### TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland's "magic number" to clinch its third consecutive American League Central title currently stands at 7.  
 » The Indians have recorded 26 starts with 10-or-more strikeouts, tied with Houston for the Major League lead and establishing a new single-season franchise record.  
 » Cleveland leads MLB with 117 stolen bases this season...Tribes in on pace to lead MLB in steals for the first time in club history.  
 » **YAN GOMES** is batting .370 (17-46) over his past 12 games with two homers, two doubles, four RBI and four runs scored...the former Blue Jay is a .268 (19-71) career hitter vs. Toronto.  
 » **ADAM PLUTKO** is 1-3 with a 5.40 ERA (13ER/21.2IP) on the road this season...he earned his first career MLB win on May 3 (Game 2) vs. Toronto, holding the Blue Jays to three runs on six hits over 7.1 innings of work (0BB, 6K).

### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians fell in walk-off fashion for the 10th time this season as Toronto prevailed, 3-2, in 11 innings yesterday...Cleveland is now 2-7 in extra-inning contests.  
 » The Tribe's "magic number" to clinch the A.L. Central remains at 7 following Minnesota's win vs. Kansas City last night.  
 » **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (1-5) plated the game's first run on an RBI-single in the top of the 5th inning...marked his 97th RBI of the season, 3rd-most in the American League...**YAN GOMES** (3-5) gave the Indians a 2-1 lead with a solo homer in the top of the 6th inning.  
 » **CARLOS CARRASCO** took a no-decision in a dominant start, allowing two runs (one earned) on six hits over 8.0 innings of work...struck out 14 batters, matching his season high (also 14 K on May 9 at Milwaukee).

### 200 COOKIES

» **CARLOS CARRASCO**'s 14 strikeouts last night gave him 201 on the season, 6th-most in the American League.  
 » Marks his third career season with at least 200 strikeouts, after previously doing so in 2015 and 2017...**Carrasco is just the fifth pitcher in Indians franchise history to record three seasons with 200-or-more strikeouts.**  
 » Carrasco now sits at 1,097 career punchouts, moving past **Mike Garcia** (1,095) for 10th place on the Indians all-time leaderboard...**Gary Bell** is 9th with 1,104 strikeouts.  
 » In allowing one earned run over 8.0 innings, Carrasco lowered his second-half ERA to 2.31 (3rd-lowest in American League, min. 50.0IP) and his season ERA to 3.41 (10th-lowest in A.L.).

### OUR FRIENDS IN THE NORTH

» Cleveland is concluding its season series vs. Toronto with a four-game series at Rogers Centre this weekend...the Indians currently hold a 2-2 record this season vs. the Blue Jays.  
 » The Tribe has outscored Toronto 39-32 across the five games, with Cleveland plating 35 runs over the last four contests.  
 » The Indians own an all-time record of 207-208-2 (.499) vs. the Blue Jays, as well as a 19-18 (.514) mark since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013...the clubs squared off in the 2016 ALCS, with Cleveland winning the series four games to one.

### STRONG STARTERS

» **CARLOS CARRASCO**'s outing last night marked the Tribe's 26th start this season with at least 10 strikeouts, tied with Houston for the Major League lead...establishes a new single-season club record, tying the 2018 Astros, the 1999 Diamondbacks and the 2000 Diamondbacks for the 4th-most starts by any team in a single season.  
 » Tribe starting pitchers have recorded 943 strikeouts this season (2nd in MLB, Houston - 980) and have issued just 213 walks (4th-fewest in MLB)...the rotation's collective 4.43 K/BB ratio is the highest in MLB and currently stands as the best mark by a rotation in MLB history...the 2011 Phillies currently hold the full-season record with a 4.22 K/BB ratio.  
 » The Indians currently boast four pitchers among the American League top 10 in ERA: **TREVOR BAUER** (3rd, 2.22), **COREY KLUBER** (5th, 2.75), **MIKE CLEVINGER** (7th, 3.11) and **CARLOS CARRASCO** (10th, 3.41)

### THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

**1995:** The Indians beat the Orioles, 3-2, at Jacobs Field to clinch the A.L. Central title, securing the Tribe's first Postseason berth since the 1954 campaign...Cleveland finished the strike-shortened season 100-44, collecting their second-ever 100-win year (111-43 in 1954)...**Eddie Murray** went 3-for-4 that evening with a double and a pair of RBI, while **José Mesa** earned his 40th save of the season.

### ADAM'S AFTERNOON

» **ADAM PLUTKO** is set to make his 11th start (14th appearance) of the season at the Major League level in this afternoon's outing.  
 » Plutko is starting on regular four days' rest after making his last start on September 3 vs. Kansas City...took the loss after allowing four runs on seven hits over 6.0 innings of work...struck out a career-high eight batters in the Tribe's 5-1 loss to the Royals.  
 » Today will mark Plutko's second career start against Toronto, after making his first career Major League start on May 3 (Game 2) at Progressive Field...earned his first MLB win in that outing, holding the Blue Jays to three runs on six hits over 7.1 innings of work (0BB, 6K).  
 » Plutko has recorded a 1-3 record with a 5.40 ERA (13ER/21.2IP) in four starts (five appearances) on the road this season...his lone road win came on May 23 at Chicago-NL (6.0IP, 2H, 0R, 4BB, 4K).

### RUNNING MEN

» The Indians combined for four stolen bases last night, bringing their Major League-leading total to 117 thefts...the Indians are seeking to lead MLB in steals for the first time in their 118-year franchise history.  
 » Yesterday marked the club's 14th game with at least three steals, five more than any other team in MLB...the club's 79.6% success rate on steal attempts ranks 2nd in MLB (Los Angeles-AL - 81.9%).  
 » **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** enters play today with 29 stolen bases, one behind American League leaders **Whit Merrifield** (KC) and **Dee Gordon** (SEA)...he is one steal away from logging the 3rd season in club history with 30-plus homers and 30-plus steals (Joe Carter - 1987, Grady Sizemore - 2008).  
 » **GREG ALLEN** leads all Major League rookies with 15 stolen bases this season...the last Indians rookie to lead MLB in steals was **Kenny Lofton**, who stole 66 bases in his 1992 campaign.  
 » **RAJAI DAVIS** stole two bases last night to bring his season total to 18 thefts, tied with **Nap Lajoie** (18 SB in 1912) for 2nd-most steals by a Cleveland player in his age-37 season or older...**Omar Vizquel** swiped 19 bases in 2004, also his age-37 campaign.

### YAN STOPPABLE

» **YAN GOMES** led the Tribe offense last night, going 3-for-5 with his 13th home run of the season...marked his 16th multi-hit effort this year, as well as his sixth contest with at least three hits.  
 » Gomes ranks 5th among A.L. catchers with 13 home runs, while he sits 3rd (min. 200 PA) with a .260 batting average.  
 » He has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games (since August 21), batting .370 (17-46) in that span with two homers, two doubles, four RBI and four runs scored...he has collected three hits in three of those contests.  
 » Gomes began his Major League career with Toronto, playing for the Blue Jays in 2012...in 19 games against his former club, he is batting .268 (19-71) with five homers and 12 RBI.

### SOUTHPAW STUDS

» After combining for 1.2 scoreless innings last night, Cleveland's left-handed relievers own a 1.39 ERA (7ER/47.0IP) since the All-Star break, 2nd-lowest in MLB (San Diego - 1.29).  
 » **OLIVER PÉREZ** has posted a 1.04 ERA (3ER/26.0IP) in 43 appearances this season, the lowest mark among left-handed relievers and 2nd-lowest among all relief pitchers (min. 30G), behind Oakland's **Blake Treinen** (0.90 ERA)...he currently holds the lowest-ever season ERA by a Tribe pitcher with 40-or-more appearances, just ahead of **José Mesa's** 1.12 ERA in 1995 (62 games/64.0 innings, finished 2nd in A.L. Cy Young voting).  
 » **BRAD HAND** has posted a 1.74 ERA (4ER/20.2IP) in 20 appearances since joining the Indians on July 20...he struck out four batters over 1.1 innings in last night's contest, marking his 33rd outing with three-or-more strikeouts since the start of 2016 (2nd-most in MLB among LHP over that span).

### (4-5, 5.04 ERA)

#### TODAY'S START

» The 26-year-old right-hander is set to make his 11th career MLB start and his 16th appearance in this afternoon's contest at Toronto.

» Will be starting on regular four days' rest after making his last start on September 3 vs. Kansas City...took the loss after allowing four runs on seven hits over 6.0 innings of work...walked none and struck out a career-high eight batters in Cleveland's 5-1 loss to the Royals.

» Tonight will mark Plutko's second career start and appearance vs. Toronto, after making his first career Major League start on May 3 (Game 2) at Progressive Field...earned his first MLB win by holding the Blue Jays to three runs on six hits over 7.1 strong innings of work (0BB, 6K).

» Plutko enters play tonight among American League rookie leaders in wins (4 - T7th), games started (10 - T10th) and innings pitched (64.1 - 14th).

#### 2018 CLEVELAND RECAP

» Plutko is in the midst of his sixth stint with Cleveland this season, and he is starting on regular four days' rest after making his last start on September 3 vs. Kansas City...was handed the loss after allowing four runs on seven hits over 6.0 innings of work...walked no batters and struck out eight, marking a single-game career high.

» Received his first recall of the 2018 season on May 3 to serve as the 26th man in the Tribe's doubleheader vs. Toronto...**earned his first Major League victory, allowing three runs on six hits over 7.1 strong innings of work...**walked none and struck out a career-high six batters as the Indians beat the Blue Jays, 13-4...**marked the longest outing by a Tribe pitcher making his first career start since Cody Anderson worked 7.2 innings (6H, 0R, 1BB, 4K) in his Major League debut on June 21, 2015 vs. Tampa Bay.**

» Plutko earned his second win in a May 23 start at Chicago-NL...**carried a no-hit bid into the 7th inning, holding the Cubs scoreless over 6.0+ innings in the Tribe's 1-0 victory...**after issuing four walks over the first 2.0 frames, Plutko retired a string of 13 consecutive batters before a pair of hits chased him in the bottom of the 7th inning.

» Labored through 5.0 innings vs. Chicago-AL on May 28, allowing five runs on six hits (1BB, 2K), but picked up his third consecutive win as the Tribe went on to beat the White Sox, 9-6...**became the first Indians pitcher to win each of his first three career starts since Scott Lewis won his first four career starts from September 10-26, 2008.**

» **Earned his fourth win of 2018 on June 24 vs. Detroit, holding the Tigers to two runs on six hits over 6.0 strong innings of work (0BB, 4K).**

» **Earned his first career save on July 11 vs. Cincinnati by working the final 4.0 innings of the Tribe's 19-4 victory,** allowing three runs on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts...marked the largest margin of victory in a save by a Tribe pitcher since the save became an official statistic in 1969, surpassing **Neal Heaton's** save in a 17-3 Tribe victory on July 16, 1983 vs. Kansas City.

#### VS. TORONTO | ON THE ROAD

» Plutko is set to make his second career start against the Toronto Blue Jays...**made his first career Major League start and earned his first win on May 3 (Game 2) at Progressive Field, holding the Blue Jays to three runs on six hits over 7.1 innings of work (0BB, 6K)...**remains the longest start of his MLB career.

» Plutko will also be making his fifth road start (sixth appearance) of the season...owns a 1-3 record with a 5.40 ERA (13ER/21.2IP) in his previous appearances...Plutko's lone road win came on May 23 at Chicago-NL, where he allowed just two hits over 6.0+ shut-out innings (carried no-hit bid into the 7th inning).

#### 2018 MILB RECAP

» Across his final four stints with Columbus, Plutko posted a 3-0 record with a 1.11 ERA (5ER/40.2IP)...**threw a no-hitter at Syracuse on June 2, allowing just one baserunner on a 9th-inning walk (retired first 25 batters faced)...**his eight-strikeout performance earned him International League Pitcher of the Week honors (June 3)...also struck out a season-high 11 batters in his July 6 start at Indianapolis.

» In 14 starts with the Clippers, Plutko posted a 7-3 record with a 1.70 ERA (16ER/84.1IP)...**led the International League in ERA (min. 80.0IP) and WHIP (0.74).**

#### MAJOR LEAGUE CAREER

» The Tribe right-hander is in the midst of his ninth career stint with the Indians, six of which have come in the 2018 season.

» Plutko received his first career Major League call-up on September 20, 2016 at age 24, following **Carlos Carrasco's** season-ending injury.

» **Made his Major League debut on September 24, 2016 vs. the Chicago White Sox, tossing 1.2 scoreless relief innings on two hits...**walked one batter and struck out two, fanning **Tim Anderson** for his first career strikeout...made another relief appearance for the Tribe on September 27 at Detroit, allowing three runs on three hits over 2.0 innings...finished the 2016 campaign with a 7.36 ERA (3ER/3.2IP) over two relief appearances.

» Spent three stints with the Indians in 2017, but did not make an appearance...Plutko was with the team from June 16-22, August 2-4 and September 1-3.

» **Underwent surgical intervention on October 9 in Dallas, Texas to repair a tear in the labrum of his right hip, in an operation performed by Dr. Bill Robertson...**immediately began rehab and returned to full baseball activity during the Tribe's 2018 Spring Training.

#### CAREER SNAPSHOT

» The Dallas, Texas native played his college ball at UCLA, where he spent three seasons (2011-13) with the Bruins...as a junior, he went 10-3 with a 2.25 ERA in 19 starts as he helped lead the Bruins to a College World Series championship...was named the CWS Most Outstanding Player after going 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA in two Postseason starts...finished his collegiate career with the 2nd-most wins (29), starts (52) and innings pitching (351.1IP) in school history.

» **Was drafted by Cleveland in the 11th round (321st overall) of the 2013 Amateur Draft...**made his professional debut with Lake County in the beginning of the 2014 season, entering as the 18th-best Tribe prospect by **Baseball America**...posted a record of 3-1 with a 3.93 ERA in 10 starts with the Captains, earning Midwest League Pitcher of the Week honors for the week of May 12, 2014.

» Earned a midseason call-up to High-A Carolina on May 29, 2014 and spent the rest of the season there, going 4-9 with a 4.08 ERA in 18 starts.

» Began the 2015 campaign at High-A Lynchburg, where he posted a 4-2 record with a 1.27 ERA across eight starts...earned two more Pitcher of the Week honors, earning Carolina League nods for the weeks of May 11 and May 25.

» Received his first Double-A assignment with a call-up on May 27 and went 9-5 with a 2.86 ERA across 19 starts for the RubberDucks...enjoyed two starts at Akron with at least 7.0 shutout innings and three-or-fewer hits allowed...**finished the season 13-7 with a 2.39 ERA across both levels, earning an Organizational All-Star nod from MLB.com.**

» Began the 2016 season at Double-A Akron and spent the first 2.5 months of the season there, going 3-3 with a 3.27 ERA in 13 starts before earning his first Triple-A call-up on June 18...went 6-5 over 15 starts for the Clippers with a 4.10 ERA, earning International League Pitcher of the Week honors for the week of August 21...struck out a career-high 13 batters at Syracuse on June 18...finished the Minor League season second among organizational pitchers with 161.2 innings pitched and 130 strikeouts.

» Spent most of the 2017 campaign with Triple-A Columbus, also serving three stints with the big-league club...posted a mark of 7-12 with a 5.90 ERA in 24 games/22 starts with the Clippers, finishing 9th in the International League and 7th in the Tribe organization with 135.2 innings pitched...over his final four starts of the season, Plutko went 2-1 with a 2.10 ERA (6ER/25.2IP).
