THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-6 through eight games on their nine-game roadtrip, going 1-2 in Cleveland, 1-2 in Texas and 0-2 in Houston...tonight the Twins will complete the trip with the three-game series finale at Houston...following tonight's game, the Twins will travel to Minneapolis for an off-day tomorrow then play three vs. the Royals over the weekend and three vs. the Yankees next Monday-Wednesday.

HOUSTON'S FINEST CAN'T OVERCOME ASTROS: The Twins lost to the Astros last night at Minute Maid Park by a score of 5-2...Trevor May (3-1) was the Opening Pitcher, allowing four runs on five hits in 1.0 innings pitched while Kohl Stewart, the Houston native and Primary Pitcher, threw 5.0 scoreless innings with three hits allowed...another Houston native, Tyler Duffey, pitched a scoreless eighth inning...Houston resident and former Astro, Robbie Grossman, went 2-for-3 with his 20th double of the season...Twins have now lost four straight, all in Texas, two in Arlington and two in Houston.

TWINS AND ASTROS: The Twins are playing for the sixth and final time against the Astros this season...the Twins have gone 2-3 vs. the Astros in 2018...the Twins are 27-29 all-time against the Astros, including a record of 16-20 since the Houston joined the American League in 2013...they have won just three times in their last 14 meetings with the Astros.
☞ The Twins can avoid a season-series loss with a win tonight and draw a tie...a loss would mark the third straight season-series loss to the 'Stros (1-5 in 2017 & 2-5 in 2016).
☞ Joe Mauer has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games vs. Houston, hitting .308 (16-for-52) in that span...he has a career .263 (15-for-57) average at Minute Maid Park, his second lowest of any opposing AL ballpark (Fenway - .255).
☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .318 (14-for-44) in 11 career games vs. Houston.

EXTRA-BASE MAUER: Joe Mauer has 596 extra-base hits in his career and needs one to tie Tony Oliva for fourth most in Twins history (since 1961):

ROCKIN' ROBBIE: Robbie Grossman is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with four doubles, five RBI, five walks, a .449 on-base percentage and a .901 OPS in his last 14 games...Grossman played for Houston from 2013-15 hitting .240 (160-for-666) with 30 doubles, 11 home runs and 63 RBI in 190 games.

KEEP THE BROOMS IN THE CLOSET: The Twins are looking to avoid being swept tonight for the seventh time this season...the last time they were swept came July 20-22 by Kansas City in three games at Kauffman Stadium...the last time they were swept by the Astros came May 29-31, 2017 in three games at Target Field...they have never been swept in Houston.

MR. ROGERS NEIGHBORHOOD: Taylor Rogers enters tonight riding a 14.2 scoreless innings streak, dating back to July 30...it marks the fifth longest active scoreless streak in AL for any pitcher, trailing Boston's Chris Sale (28.0), Seattle's Wade LeBlanc (18.0), the Twins' Adalberto Mejía (15.1) and Texas' Jose Leclerc (15.0)...he has posted a 1.47 ERA (30.2 IP, 5 ER) with eight walks, 39 strikeouts and a .155 opponent batting average in 33 games since June 17, opposed to a 5.13 ERA (26.1 IP, 15 ER) with six walks, 25 strikeouts and a .297 opponent batting average in his first 28 games...additionally, he has set a career-high in games (61) and needs one strikeout to set a career-high (64).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2018, Bartolo Colón made his 10th start as a Twin at Tampa Bay opposite tonight's starter Jake Odorizzi...the Twins lost to the Rays 2-1 as both pitchers threw 6.2 innings as Colón (L) allowed two runs and Odorizzi (W) allowed zero...it marked the seventh different uniform he had worn when facing the Rays (previously Cleveland, Chicago-AL, Los Angeles-AL, New York-AL, Oakland, New York-NL), most of any starting pitcher and tied for the most of any player overall...Colón is the only remaining active player who debuted before the Rays played their first game.

MINOR MATTERS: Twins minor league affiliates in the playoffs:

- ☞ Single-A Ft. Myers won Game 1 yesterday in the Florida State League Finals, beating Palm Beach by a score of 3-1...with a win tonight they could clinch their first FSL Championship since 2014, first pitch at 6:30 pm.
- ☞ Rookie-Level Elizabethton won Game 1 yesterday in the Appalachian League Finals, beating Princeton by a score of 7-4...the E-Twins can win the Appy League title for the second year in a row with a win tonight, first pitch at 7 pm...it will mark their eighth Appy League Championship under Manager Ray Smith (since 1989).

LAST START: Odorizzi suffered his second consecutive start on August 30 at Cleveland... went 5.1 innings and allowed one run to score and left two runners on base when he was relieved by Alan Busenitz, who allowed both runs to score, giving Odo the loss... his three hits allowed were his fewest since July 22 at Kansas City and his three walks issued the most since July 3 at Milwaukee...is now 0-4 in the division through 12 starts.

AGAINST HOUSTON: Is 3-0 against Houston in four career starts, including his start earlier this season on April 10...Odo earned the win after 6.0 innings and allowing just one run on five hits, five walks and four strikeouts...two of his four starts against the Astros have been scoreless and three of the four have been quality starts...has just one start at Minute Maid Park on August 18, 2015, where he did not earn the decision after 6.0 innings, allowed six hits and one run score, one walk and nine strikeouts.

ON THE FIRST PITCH: Through his 27 starts this season, Odorizzi has allowed a .479 (23-for-48) average on the first pitch against a batter...on the 0-0 count, five of the 23 hits have been home runs and seven have been doubles...his .479 average is the highest of any full season in his career.

- On the contrary, when Odorizzi gets two strikes on a batter he is holding hitters to a .183 (61-for-333) average.

QUALITY NOT QUANTITY: Over his 28 starts this season, Odorizzi has averaged just over 5.1 innings/start...of starters with at least 28 starts, his 143.0 innings ranks as the fewest in MLB...his 18.9 pitches/inning ranks highest in baseball...he averages 4.37 pitches/batter faced which is most in MLB...though his starts have been on the short side, his 70 earned runs allowed ranks sixth fewest in the American League among qualified pitchers who have started at least 28 games.

- His start on August 24 snapped his MLB record stretch of 26 games started without recording an out in the 7th inning.

HOME AND ROAD: Has gone 4-4, 4.73 ERA (70.1 IP, 37 ER) in 14 home starts this season, compared to 1-5, 4.09 ERA (72.2 IP, 32 ER) in 14 road starts...at home Odo has walked 22 batters and 35 on the road...among starters on the Twins Odorizzi has received the second most runs of support at home (40)...in contrast, he has only received 27 runs of support on the road, which is tied for second fewest of any starter with at least 13 road starts in baseball.

STILL NEED HELP: In Odorizzi's 28 starts in 2018, the Twins offense has supplied 67 total runs, good for a run support average of 4.25 runs per game...the 65 runs of support rank second fewest in baseball among starters with at least 27 starts and his 4.22 RSA ranks 12th lowest in the American League.

FLY AWAY: In 2017 Odorizzi ranked fourth among all major league pitchers in Fly Ball Percentage (min. 140.0 IP) with a rate of 47.3%...he trailed Ariel Miranda of Seattle (52.2%), Marco Estrada of Toronto (50.3%), and Ian Kennedy of Kansas City (47.7%)...since 2014 Odorizzi has ranked in the top-10 in fly ball percentage every season: 2014 (2nd, 48.7%), 2015 (10th, 40.6%), and 2016 (9th, 44.4%)...in 2018, Odorizzi has allowed 176 fly balls, seventh most in baseball and sixth most in the AL...in his first two months, Odorizzi allowed 14 home runs...since June 6, has only allowed four home runs, tied for fifth fewest in AL over that stretch among starters with at least 10 starts.

A BRIGHT START: Odorizzi pitched in his first career Opening Day start and first career start for the Twins...he went 6.0 innings and allowed just two hits, while not allowing a run and striking out seven...only five other times in his career has he notched seven or more strikeouts while not allowing a run in 6.0-plus innings, the first since April 8, 2015 vs. Baltimore...he became the eighth different pitcher to start Opening Day for the Twins in the last 12 seasons.

- Selected by Milwaukee in the first round (32nd overall) of 2008 First-Year Player Draft, traded to Kansas City in 2010, then in 2012 traded to Tampa Bay where he remained until his trade to Minnesota on February 17, 2018.
- 2017 marked his fourth straight year of at least 28 starts.
- On May 29, 2016 vs. New York-AL, retired his first 16 batters-faced, tied for third-longest perfect game bid in Rays history.
- Established career-highs in 2016 for starts (33) and innings pitched (187.2).
- In 2016 allowed 2 ER or fewer in 13 of his no-decisions, a mark reached by only one other pitcher since 1913.
- Earned his first major league win in his season debut on April 4, 2014 vs. Texas.
