BRING IT HOME: The Padres fell 8-4 last night to the Brewers, dropping to 1-4 on the season vs. MIL...in today's rubber match, the Friars are in search of their fifth road series victory (currently 4-12-2) and their sixth rubber-game win (currently 5-10)... last night, in his Major League debut, RHP **Brett Kennedy** worked 4.0 innings, allowing 11 hits on six runs (earned) and three strikeouts...he became the first pitcher since 1900 to give up three-straight homers in the first inning of his debut...**Freddy Galvis** and **Hunter Renfroe** logged multiple hits in the game, and Renfroe hit his third homer in as many days.

MY NAME IS ERL: **Robbie Erlin** toes the rubber for his fourth start this season, searching for his second-consecutive victory as a starter (has only done so once in his career when he won three-straight starts from May 11-Sept. 14, 2014)...last Thursday at Wrigley Field, he earned his first win as a starter since September 26, 2015 vs. ARI, limiting the NL Central-leading Cubs' offense to one run on two hits in SD's 6-1 victory.

HUNTING FOR HITS, HOMERS, ETC.: **Hunter Renfroe** has homered in three-straight games for the first time in his career, and he also has multiple hits in three-consecutive games for the first time as well...Renfroe has hit in six-straight games (9-for-25, .360) with one double and three homers (.760 SLG), tying for the longest hitting streak of his career (done three times in total).

WHO'S HOTTEST IN AUGUST: Since August 1, three Padres rank in the top 10 in batting average in the National League (min. 12 at-bats), which are the most players of any NL team...**Christian Villanueva's** .429 average (9-for-21) ties for fifth, **Travis Jankowski's** .417 clip (5-for-12) ties for seventh and **Cory Spangenberg's** .400 mark (6-for-15) ties for 10th.

HOZAH! **Eric Hosmer** has reached base via hit or walk in 14-straight games (.387 OBP), and the streak has now tied his season high (May 11-26).

WORK THOSE BASES: Since the All-Star break, the Padres have drawn just 44 walks, the fifth-fewest of any team, with 14.84 plate appearances per walk...prior to the All-Star game, the Friars had a walk every 12.51 plate appearances.

DESERT ISLAND: The Friar bullpen have inherited 134 runners this season, allowing just 30 runners to score for a National League-leading 22.4 IR scoring percent...they trail just LAA for the best percentage in baseball this season (20.2).

WHIP THOSE VOTES: Padre starters have the highest WHIP of any rotation this season (1.49), while the Padres relief core have the third-best WHIP in '18 (1.18)... since the All-Star break, the Friar bullpen's 1.03 WHIP is the second-best in the majors behind just LAD's 0.98...conversely, Milwaukee's bullpen has a 1.64 WHIP since the break, the third-highest mark in the ML in that time.

IT'S ALWAYS SUNNY IN SAN DIEGO: Following today's game, the Padres will fly home to take-on the Philadelphia Phillies for the final meeting between the clubs this season...since 2017, the Padres have a 6-3 record vs. PHI, with Padres hurlers holding Phillies bats to a .228 average and a .200 average with RISP...in the 10th homestand of the season, the Friars will host the Phillies (Aug. 10-12), LA Angels (Aug. 13-15) and the D-Backs (Aug. 16-19).

PADRES ON DECK: Last night for Lake Elsinore (A), **Luis Torrens** was 4-for-5 with a double, a homer and four RBI, and **Edward Olivares** was 3-for-4 with a walk, three RBIs and two runs scored...also for the Storm, LHP **Nick Margevicius** allowed a run on six hits and a walk with over 7.0 innings.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#41 LHP ROBBIE ERLIN (2-3, 3.34)

HURLIN' ERLIN: 27-year-old **Robbie Erlin** is set to make his fourth start of the season and 29th of his career today in the series and season finale against Milwaukee...it will be his first career start and appearance at Miller Park...made his first career appearance against the Brewers on 3/31, tossing 3.2 IP of relief (3 H, 2 R, 2 ER) in SD's 7-3 loss.

LAST TIME OUT: Last Thursday at Wrigley Field, earned his first win as a starter since September 26, 2015 vs. ARI...limited the NL Central-leading Cubs' offense to one run on two hits in SD's 6-1 victory...had been saddled with the loss in each of his previous five starts dating back to October 3, 2015.

- In his career as a starter, he is now 9-14 with a 4.84 ERA (82 ER, 152.1 IP).
- A win today would mark just the second time in his career that he has recorded consecutive wins as a starter (also, May 11-September 14, 2014).

HOT AS SUMMER: Allowed just one run in his seven July relief appearances and 12.0 IP (0.75 ERA)...struck out 10 and walked just one while limiting opposing hitters to a .158 average.

- Since July 1, Erlin has posted a 1.06 ERA (2 ER, 17.0 IP) with 14 strikeouts against two walks across eight appearances (one start).

GOOD PENMANSHIP: Has worked primarily out of the bullpen this season, making 18 scoreless appearances out of his 27 relief outings and posting a 2.05 ERA (12 ER, 52.2 IP) with 44 strikeouts against four walks.

- Prior to his last start, his 52.2 IP in relief led the Padres bullpen...he has made five separate long relief outings of at least 3.1 IP, including a career-high scoreless 5.2 IP of relief on 5/28 vs. MIA.

NO WALKS FOR YOU: Has walked just seven of the 245 batters he has faced this season.

- His 0.68 walks per nine innings and .021 walks per batters faced ratios lead all Major League relievers, while his 0.80 WHIP ranks tied for third.

NICE VS. THE NL CENTRAL: After his 5.0 IP of one-run ball in his last outing at CHC on 8/2, he has posted a 2.20 ERA in seven appearances (one start) vs. the NL Central this season, his lowest mark against any division.

- His 2.95 career ERA against the NL Central is his lowest against any NL division, trailing only his 1.38 mark against the AL Central.

FIRST AND FOREMOST: Is yet to allow a baserunner in the first inning in each of his three starts (0-for-9 with three strikeouts).

- In the second inning, he has surrendered a .500 (8-for-16) average and a .375 (9-for-24) clip in the third frame.

WHEN IT MATTERS MOST: With runners in scoring position and two outs, he is limiting the opposition to a .211 (4-for-19) average

- While pitching in one-run games, opposing hitters are batting .133 (2-for-15) against Erlin.

HISTORICALLY SPEAKING: Erlin has posted a 4.63 ERA (72 ER, 140.0 IP) before the All-Star Break and settled into a 3.31 mark (27 ER, 73.1 IP) post-All-Star Break.

LONGEST TENURED PADRE: Erlin was originally acquired by the Padres along with RHP Joe Wieland from the Texas Rangers in exchange for RHP Mike Adams on July 31, 2011.

- Made his ML debut on April 30, 2013 at CHC...he is the longest tenured pitcher who has appeared for the Padres at the big league level.

SOLID SPRING: Made two appearances (one start) during Spring Training, posting a 2.84 ERA (2 ER, 6.1 IP) while limiting opposing hitters to a .208 average.

LONG ROAD BACK: Began the 2016 season with El Paso (AAA) but did not pitch in a game before being called up by SD on April 8, 2016, making three starts before undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery on his left elbow on May 17, 2016.

TRIP DOWN MEMORY LANE: Tossed four complete game shutouts his senior season at Scotts Valley (CA) High School, including a 15-strikeout no-hitter.
