TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants and Cubs play the first game of a three-game series...San Francisco is 2-2 on this current homestand (2-2 vs. St. Louis), while the Cubs are on the first leg of a two-city road trip that also includes a stop in San Diego.

2018 ALL-STARS: IF Brandon Crawford will be the starting NL shortstop in this year's All-Star Game in Washington, D.C....it's Crawford's second All-Star selection and his first as a starter...**C Buster Posey** will be joining him as the winner of the players' vote at his position...it's Posey's sixth All-Star selection and his third as a reserve.

#BELTTHEBALLOT: IF Brandon Belt is one of five candidates for the NL Final Vote with the winner earning the last spot on the All-Star team...Belt won the Final Vote in 2016...voting is open until 1 p.m. PST on Wednesday...vote for Brandon at sfgiants.com/vote.

ALL-STAR MATERIAL: IF Brandon Belt leads all first basemen in defensive runs saved...he has the second-best OPS in the NL in the fourth through sixth innings...this season, he is batting .308 against relief pitchers.

SF RELIEVERS: The bullpen trio of **RHP Reyes Moronta**, **LHP Tony Watson** and **LHP Will Smith** have a combined 1.54 ERA (18er, 105.0ip) in 2018, which is the third-best ERA by relievers in the Majors.

ON THE SHORES OF McCOVEY COVE: The Giants are 28-16 (.636) here at home this season, the third-best home record in the NL behind Philadelphia (30-16, .652) and Chicago (28-15, .651)...SF has won six of their last nine home games and 16 of their last 22...the Giants have gone 9-0-2 (win-lost-split) in their last 11 home series...they haven't lost a home set since dropping two of three to Arizona from April 8-10.

NOT A LOT OF REST: The Giants are currently in a stretch of playing 16-consecutive games before their next off day, which is Thursday, July 12...beginning June 8 and leading up to the All-Star Break, the Giants will have played 36 games in 38 days.

This Date in Giants History: July 9, 1988

Chris Speier hit for the cycle and **Ernest Riles** recorded the 10,000th home run in Giants history to lead San Francisco to a 21-2 rout of the St. Louis Cardinals...at the time the 21 runs were a San Francisco record...Speier also cycled as an Expo in 1978, just the fourth Major Leaguer to do so for two teams...he joined Joe Cronin (Washington, 1929; Red Sox, 1940), Babe Herman (Dodgers, 1931; Cubs, 1933) and Bob Watson (Astros, 1977; Boston, 1979).

6-0, 187, 25 years old (September 11, 1992)
3-5 Record, 3.92 ERA

- The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 15th career Major League start...has gone 3-5 with a 3.92 ERA (34er, 78.0ip) in 14 outings, with the Giants going 5-9 in those games.
- Despite a great outing, he was tagged with the loss in the Giants' 1-0 defeat at Colorado on July 4...allowed one run on five hits with no walks and six strikeouts... his one run allowed was a solo home run by Chris Iannetta.
- Has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his last five outings, posting a 2.10 ERA (7er, 30.0ip).
- Has struck out 72 batters while issuing just 15 walks in his first 14 career Major League starts...ranks fourth among NL rookies in strikeouts.
- His 72 strikeouts through his first 14 career starts rank fourth in Giants history since 1920.

- Became the first Giants pitcher to begin his career with 14 starts of two walks or fewer since 1913...the last MLB pitcher to begin his career with at least 13 starts of two walks or fewer was Pittsburgh's Trevor Williams who had 15 consecutive such starts to begin his career from 2016-2017 (Stats, LLC).
- Opponents have 19 hits in 59 at-bats (.322) off him with runners in scoring position...is holding opponents to a .130 average (3-for-23) with RISP and two outs.
- Has received three or fewer runs of support in 10 of his 14 starts.
- Is 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA (3er, 19.0ip) and a .235 opponents average over his last three starts at AT&T Park.
- Lefties are hitting .184 (14-for-76) off him and are just 5-for-their-last-35 (.143).
- Was selected in the second round of the 2015 MLB Draft by San Francisco (No. 61 overall).

NOTES: The two-time All-Star (2014 & 2016) returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the disabled list on July 5...is scheduled to make his seventh start of the season...was placed on the DL on May 1 with right elbow inflammation...saw Dr. James Andrews on May 7 and was diagnosed with an elbow sprain...missed 61 games...struggled in his first start back from the disabled list last Friday...allowed five runs on 10 hits in 5.0 innings of work in the Giants' 11-2 loss to the Cardinals...his 10 hits allowed marked the most he's given up in a game since Oct. 1, 2017 vs. SD (12)...Has posted a 9-9 record with a 3.35 ERA (58er, 156.0ip) in 25 career starts against the Cubs.
