuts are tied with Colorado for 5th most in the NL (the Mets and Padres co-lead with 11 debuts).

WHAT A RELIEF: In their last 12 games since July 27, the Cardinals bullpen leads the National League in ERA (1.43), wins (4), average against (.174), and baserunners/9.0 IP (8.80), ranks 2nd in WHIP (0.98), and innings (44.0) and 4th in strikeouts (37).

MIAMI CONNECTIONS

Marcell Ozuna spent parts of five seasons in a Marlins uniform (2013-17) where he was a two-time NL All-Star (2016-17)...won the 2017 National League Silver Slugger and Rawlings Gold Glove awards...originally signed with the Marlins as a non-drafted free agent (Feb. 15, 2008)...became a Cardinal via trade with the Marlins this offseason, exchanged for pitchers **Daniel Castano**, **Zac Gallen**, and **Sandy Alcántara** and outfielder **Magneuris Sierra** (December 14, 2017).

Yadier Molina and **Carlos Martinez** represented St. Louis in the 2017 MLB All-Star Game at Marlins Park...Molina became the 7th Cardinal (14th time) to homer in an All-Star game...Martinez joined **Dizzy Dean** (1934) as the only two Cardinals with 4 strikeouts in an All-Star Game.

Matt Carpenter and **Bryan Holaday** were teammates in 2008 at Texas Christian University.

Miles Mikolas made his MLB debut vs. the Marlins in 2012 while with San Diego...graduated from nearby Jupiter (Fla.) High School and Nova Southeastern University.

Austin Gomber pitched Florida Atlantic University in nearby Boca Raton, Fla.

Trevor Richards graduated from Mater Dei Catholic High School in nearby Aviston Ill....pitched at Drury University in Springfield, Mo., where his 230 career strikeouts were second-most in program history at the time of his graduation...pitched 2015-16 seasons for the Gateway Grizzlies of the independent Frontier League.

Brett Graves was born in St. Charles, Mo...graduated from Francis Howell High School...named the 2011 Gatorade baseball player of the year for Missouri...originally selected by St. Louis in the 26th round of the 2011 MLB draft, but did not sign to attend the University of Missouri.

Pitcher **Kyle Barraclough** was selected by the Cardinals in the 7th round of the 2012 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in the Cardinals minor league system (2012-15)...traded by St. Louis to the Marlins for pitcher **Steve Cishek** (July 24, 2015).

Marlins VP of Scouting **Stan Meek** was selected by the Cardinals in the 15th round of the 1974 MLB Draft...played four seasons (1974-77) in the Cardinals' minor league system.

Outfielder **Magneuris Sierra** played in 22 games for St. Louis during the 2017 season...named the Cardinals 2014 Minor League Player of the Year...originally signed by the Cardinals as a non-drafted free agent (July 13, 2012).

Marlins broadcaster **Jeff Nelson** was a Cardinals non-roster invitee to 2006 Spring Training, but was released at the end of Spring Training.

Cardinals Communications Game Day Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2016 Communications Intern for the Marlins.

Since 2003, the Cardinals and Marlins have shared the Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium Complex in Jupiter Fla. as their Spring Training site...RDCS is also the only stadium in the country to host four minor league teams: Jupiter Hammerheads and Palm Beach Cardinals of the High-A Florida State League, and the GCL Marlins and GCL Cardinals of the Rookie-level Gulf Coast League.

The Marlins played their first regular season game at Marlins Park against St. Louis (April 4, 2012), a 4-1 Cardinals win.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 10th start of the season (17th appearance) and 19th career Major League start (44th career appearance).
- Has taken rotation spot of Michael Wacha, who's currently on DL with left oblique strain.
- Is 1-4 with 4.63 ERA (24 ER/46.2 IP) in nine starts for St. Louis, averaging 7.9 strikeouts/9 IP (41 K).
- Is 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA in seven relief appearances (16.2 IP).
- Is limiting the opposition to a .218 average against (52-238) this season, and he sports a .227 OPP AVG (40-176) as a starting pitcher.
- All six home runs allowed this season have been hit by left-handers: Odúbel Herrera, Freddie Freeman, Pablo Sandoval, Tucker Barnhart, Ben Zobrist & Anthony Rizzo.
- Features a split-finger change-up nicknamed the "Vulcan" due to his unique four-finger grip. Has highest pct. of swing & miss (5.1) on a change-up of any Cardinals pitcher.

LAST TIME OUT

- Had his shortest start (4.0 IP) of the season and allowed a career single-game high 6 runs and 8 hits, taking a no-decision in road trip opening game last Fri. (8/3) at PIT.

- Took the mound for ESPN Sunday Night game on 7/29 vs. CHI and was charged with 5-2 loss, allowing three runs (2 earned) on 2 HR's in 4.1 IP.
- Threw 1.0 inning of relief in a 7-3 defeat at Cincinnati allowing 2-run HR by T. Barnhart.
- Had 5.0 scoreless innings in Game 2 of 7/21 doubleheader against the Cubs at Wrigley Field as Cards scored five unanswered runs over the final three innings for a 6-3 victory.
- Was the most recent Cardinals pitcher to start Game 2 of a doubleheader since Marco Gonzales vs. MIL (6/13/17) and to do so against the Cubs since Tim Cooney (7/7/15).
- Had a career-best scoreless innings streak of 9.0 innings from 7/15-7/21.
- Hurlled 4.0 scoreless innings without allowing at hit vs. CIN (7/15) to earn the win in Mike Shildt's managerial debut. It was the longest relief outing by a Cardinals pitcher in 2018 and the 2nd-longest relief outing of Gant's career (4.2 IP at BOS 4/27/16 w/ATL).
- Took the rotation turn of Michael Wacha (10-day D.L.) and tossed 7.0 scoreless innings with one infield hit allowed, earning a 4-0 win against Cleveland (6/25).
- Was recalled from Memphis (AAA) on 6/21 and worked 2.0 innings in relief at MIL, striking out 2 and allowing 4 unearned runs on 3 hits.
- Was 5-1 with a 1.65 ERA in his eight starts overall at Memphis (AAA) this season.
- Struck out 7 in consecutive starts: 5/19 vs. PHI & 5/25 at PIT (14 K's/9.2 IP).
- Worked in relief of Adam Wainwright in St. Louis' 5-3 loss to the Padres at PETCO Park (5/13). Set single-game team highs for relief IP (3.2) and tied for strikeouts in relief (4).
