CARDINALS NOTES

- **Luke Weaver** made his team-leading 14th start of the season, second against the Padres in 2018 (1-0) and third career start vs. the Padres (2-0)...has lost a team-high four straight decisions this season, last earning a win at SD (5/11)...had thrown 12.0 consecutive scoreless innings vs. SD racking up 14 strikeouts before allowing a two 1st inning runs tonight.
- **Luke Weaver** recorded his first hit against a left-handed pitcher with a single in the 3rd inning (3rd career hit vs. LHP).
- **Jedd Gyorko** has hit safely in 13-of-16 career games with an at-bat vs. the Padres (25-59, .424)...collected his first multi-hit game since 5/29 at MIL.
- **Marcell Ozuna** extended his hitting streak to seven games (10-27, .370) and has hit safely in 11-of-12 games (18-45, .400) in June...has an RBI in five straight games, establishing a new club high this season.
- **Tommy Pham** extended his season-high hitting streak to eight games (10-34, .294).
- The **Cardinals** did not draw one walk during this three-game series, the first time a Cardinals team has not drawn a walk in a three-game series since May 26-28, 1978 vs. Chicago at Busch Stadium II...have not committed an error in six straight games, extending their season-high and longest streak since 8/3-8/2017...are 4-6 against N.L. West teams this season averaging 3.1 runs per game and averaging 4.5 runs against all other opponents.

PADRES NOTES

- **Eric Lauer** made his 10th start of the season, second against the Cardinals in 2018 (1-1) and in his career...has two wins in his last three starts...has pitched 5.0 or more innings in either of his last three starts...surrendered six runs over 2.1 innings in his last starts vs. STL also facing Luke Weaver, giving up four home runs (1 of 11 pitchers, 13 instances a starting pitcher allowed 4 HR in a game this season)...has allowed eight home runs this season with five coming to the Cardinals.
- **Cory Spangenberg** has scored in four straight games, one shy of his career-high of five done twice in 2017.
- **Christian Villanueva** scored his first run in the month of June (last: 5/31 vs. MIA).
- **Manuel Margot** recorded a season-high three hits (last: 5/9 vs. WSH) for the second time this season...raced out his 3rd triple of the season...has hit safely in his last six games (9-20, .450), one game shy of his career-high seven game hitting streak (twice).
- **Franmil Reyes** collected his first career double...was his first extra base hit this season that was not a home run (6 HR).
- **Raffy Lopez** is 4-for-39 (.103) this season on the road with two of the hits against the Cardinals.
- **Eric Hosmer** tallied his 26th multi-hit game, ranking 2nd in the National League.

- **José Castillo** has faced 14 Major League batters in his career and has struck out nine batters including the last five...struck out a season-high four batters...is one of five pitchers this season to face exactly four batters and strike out all four (**Nick Vincent, Pedro Báez, Brad Hand, Bruce Rondón**).
- **Brad Hand** recorded his National League leading 21st save, tying his single-season high (2017)...has nailed down his last 15 straight save opportunities and the Padres are 19-0 in his last 19 appearances...has not allowed a run in his last five appearances (6.0 IP) and a hit in his last four appearances.
- The **Padres** won the season series against the Cardinals 4-3 (first time since 2015; also 4-3)...have won five straight series, all 2-1, last losing a series at Los Angeles (5/25-27)...did not issue a walk during this three-game series, marking the first time in club history the team did not issue a walk in a three-game series...the last walk issued was to **Justin Bour** at Miami to lead-off the 7th inning...the 28.0 inning stretch without a walk is the 5th-longest stretch in club history.
