THE TWINS: The Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 1-2 at Cleveland, winning the second game of the three-game series on Tuesday night with losses on Monday and Wednesday...the Twins will continue their roadtrip today with the four-game series finale in Cleveland then travel to Detroit for three over the weekend...the Twins are 18-12 in 30 games since July 5.

TWINS WALKED-OFF.....AGAIN: The Twins lost to the Indians last night in walk-off fashion, allowing a three-run homer to Francisco Lindor in the bottom of the ninth...it marked the Twins 11th walk-off loss this season and eighth via home run...Jake Odorizzi was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs (1 earned) on four hits in 4.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, highlighted by Miguel Sanó, who went 2-for-4 with his first home run since May 31 vs. Cleveland, which tied the game at 2-2 in the top of the ninth.

TWINS AND TRIBE: The Twins are playing the Indians for the 16th of 19 scheduled meetings this season and for the seventh time of 10 scheduled games at Progressive Field...they have gone 8-7 vs. the Tribe, 4-3 at Target Field, 1-1 in Puerto Rico and 3-3 at Cleveland...eight wins are their most vs. any opponent this season.

☞ The Twins are 14-10 in their last 24 at Progressive Field and 9-6 in their last 15.

☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .340 (81-for-238) with 12 doubles, three triples, 15 home runs, 34 RBI and 39 runs scored in 63 career games vs. Cleveland; the homers, hits and RBI all being his personal most vs. any opponent...his 81 hits vs. CLE since 2015 lead baseball...in 32 career games at Progressive Field, he is hitting .380 (46-for-121); in his last eight games here, he has four hits three times and three hits once.

☞ Miguel Sanó has reached safely in each of his last 13 vs. the Indians.

MAUER IS PROGRESSIVE: Joe Mauer is hitting .315 (118-for-375) with 34 doubles, 48 walks and a .392 on-base percentage in 96 career games at Progressive...he's hitting .356 (31-for-87) in his last 21 here...Mauer is hitting .318 (234-for-736) with 51 doubles, 14 home runs, 78 RBI, 101 walks, 110 runs scored and .399 on-base percentage in 193 career games vs. the Indians...234 hits are his second most vs. any opponent (247 vs. KC)...among actives vs. Cleveland, he ranks first in doubles and walks and second in hits...below are all-time ranks at Progressive Field for opponents:

ROSIE RAKES: Eddie Rosario is hitting .299 (136-for-455) with 28 doubles, 20 home runs, 66 RBI, 72 runs scored and a .340 on-base percentage in 112 games this season...he has 43 multi-hit games this season, fourth most in baseball, trailing Francisco Lindor (46), Nick Markakis (45) and J.D. Martinez (45)...additionally he ranks tied for second in hits with Francisco Lindor, behind J.D. Martinez (138) and tied-sixth in total bases in the American League.

SANÓ STORMING: Miguel Sanó is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with four doubles, four RBI, six walks and a .457 on-base percentage in his last nine games...since being recalled on July 28, he is hitting .278 (10-for-36) with six walks and a .381 on-base percentage, compared to .203 (30-for-148) with a .270 on-base percentage prior to being optioned to the minor leagues on June 14...he has reached safely in nine straight games overall and has recorded four multi-hit games during that streak.

ROCKIN' ROOKIES: Of Rookies this season appearing in at least 42 games this season Jake Cave and Mitch Garver rank among some of the best in baseball in multiple offensive categories:

☞ Cave ranks eighth in baseball and third in the A.L. in average (.280), sixth in SLG (.642) and 10th in OBP (.311).

☞ Garver ranks third in average (.260), eighth in hits (56), sixth in OBP (.339), 11th in XBH (19), and 10th in total bases (89).

☞ Garver also ranks in the top ten among all AL catchers in fielding percentage (.996) and is third among Rookie catchers in games started (55)

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1967, the Twins played a 20-inning game against the Senators, losing 9-7...it stands as the third longest game in Twins history in terms in innings (August 31, 1993 vs. Cleveland - 22 innings & May 12, 1972 vs. Milwaukee - 22 innings)

THE BIRTHDAY BOY: Twins minor league coordinator Edgar Varela is celebrating his 38th birthday today...Varela is in his first season in the Twins organization...he shares a birthday with several former Twins: Drew Butera (35), Mike Lamb (43), Brian Fuentes (43), Pat Mahomes, Sr. (48), John Moses (61), and Bill Campbell (70).
