TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** lost the one-game series vs. the White Sox in a makeup game from mid-April...this is the second one-game series the Twins have played in, the other was a loss to Seattle on May 14...finish the homestand 5-2 and fall to 19-6 in their last 25 at home and 38-26 at Target Field overall...are now to 28-26 vs. the AL Central...are now 7-6 vs. Chicago-AL this year and 3-3 at Target Field...the Twins travel to Chicago tomorrow for a two-game series vs. the White Sox...the Twins recorded 17 home runs this homestand, the most in baseball since August 14; 26 of their 45 runs on the homestand off homer runs...the beginning of the game was delayed by 33 minutes.
- **STEPHEN GONSALVES** lasted 1.1 innings in his major league debut, allowing four runs on six hits and two walks with three strikeouts...sixth Twin to make his major league debut in 2018...tied for the shortest start by a Twin this year, the other outing coming from Aaron Slegers on July 10 vs. Kansas City.
- **MAX KEPLER** (2-for-4) tripled and homered tonight to extend his home on-base streak...has now been on base, by hit or walk, in 23 straight games...is hitting .342 (27-for-79) with 12 extra-base hits and 14 walks during the streak...the triple is his fourth this year, most on the team.
- **EHIRE ADRIANZA** (2-for-4) singled twice and drove in a run, his 10th multi-hit game this year...is now hitting .329 (23-for-70) with 14 RBI in his career vs. Chicago.
- **TYLER AUSTIN** (1-for-4) doubled and drove in a run in the second inning and is now hitting .370 (10-for-27) with four extra-base hits and six RBI since joining the Twins.
- **JAKE CAVE** (1-for-3) hit a two-run home run in the fourth inning and has hit a home run in consecutive games for the first time in his career...has a hit in 12 of his last 16 games and 16 of his last 21 ...is now hitting .350 (28-for-80) with 13 extra-base hits and 20 RBI at Target Field this year.

WHITE SOX NOTES:

- **THE WHITE SOX** took the one-game series from the Twins and have now won five of their last six games and 10 of their last 17...the White Sox have also won six of their last seven road contests and eight of their last 11; improve to 23-38 on the road this year...improve to 22-32 against the AL Central this year, including 11-14 on the road...did not hit a home run tonight for the first time in 11 games...are now 10-8 in August, only their second month with double-digit wins (12-17 in June).

- **LUCAS GIOLITO** earned the win after allowing three runs (two earned) on five hits and two walks with six strikeouts over 6.0 innings...his 12th quality start of the year and his third in his last four starts...in his last five road starts, is 3-1 with a 3.34 ERA (32.1 IP, 12 ER) with 27 strikeouts and is 6-4 with a 4.54 ERA (79.1 IP, 40 ER) overall on the road this year.
- **NICKY DELMONICO** (1-for-4) tripled in the second inning to extend his hitting streak to six games and is hitting .292 (7-for-24) with four extra base hits and six runs scored over the streak...his fourth triple this year, his first since July 27.
- **JOSE ABREU** (2-for-5) doubled and drove in a pair of runs in the second inning, his 36th double of the year...has now hit safely in seven straight games, hitting .392 (11-for-28) with 11 RBI...has hit safely in 22 of his last 26 games, hitting .350 (36-for-103) with nine doubles and 26 RBI...37th multi-hit game.
- **MATT DAVIDSON** (2-for-5) singled and hit a two-run home run tonight, driving in three runs, the sixth time this year he's driven in three or more runs and the first time since July 1 vs. Texas...over his last nine games is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with three home runs and eight RBI.
- **TIM ANDERSON** (2-for-4) singled twice for his 30th multi-hit game this year...over his last seven games is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with five RBI.
- **DANIEL PALKA** (2-for-4) singled and hit an RBI-double tonight for his 20th multi-hit game of the year, which is fourth most among AL rookies...owns 50 RBI this year, third most among AL rookies.
- **YOLMER SANCHEZ** (1-for-4) singled in the ninth to extend his hitting streak to nine games, is hitting .342 (13-for-38) during the streak.
- **LEURY GARCIA** left the game in the bottom of the fourth inning after suffering a left hamstring strain chasing down a Mitch Garver double...he will be reevaluated tomorrow in Chicago.
